COVID-19 Prevention Tips



WASH

Wash your hands frequently using soap for at least 20 seconds or sanitise them using alcohol-based handrub.



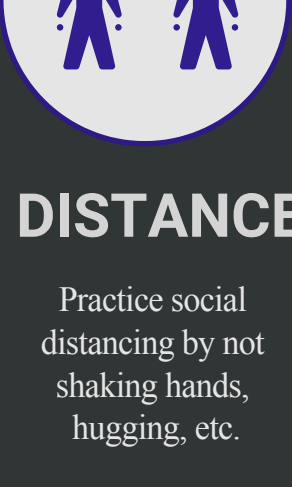
COVER

Practice social distancing by not shaking hands, hugging, etc.



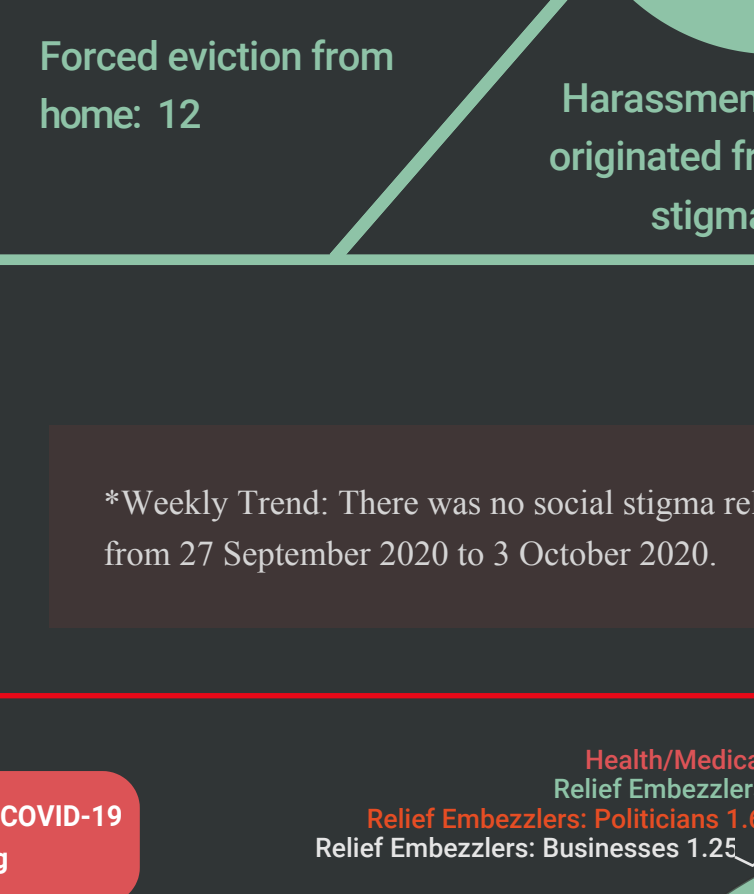
ISOLATE

Covid-19 Related Incident Mapping in Bangladesh

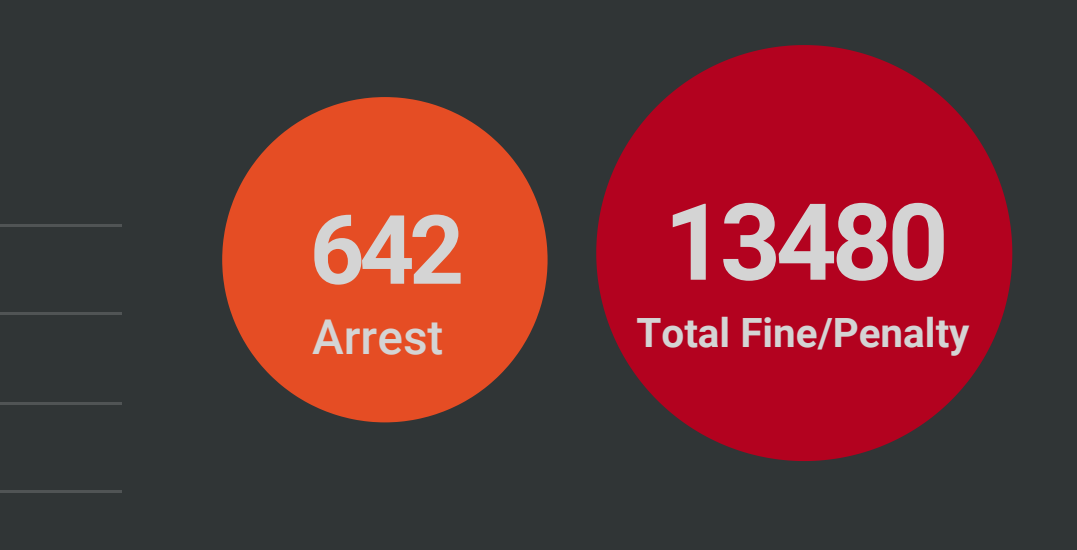
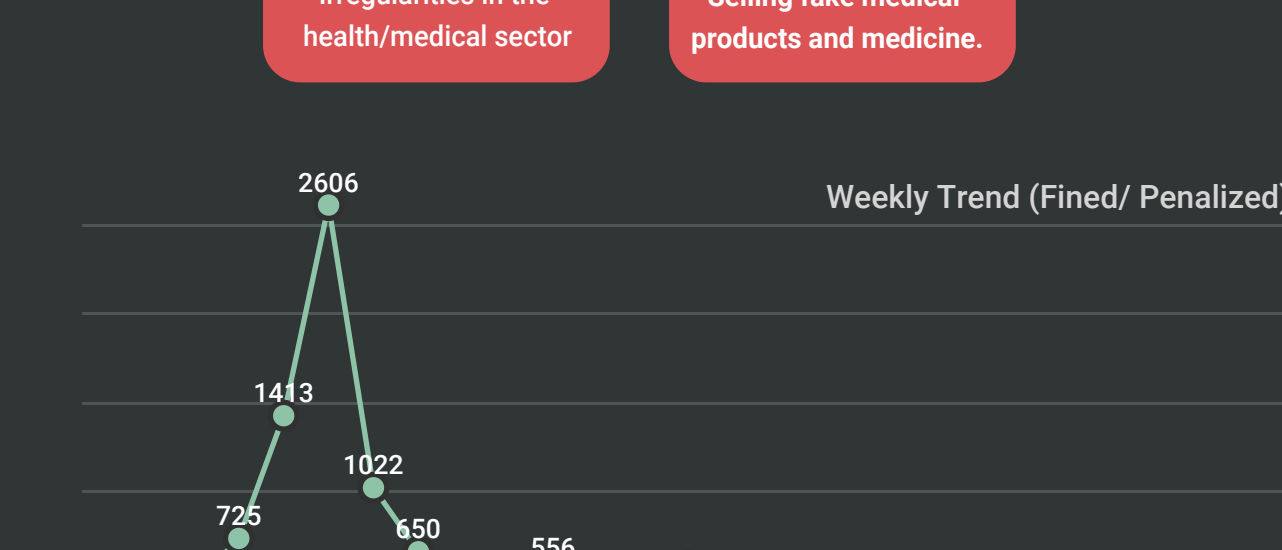

