COVID-19 Prevention Tips



WASH

Wash your hands frequently using soap for at least 20 seconds or sanitise them using alcohol-based handrub.

COVER

Use tissues when you cough or sneeze and dispose them immediately in a closed bin. Use flexed-elbow if tissue is unavailable.

AVOID

Avoid touching your mouth, eyes and nose, especially after contact with any surface.

DISTANCE

Practice social distancing by not shaking hands, hugging, etc.

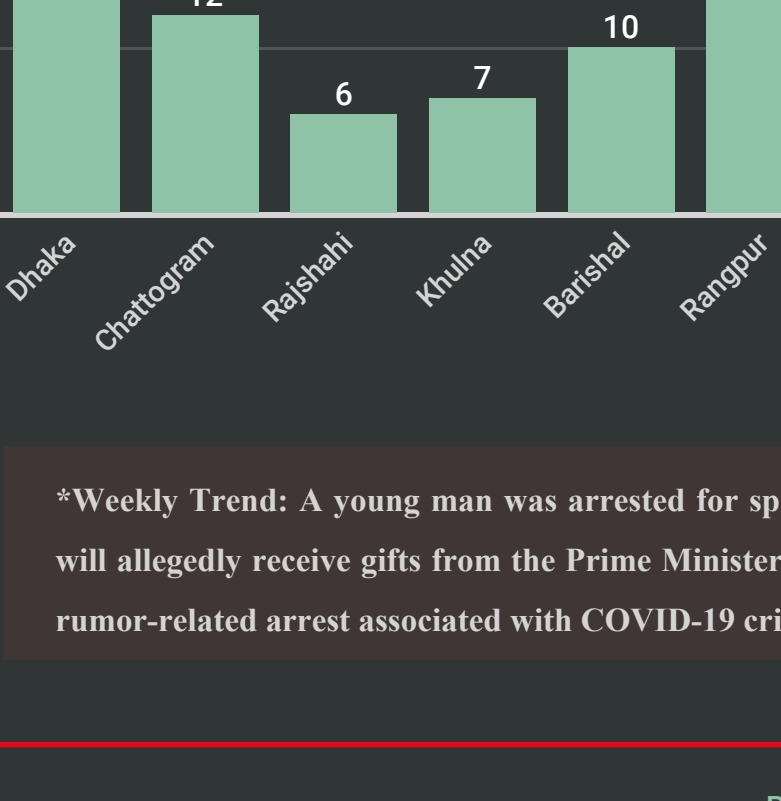
ISOLATE

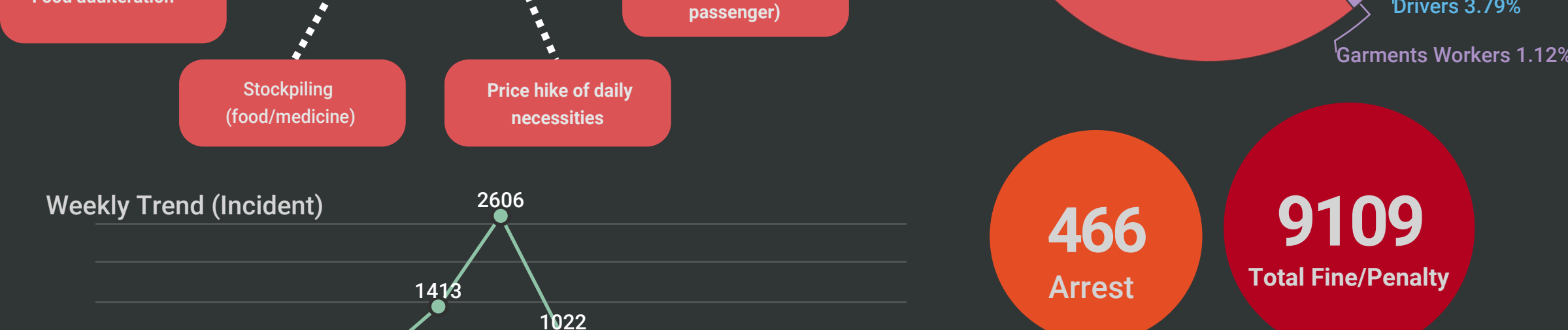

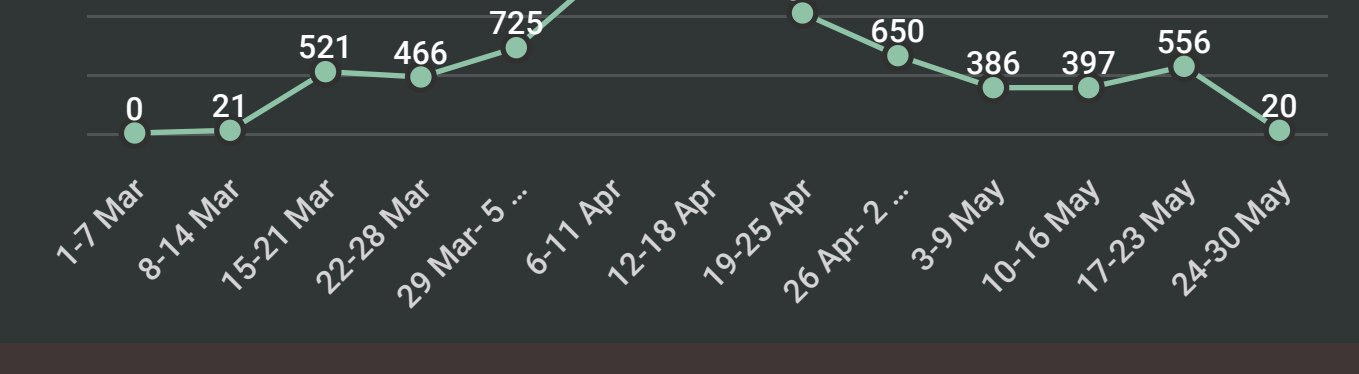
Rumors

*Weekly Trend: A young man was arrested for spreading rumors in Facebook about a 'fake list' of people who will allegedly receive gifts from the Prime Minister amid the COVID-19 pandemic in Gazipur. This was the only rumor-related arrest associated with COVID-19 crisis from May 17th to May 30th.

