WASH

Wash your hands frequently using soap for at least 20 seconds or sanitise them using alcohol-based handrub.



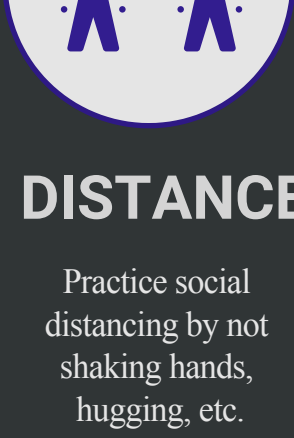
COVER

ISOLATE

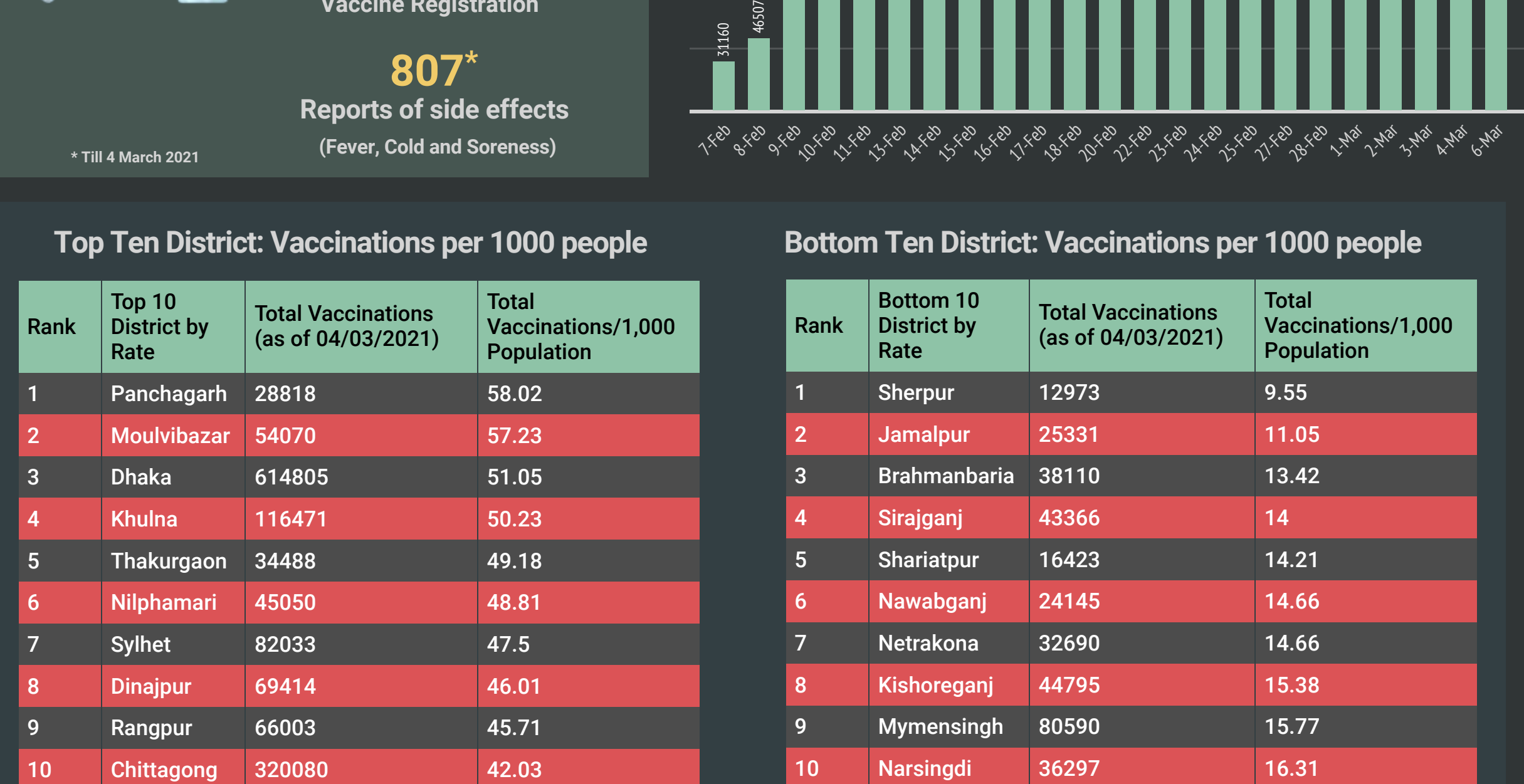
Stay at home if you become ill and help prevent its spread.

