## COVID-19 Prevention Tips



### WASH

Wash your hands frequently using soap for at least 20 seconds or sanitise them using alcohol-based handrub.



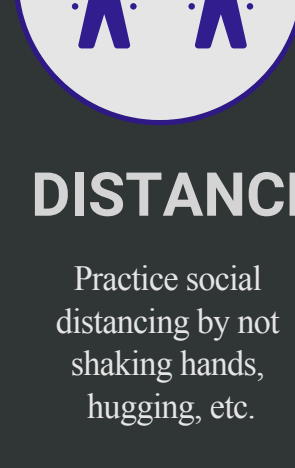
### COVER

## Covid-19 Related Incident Mapping in Bangladesh

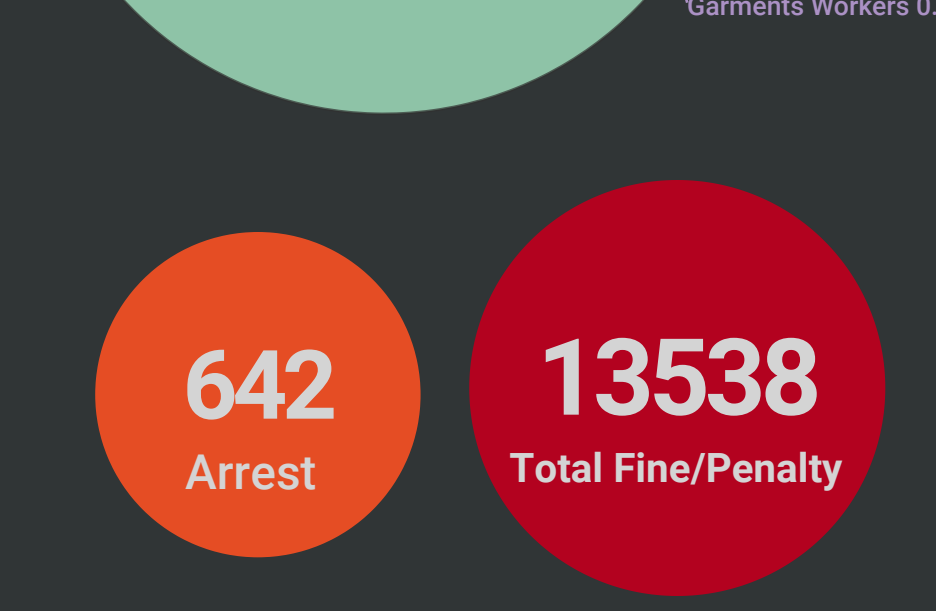
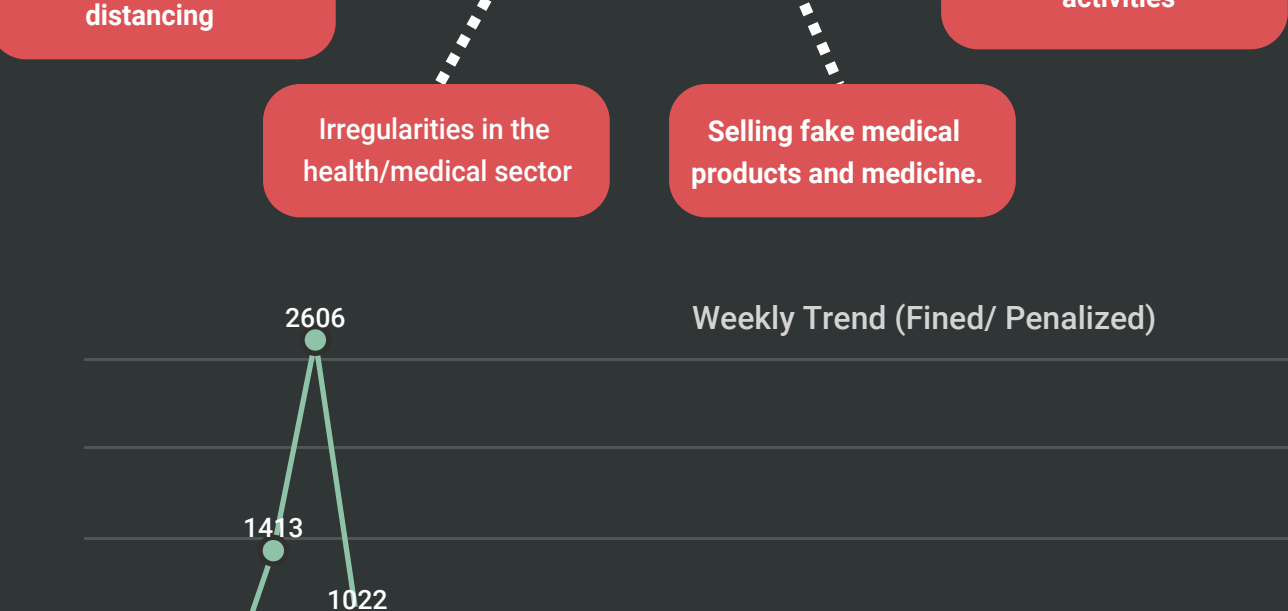