Major Reasons of Fine/Penalty

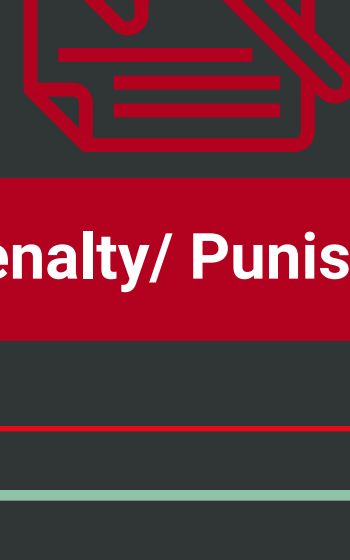

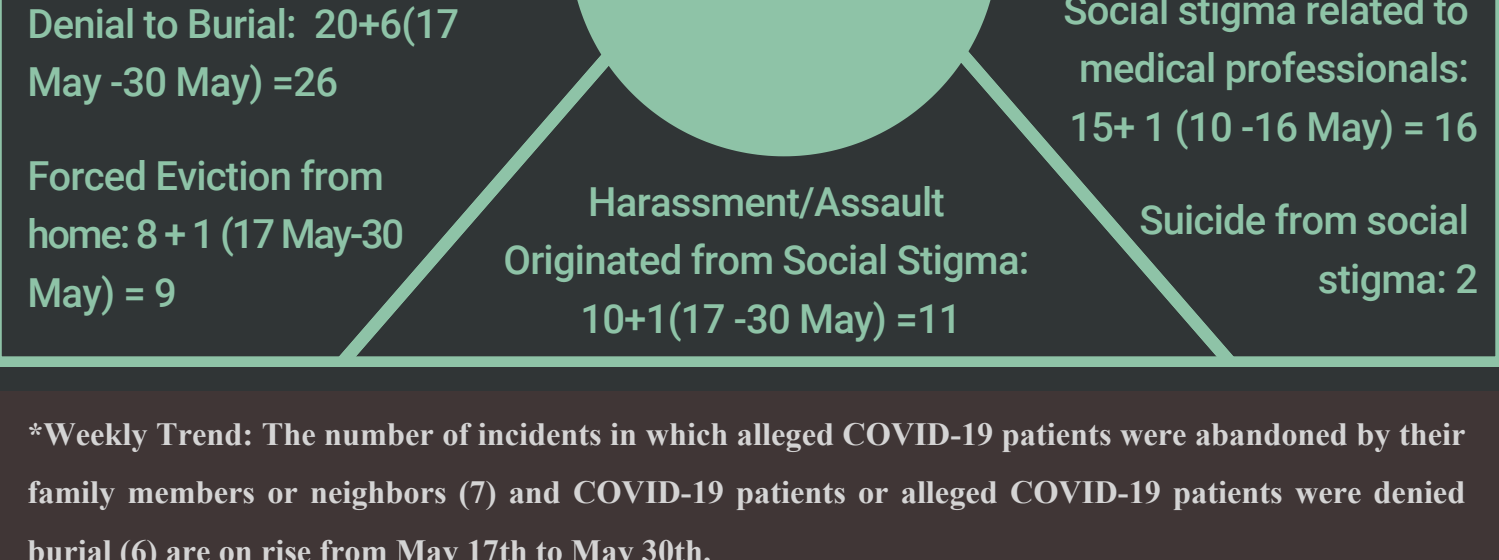
Fine/ Penalty/ Punishment

* The Ministry of Local Government, Rural Development and Co-operatives suspended 18 people's representatives (4 UP chairmen, 11 UP members, 3 councilors) and arrested two rice dealers of TCB for irregularities in distribution of relief among the poor amidst the coronavirus pandemic. Till 30 May, a total of 73 People's representatives has been suspended in this connection.
* At least 576 were reportedly detained/fined/penalized and 50 were arrested all over Bangladesh during 17-30 May 2020. Most of the fine and penalty accounted for the violation of health and safety regulations amid the limited shopping before Eid-ul-Fitr.

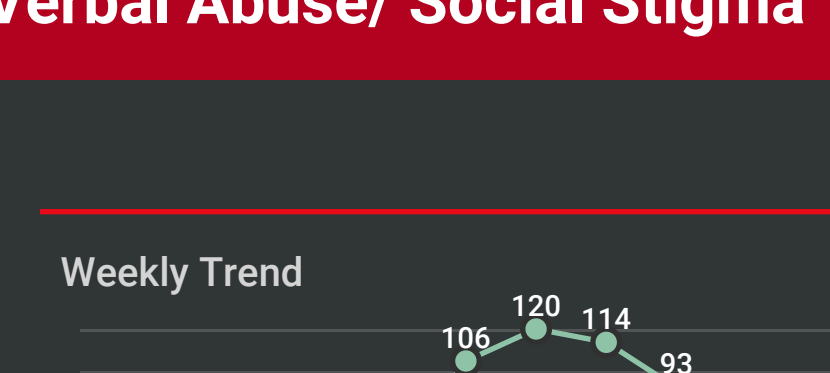

*Weekly Trend: The number of incidents in which alleged COVID-19 patients were abandoned by their family members or neighbors (7) and COVID-19 patients or alleged COVID-19 patients were denied burial (6) are on rise from May 17th to May 30th.
*Eg. The body of a housewife named Ferdousi Begum (28), who died at a hospital in Narsingdi with corona symptoms, was buried by the police as the family members did not accept her body. Burial was arranged at the municipal cemetery on Friday (May 29) at the initiative of Narsingdi Model Police.
*Eg. o A 60 years old man, Anwar Hossain died with breathing difficulties and fever after he was taken to the Mugda General Hospital. He died in front of the hospital gate. He was denied treatment by the hospital authority at Mugda, Dhaka.
*Eg. o In Sonagazi of Feni, two daughters-in-law left Firoza Begum (65), a sick old mother-in-law, on the street on suspicion of corona. The incident took place in Sujapur area of Matiganj union of the upazila on Monday (May 18). Later in the night, the locals rescued the old woman and took her home.