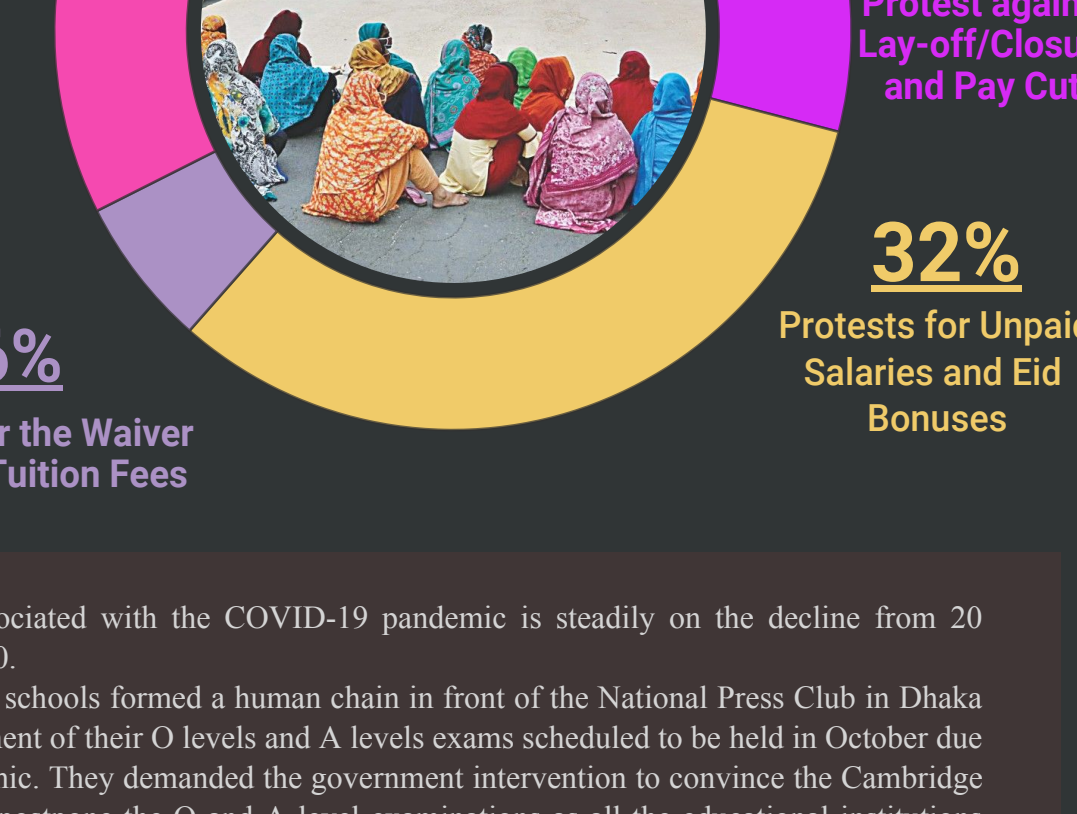

Protests Associated with COVID-19 (26 April -3 October)