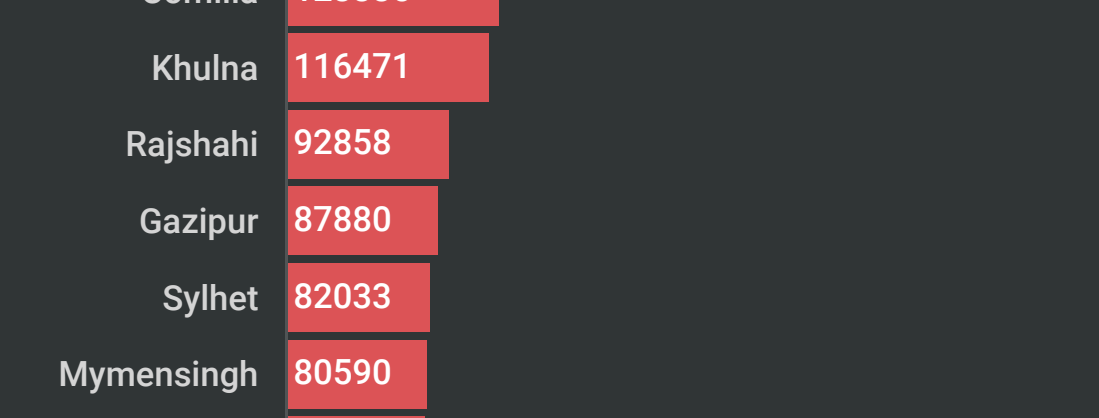

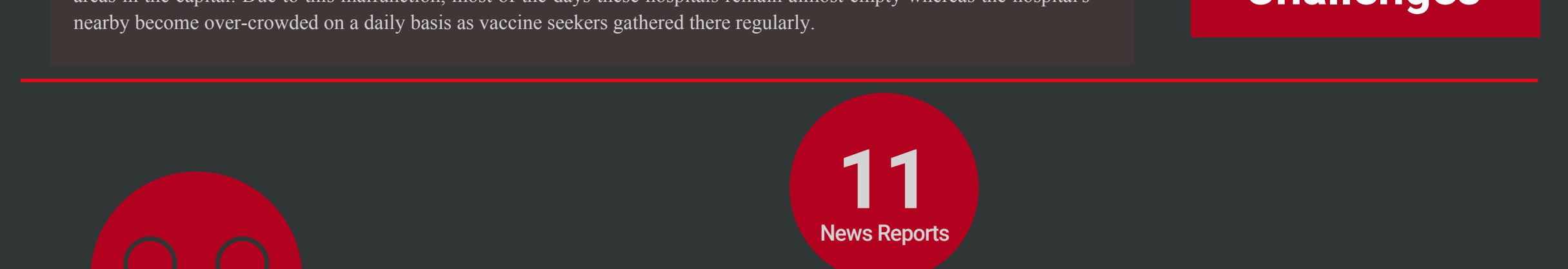
There are 60 news reports associated with the COVID-19 vaccine roll-out from 14 February to 27 February 2021. Health Minister Zahid Maleque said that the second dose of Covid-19 vaccine would be administered from 7 April. A total of 40,37,361 people have so far been registered to receive COVID-19 vaccines as the vaccination campaign was launched on 27 January. Bangladesh has ranked 15th in the list of countries with the most number of people vaccinated against Covid-19 from 1 January till 21 February 2021.



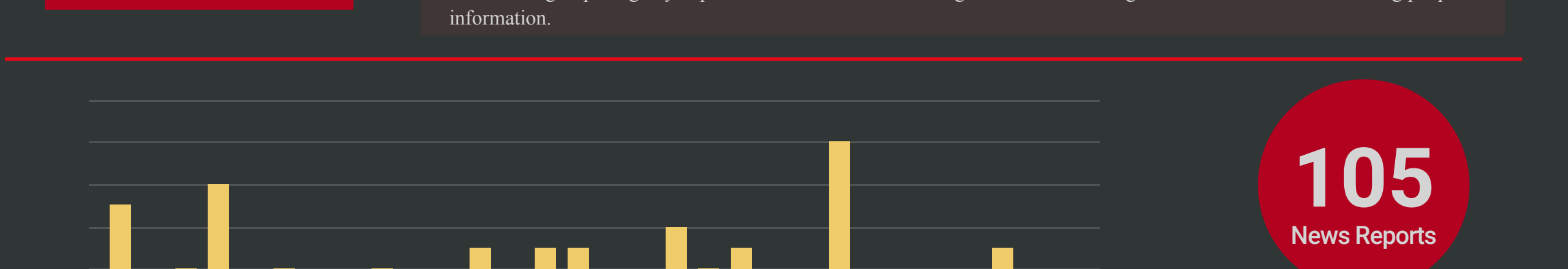
Eleven news reports regarding the COVID-19 vaccination challenges, including online registration problems, enthusiasm gap, mismanagement, underfunding infrastructure, etc., were mapped from 14 February to 27 February 2021. Corona vaccination activities will be carried out in the future subject to the availability of the vaccine. Health Minister Zahid Malek said there was a shortage of vaccines compared to demand. Even if three crore vaccines are available, 1.5 crore people can be vaccinated in two doses. Due to the location error of the 'Shurokkha app' two hospital's location have been misplaced in two city corporation areas in the capital. Due to this malfunction, most of the days these hospitals remain almost empty whereas the city's population is nearby become over-crowded on a daily basis as vaccine seekers gathered there regularly.