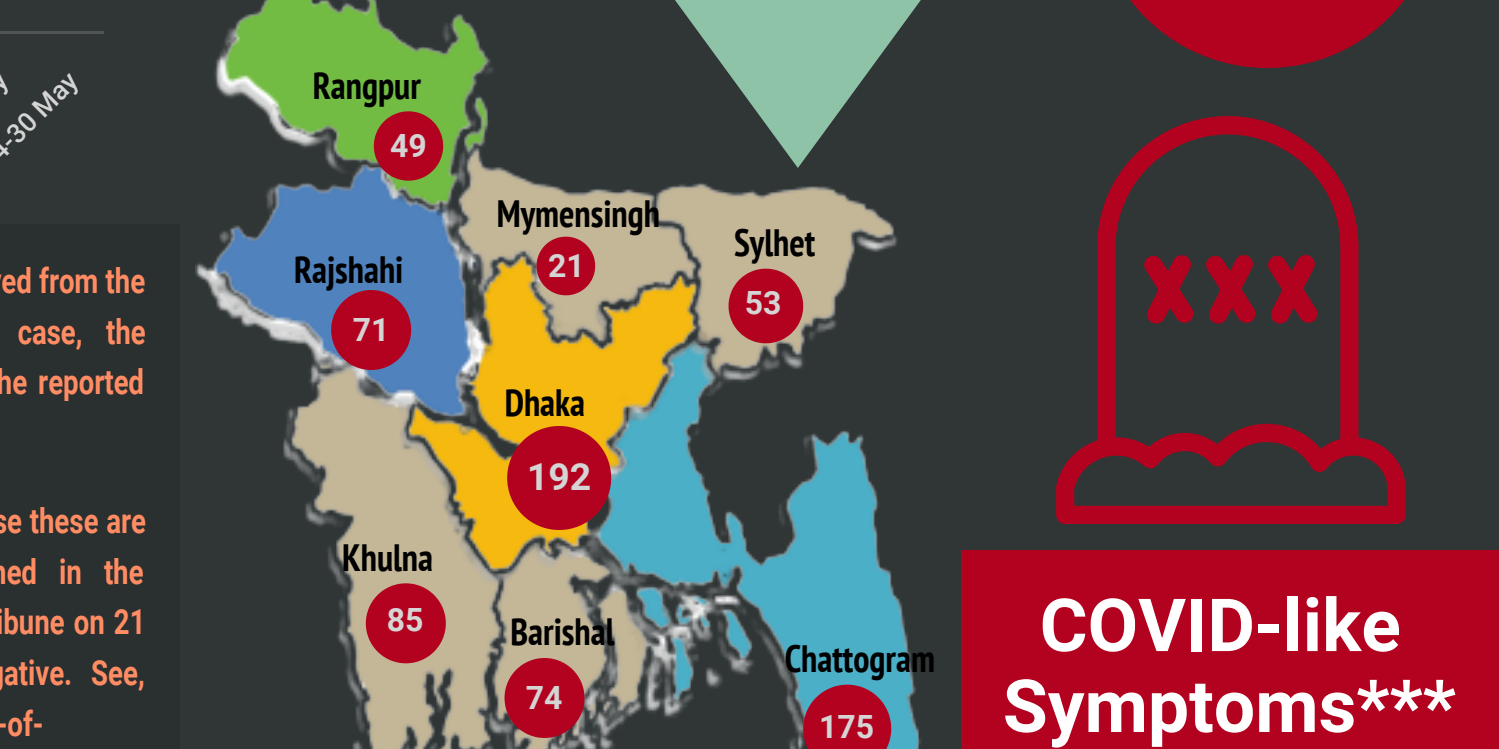


COVID-like Symptoms***

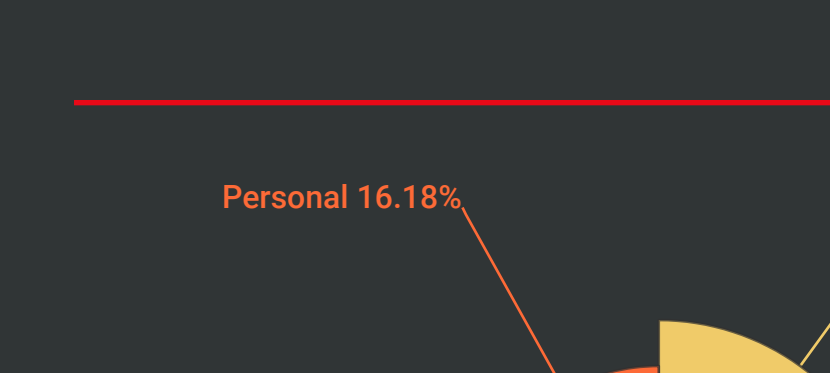

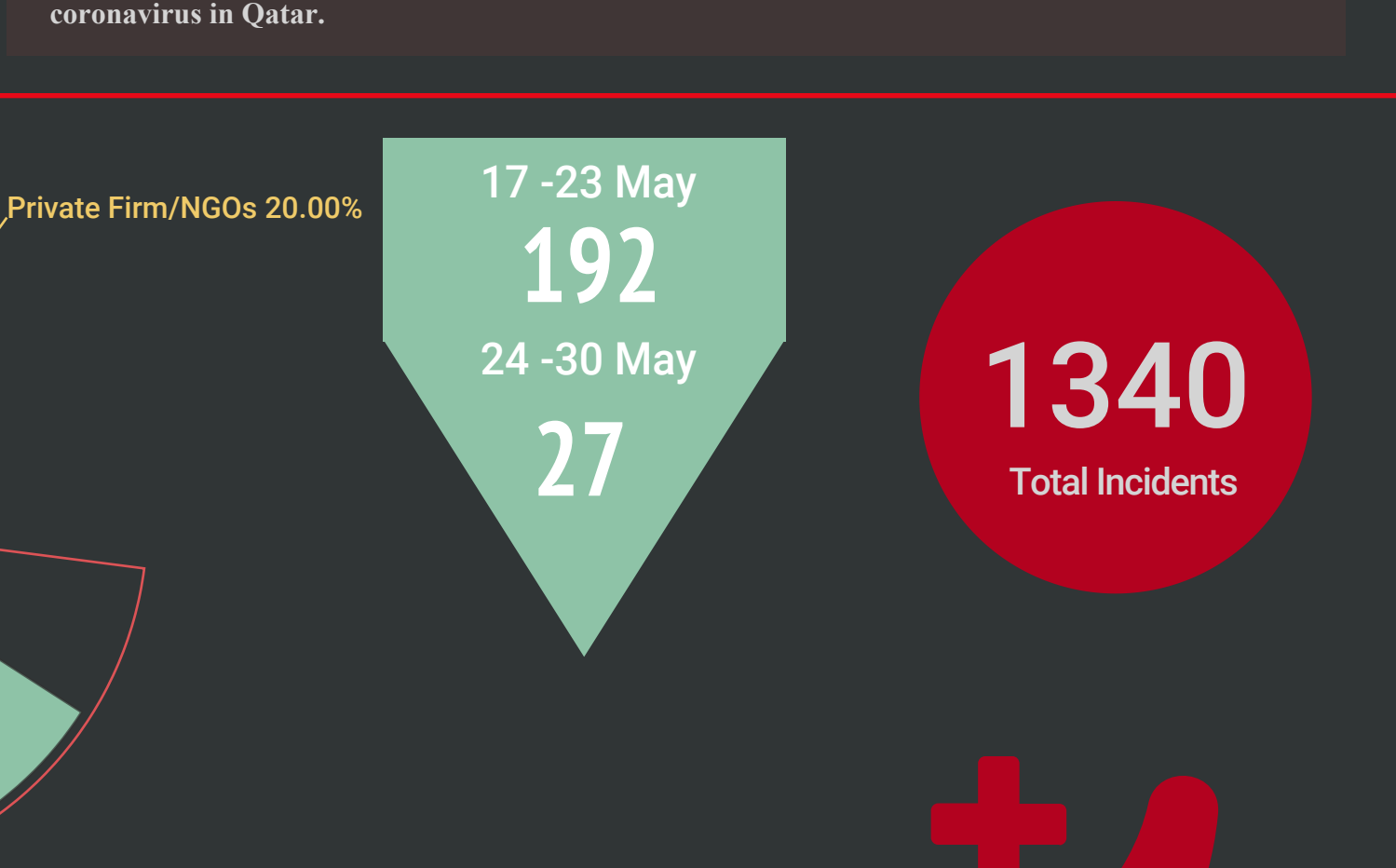

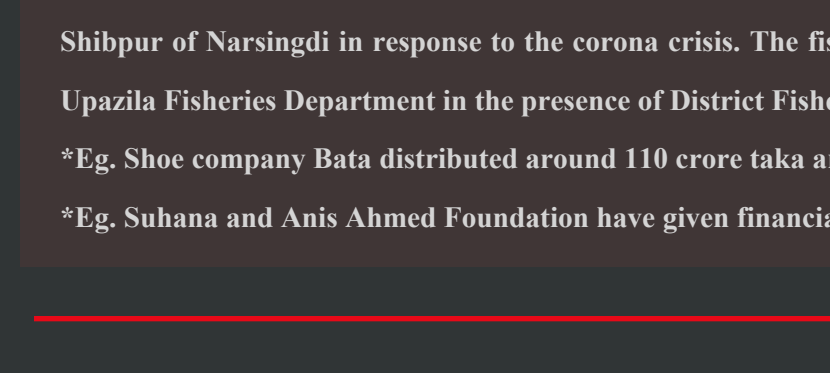

*Eg. Dhaka University Corona Virus Response Technical Team committee informed that they completed sequencing five Genom of COVID-19 examined in the lab of the university 'Centre for Advanced Research