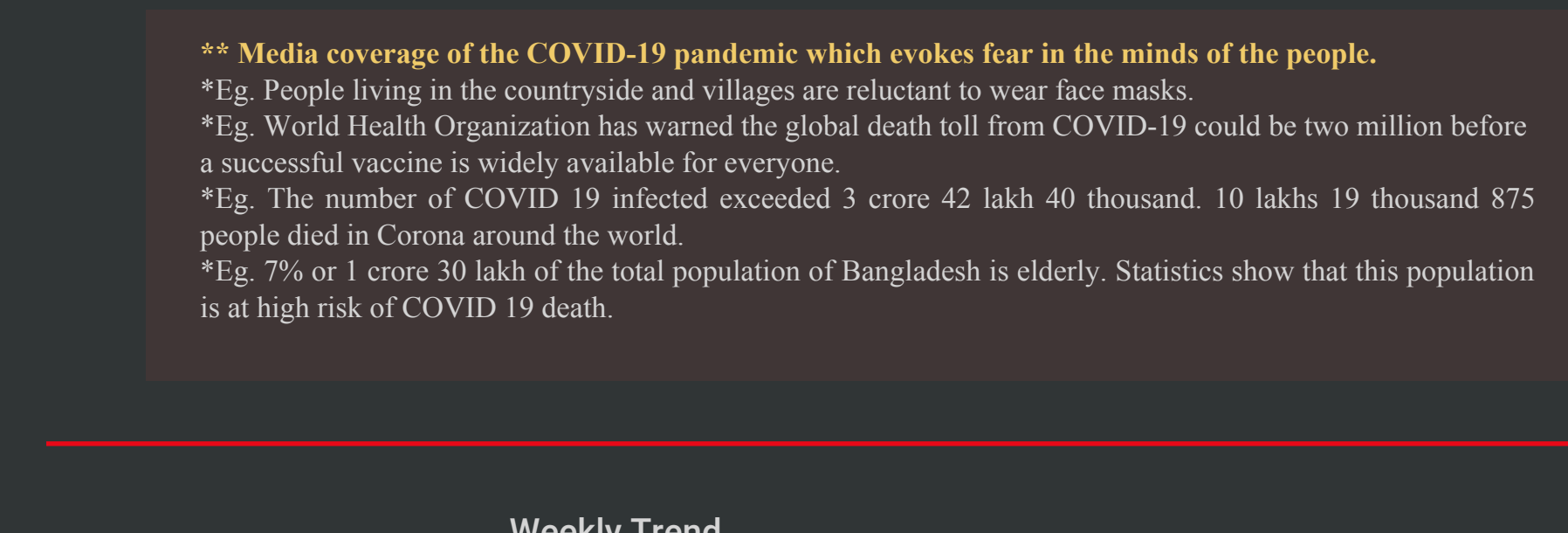

*Weekly Trend: Protests (5) associated with the COVID-19 pandemic is steadily on the decline from 20 September 2020 to 3 October 2020.
*Eg. Students of English medium schools formed a human chain in front of the National Press Club in Dhaka on Sunday, demanding postponement of their O levels and A levels exams scheduled to be held in October due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. They demanded the government intervention to convince the Cambridge and Edexcel education boards to postpone the O and A level examinations as all the educational institutions across Bangladesh remained closed due to the pandemic.
*Eg. Jatiya Chattro Shomaj, Chawkbazar, Chattogram did a possession and demanded to the government for forgiving the tuition fee during the pandemic.
*Eg. Doctors of Kuwait-Bangladesh Government Hospital dedicated to COVID-19 treatment held a sit-in protest at the hospital's Director's office as the authorities of the hotel allocated for their accommodation forced them out on 23 September 2020. Some agitated doctors protested against this and demanded to solve their accommodation immediately.