Seven news report associated with fear related to the COVID-19 vaccine were reported from 14 February to 27 February 2021. One of the high ranking civil servant of the government has been infected with COVID-19, a week after he received the first dose of the vaccine in the capital. A health worker of Sir Salimullah Medical College and Mitford Hospital in the capital Dhaka named Sajjad Hossain was infected with COVID 19 even after being vaccinated. He was vaccinated on 8th February and got his corona positive report on Tuesday after 16 days of the vaccination. A hacker group allegedly copied the COVID-19 distributing website of the Bangladesh Government and stealing people's information.

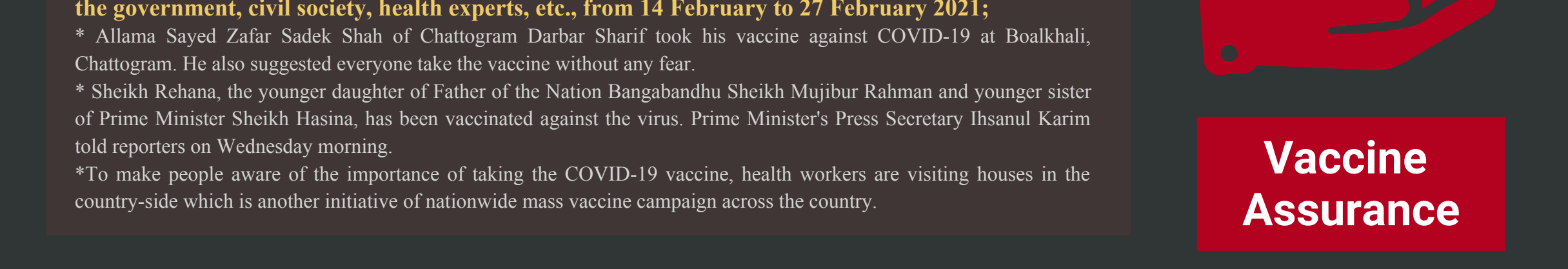


There are 36 news reports of COVID-19 vaccine assurance from different stakeholders, including the government, civil society, health experts, etc., from 14 February to 27 February 2021. Allama Sayed Zafar Sadek Shah of Chattogram Darbar Sharif told his vaccine against COVID-19 at Boalkhali, Chattogram. He also suggested everyone take the vaccine without any fear. Sheikh Rehana, the younger daughter of Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman and younger sister of Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina, has been vaccinated against the virus. Prime Minister's Press Secretary Ihsanul Karim told reporters on Wednesday morning. To make people aware of the importance of taking the COVID-19 vaccine, health workers are visiting houses in the country-side which is another initiative of nationwide mass vaccine campaign across the country.