in Sciences (CARSS)' which is also approved by Global Initiative on Sharing All Influenza Data (GISAID).
*Eg. A fish farmer named Mokhesur Rahman Mollah is distributing fresh fish from his pond among 500 distressed families in Shibpur of Narsingdi in response to the corona crisis. The fish was distributed at noon on Tuesday (May 19) at the initiative of the Upazila Fisheries Department in the presence of District Fisheries Officer Belayet Hossain.
*Eg. Shoe company Bata distributed around 110 crore taka amongst the poor community in different parts of the country.
*Eg. Suhana and Anis Ahmed Foundation have given financial assistance to 2953 CNG drivers across the country.

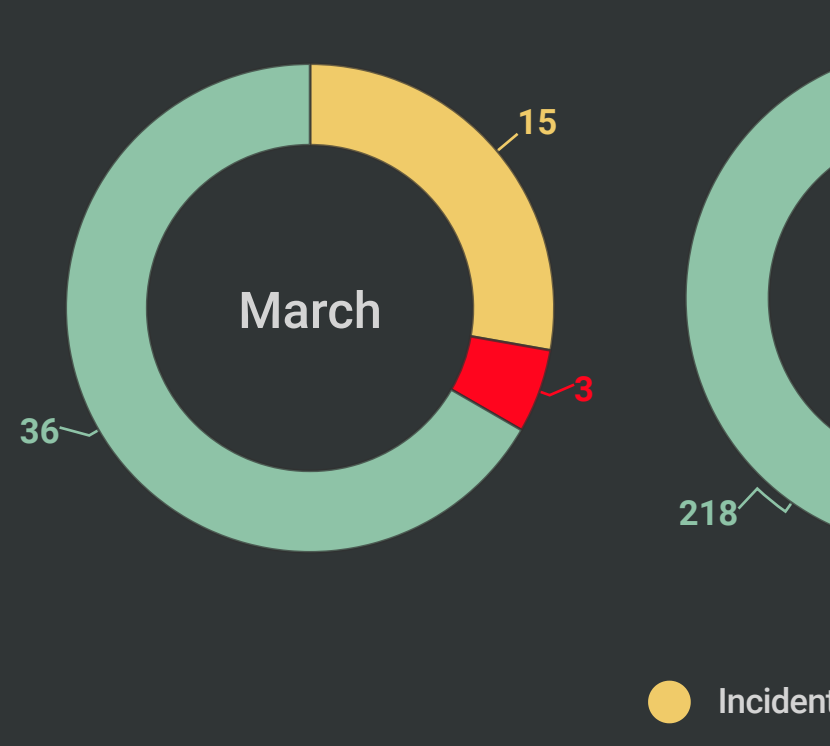
Protests Associated with COVID-19 (26 Apr-16 May)