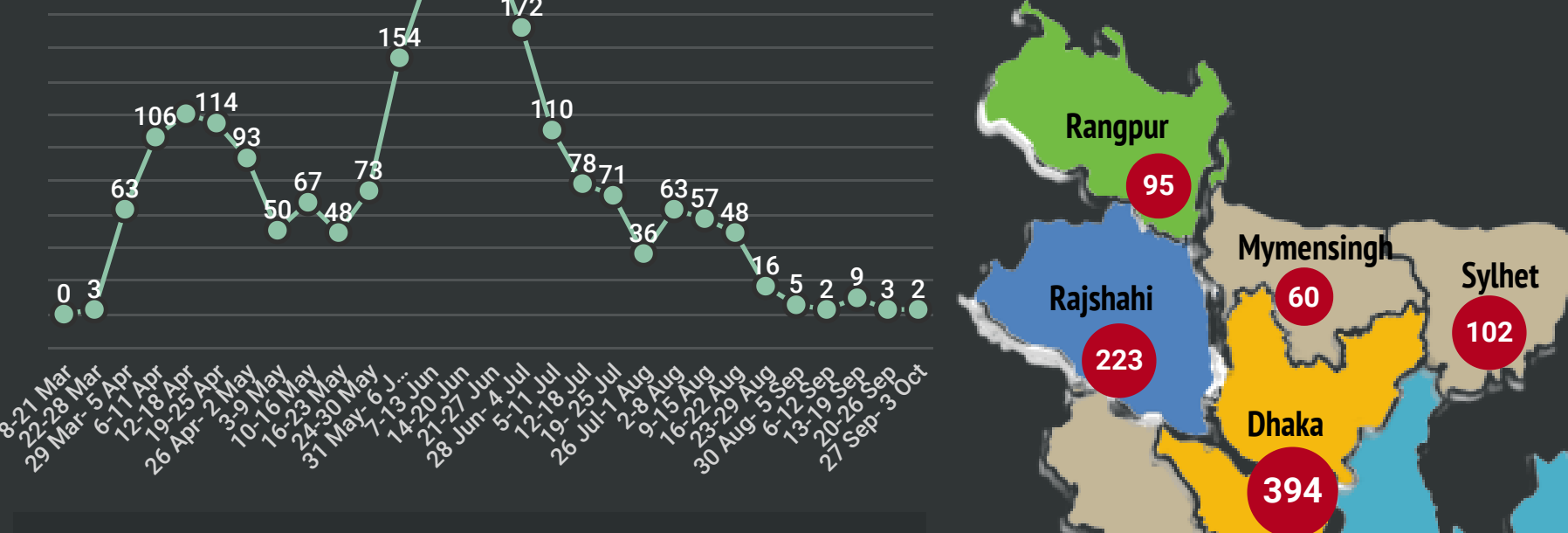

** Media coverage of the COVID-19 pandemic which evokes fear in the minds of the people.
*Eg. People living in the countryside and villages are reluctant to wear face masks.
*Eg. World Health Organization has warned the global death toll from COVID-19 could be two million before a successful vaccine is widely available for everyone.
*Eg. The number of COVID 19 infected exceeded 3 crore 42 lakh 40 thousand. 10 lakhs 19 thousand 875 people died in Corona around the world.
*Eg. 7% or 1 crore 30 lakh of the total population of Bangladesh is elderly. Statistics show that this population is at high risk of COVID 19 death.