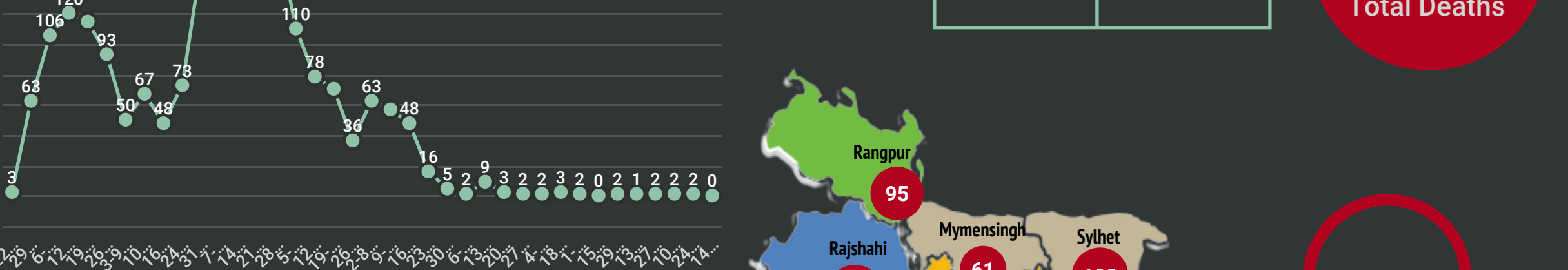

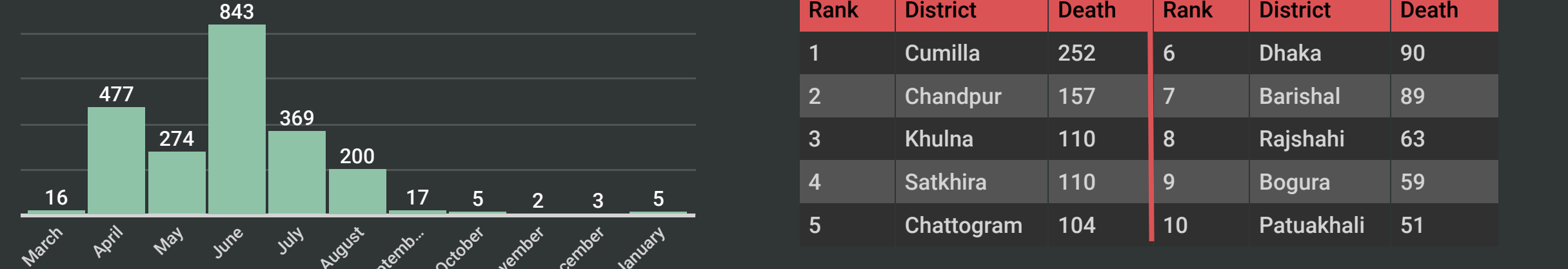

Report on Fear related to COVID-19 (30 May 20 - 27 February 21)