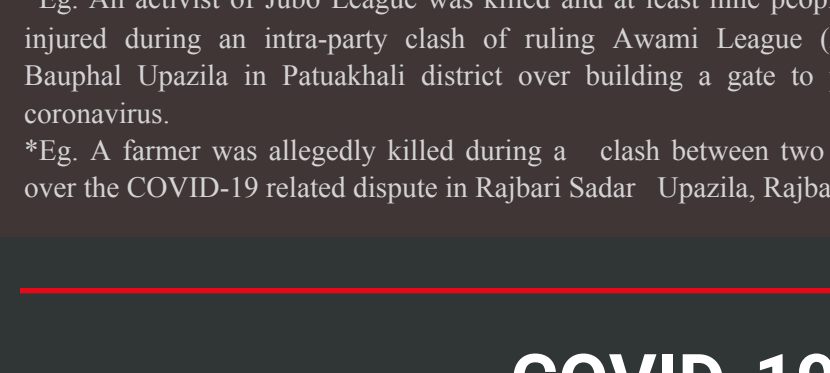

Violent Incident Related with COVID-19 (1 March -30 May 2020)



*Eg. In Cumilla, a man told his two nieces to stay quarantined at home as they have recently back from Dhaka. Two nieces and their father got agitated, scolded him, and an altercation began over the matter. At one point, The father of the two Dhaka-returnee boys along with his sons and others randomly beat and injured his younger brother. Later, the victim was rescued but the doctor declared him dead. Police arrested six people in this connection.
*Eg. An activist of Jubo League was killed and at least nine people were injured during an intra-party clash of ruling Awami League (AL) at Banghal Upazila in Pataukhali district over building a gate to prevent coronavirus.
*Eg. A farmer was allegedly killed during a clash between two groups over the COVID-19 related dispute in Rajbari Sadar Upazila, Rajbari.