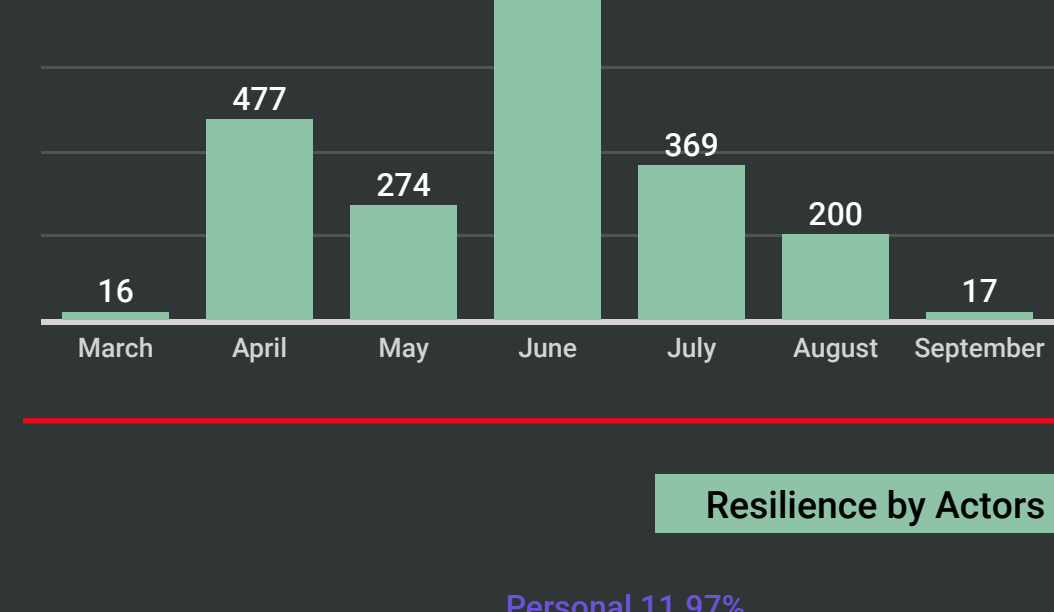

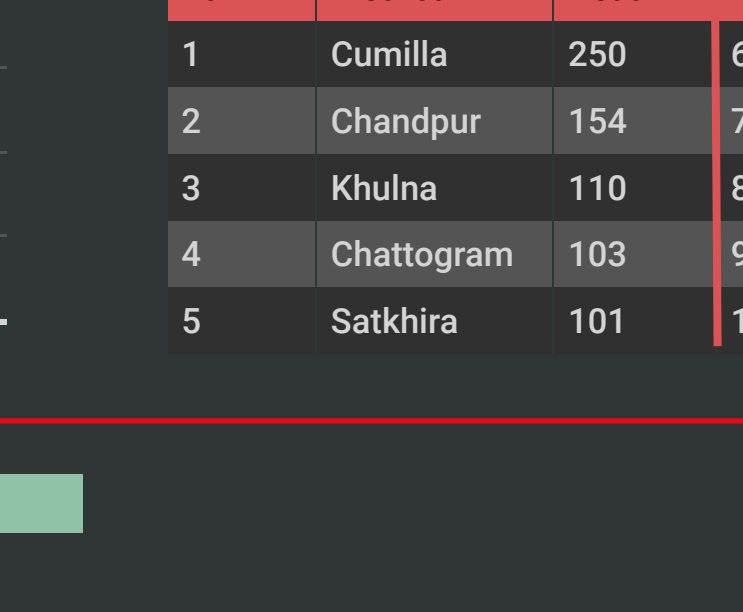


** Media coverage of someone's mental condition related to the COVID-19 pandemic.
*A man, Jaded Hasan (48), allegedly tried to commit suicide after stabbing his two children in Hazaribag, Dhaka. Later they were taken to Dhaka Medical College Hospital where his six-year-old girl died. Relatives said, due to the pandemic Jaded was going through an extreme financial crisis as his business closed down. And over this depression, he took this attempt. His wife was also injured in this incident.