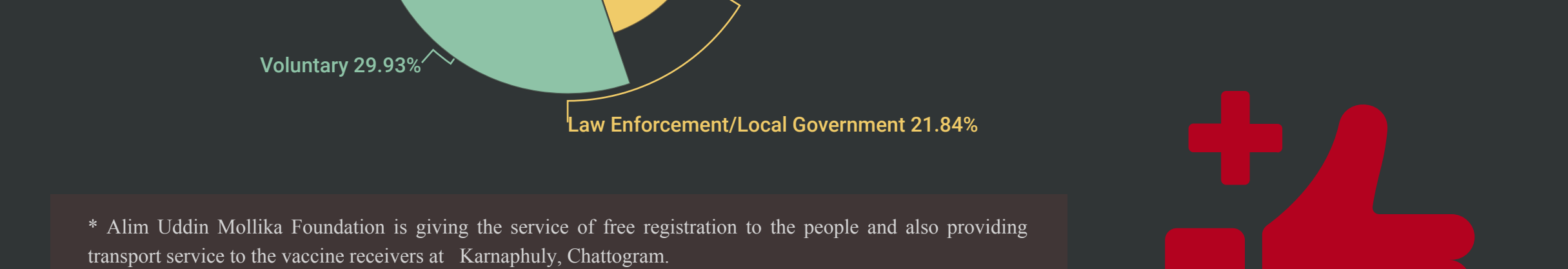
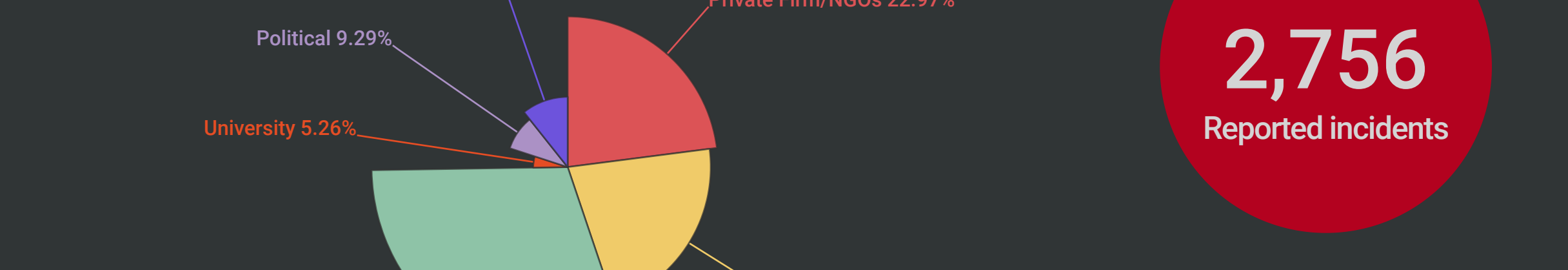
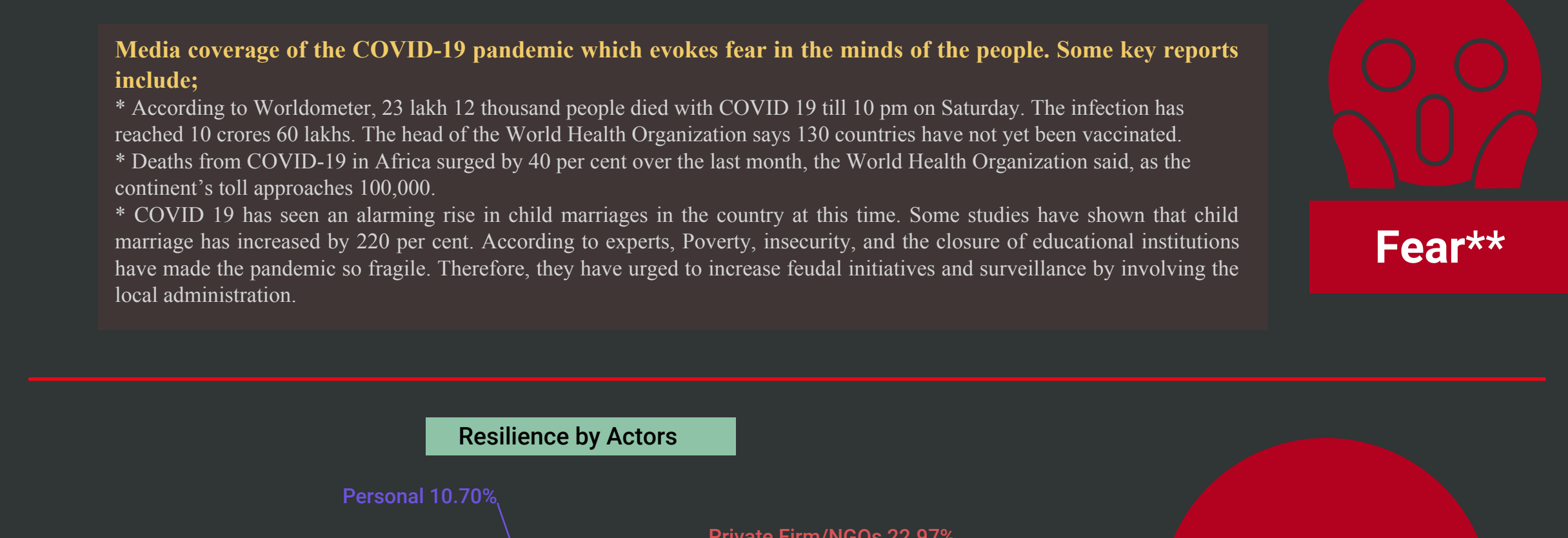
Media coverage of the COVID-19 pandemic which evokes fear in the minds of the people. Some key reports included: According to Worldometer, 23 lakh 12 thousand people died with COVID 19 till 10 pm on Saturday. The infection has reached 10 crores 60 lakhs. The head of the World Health Organization says 130 countries have not yet been vaccinated. Deaths from COVID-19 in Africa surged by 40 per cent over the last month, the World Health Organization said, as the continent's toll approaches 100,000. COVID 19 has seen an alarming rise in child marriages in the country at this time. Some studies have shown that child marriage has increased by 220 per cent. According to experts, Poverty, insecurity, and the closure of educational institutions have made the pandemic so fragile. Therefore, they have urged to increase feudal initiatives and surveillance by involving the local administration.



Alim Uddin Mollika Foundation is giving the service of free registration to the people and also providing transport service to the vaccine receivers at Kamaphuly, Chattogram. Despite being a developing country, Bangladesh has managed to secure the 17th position in the list of countries with the most number of people vaccinated for Covid-19. The country achieved the feat in under a month as the nationwide inoculation program was launched on 7 February while countries like the UK, the first country to launch the Covid-19 vaccination program in the world, began in early December. A group of youth formed the "Antahien Foundation" and gave uninterrupted service of collecting corona samples from the beginning of the pandemic at Chattogram district. A local Bangladesh Chattro League leader started a campaign of free registration for the COVID-19 vaccine at Cox's Bazar district. The National Gender (NBR) has decided to withdraw advance income tax on importing all types of vaccines for human use. The company has taken this decision in response to the request of the Department of Health.