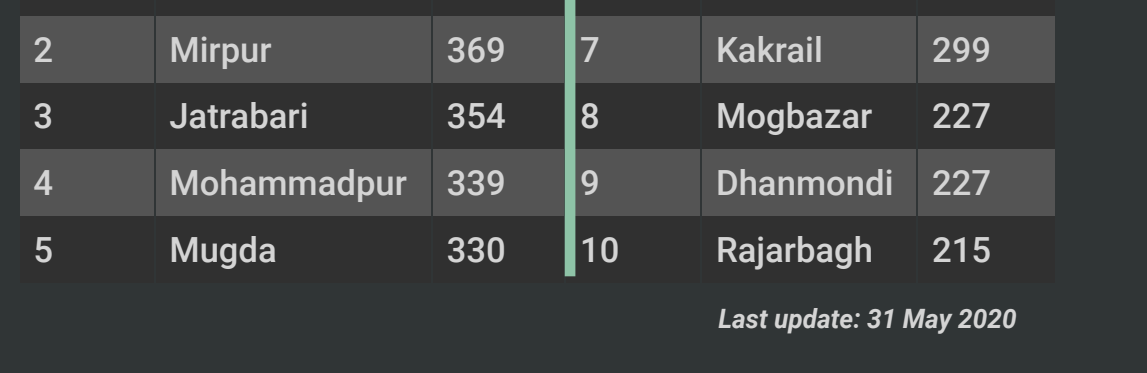
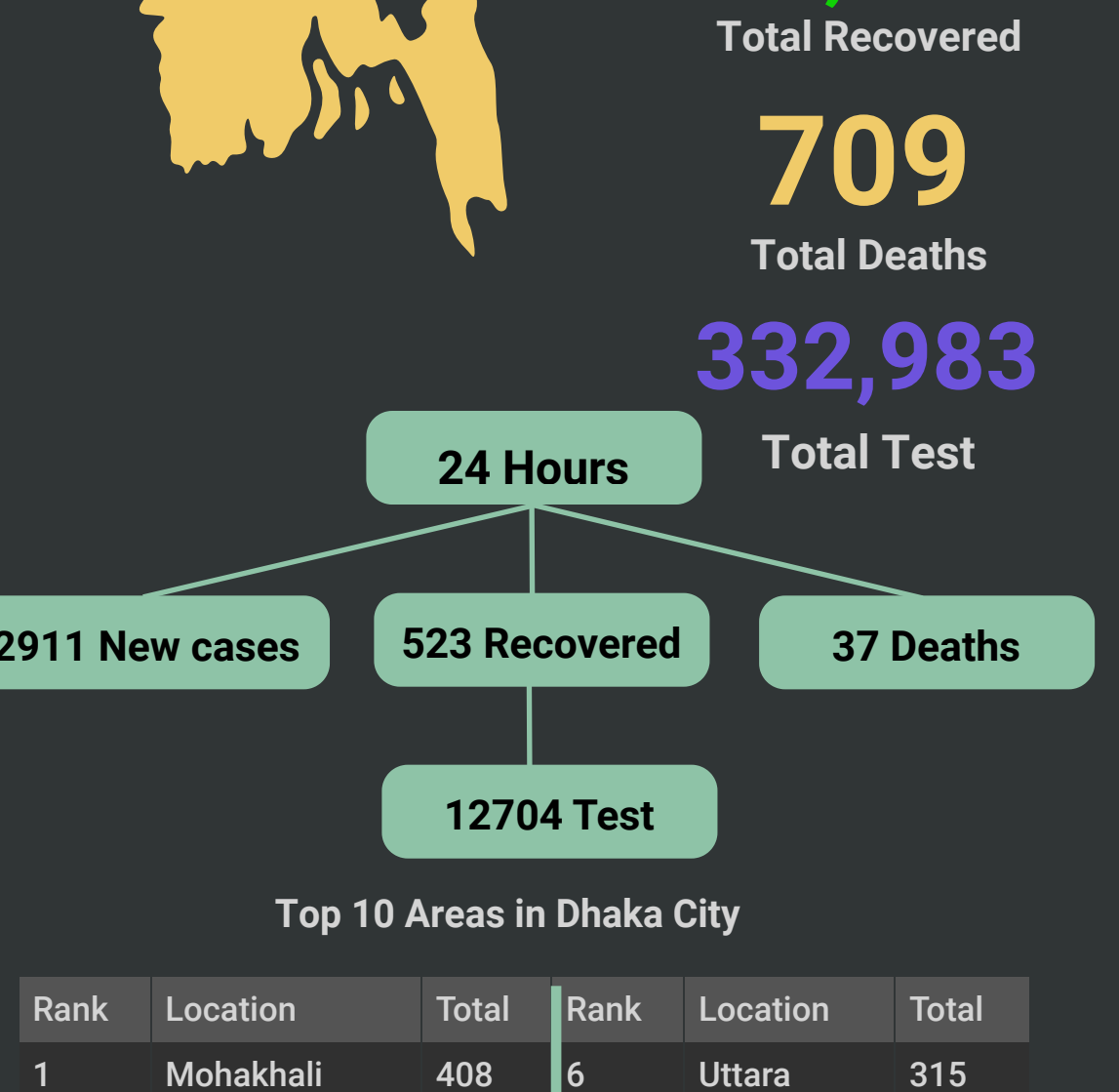

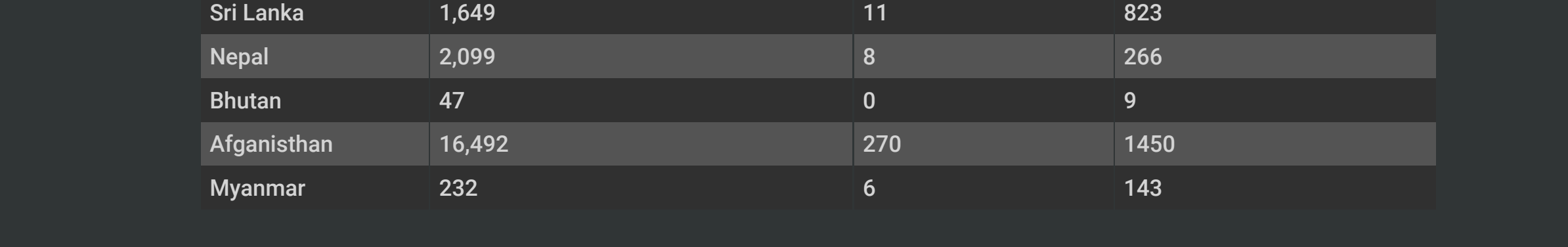