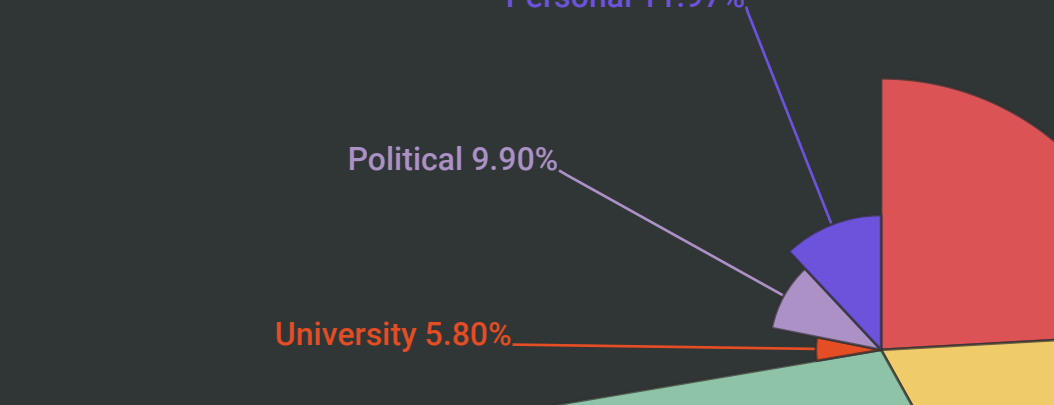
COVID-like Symptoms***

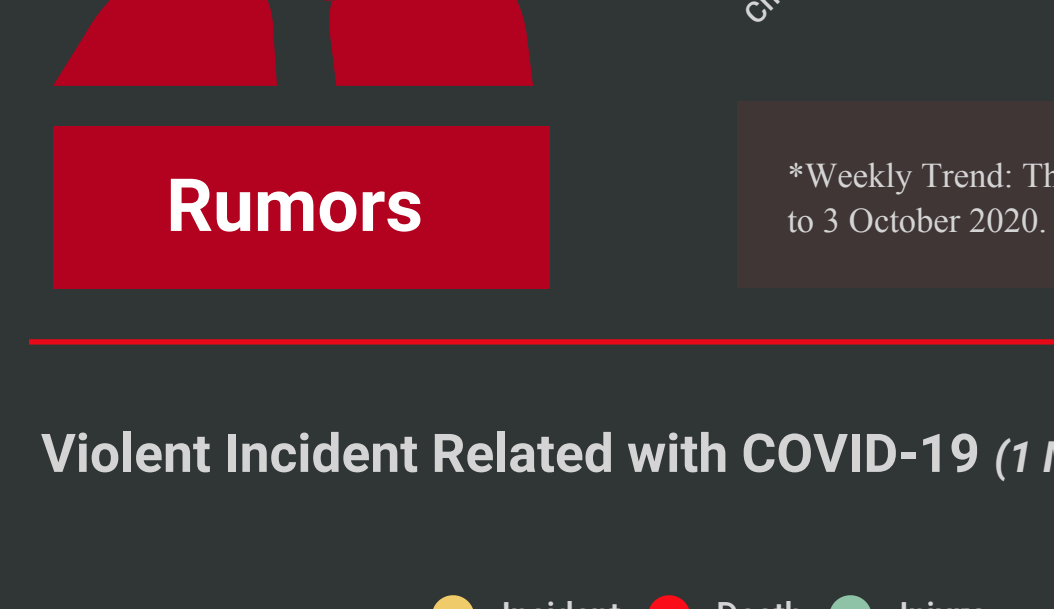

*Eg. The Asian Development Bank has granted Bangladesh \$3 million for the procurement of the COVID-19 vaccine and emergency medical equipment.
*Eg. A new COVID-19 testing lab has been launched at Madaripur Sadar Upazila Madaripur.
*Eg. A tenth-grader schoolgirl of Gauripur Pilot School has distributed food almost every day among 19 poor families at her localities during this pandemic.
*Eg. An organization named ADDS distributed face mask to the people at Halishahar, Chattogram.
*Eg. A poor girl of Khulna named Aakhi has achieved the 'Real-Life Hero' award from the United Nations because of her contribution during this corona pandemic. She had distributed her hand-made masks to the poor rickshaw pullers and day laborers amid this pandemic in Rupsha, Khulna.

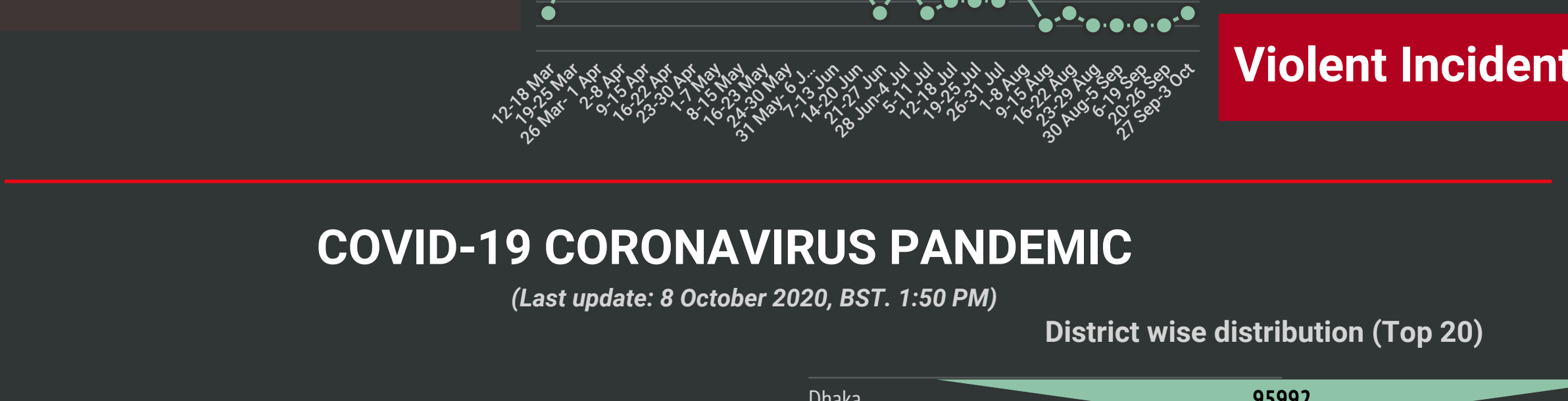

Violent Incident Related with COVID-19 (1 March -3 October 2020)

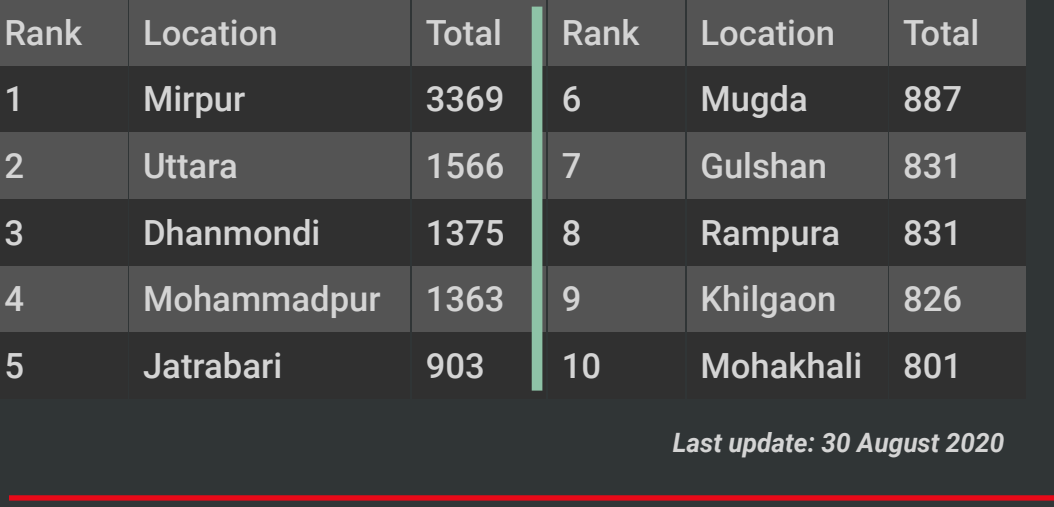

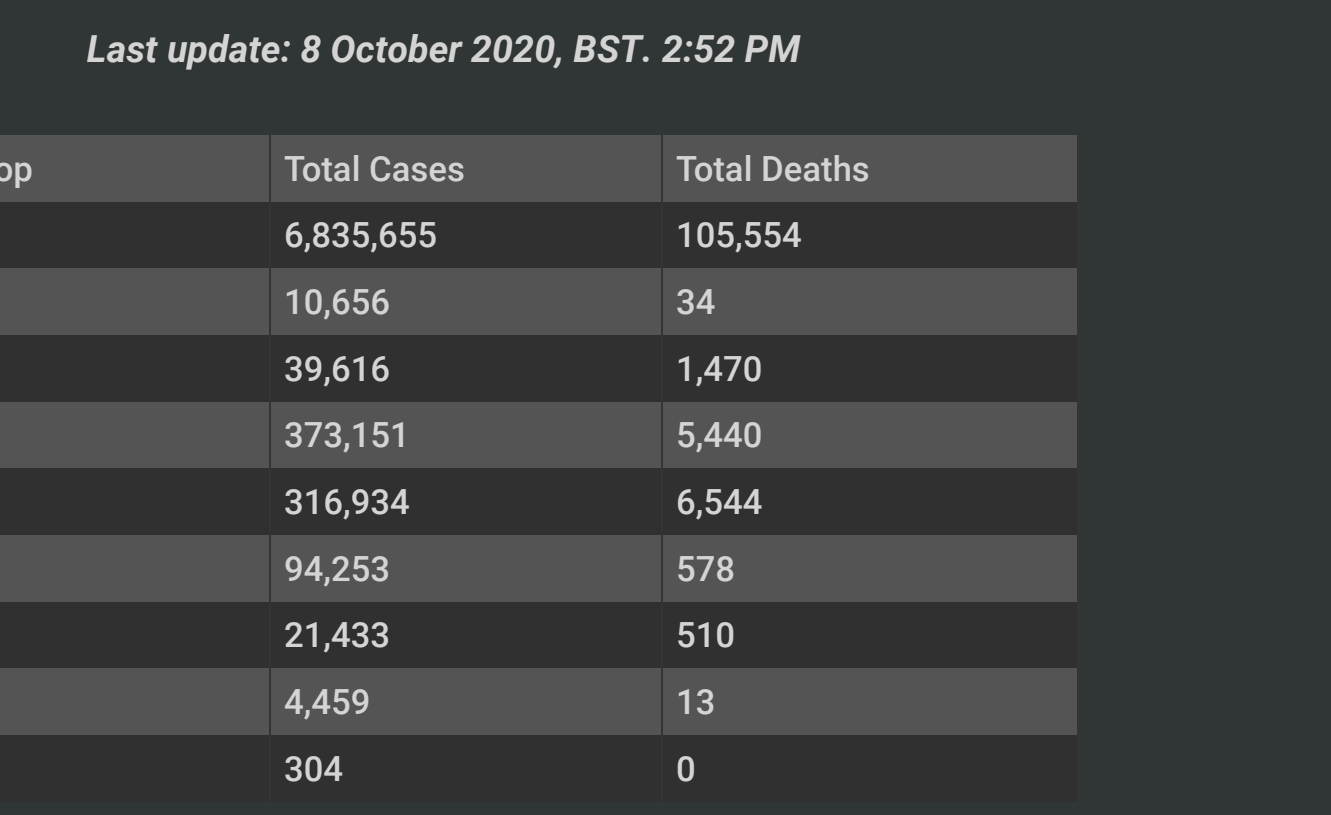