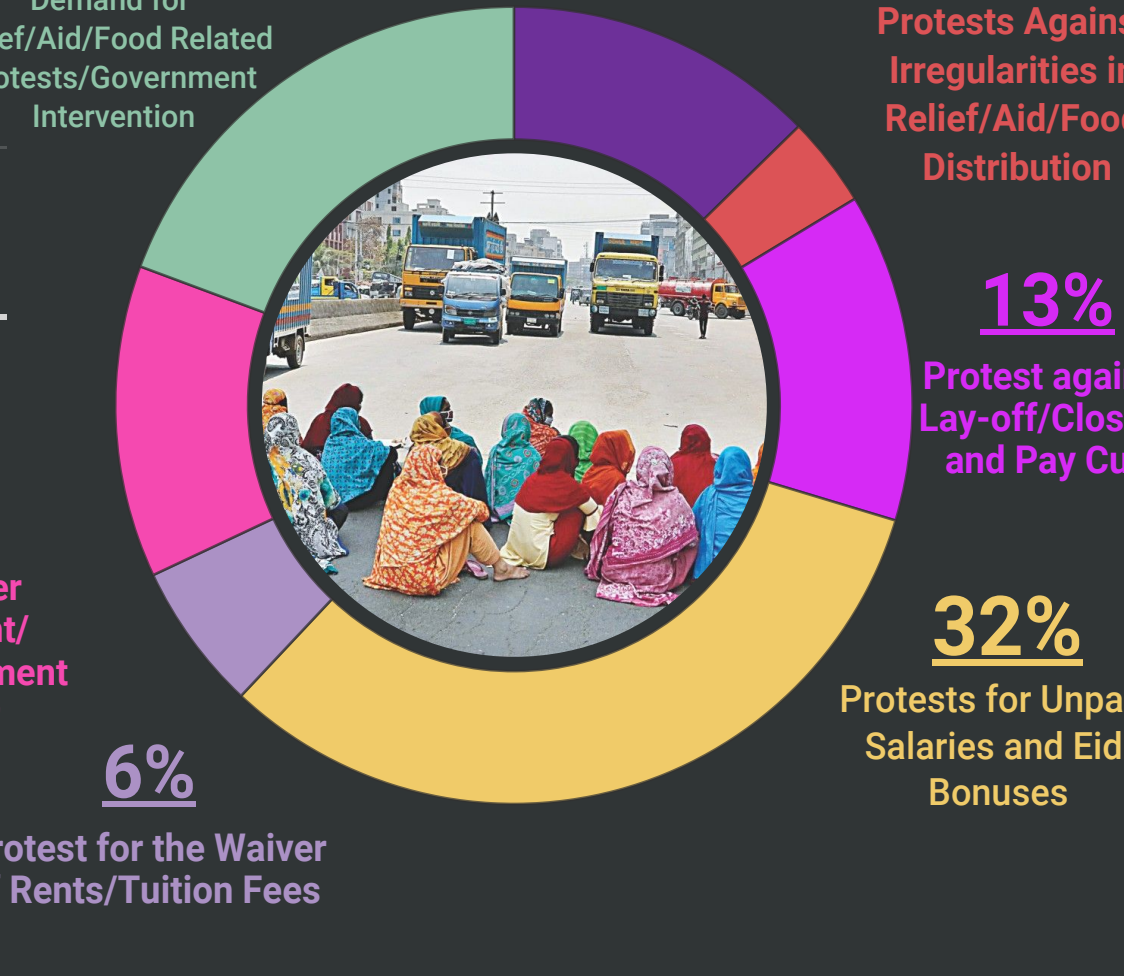

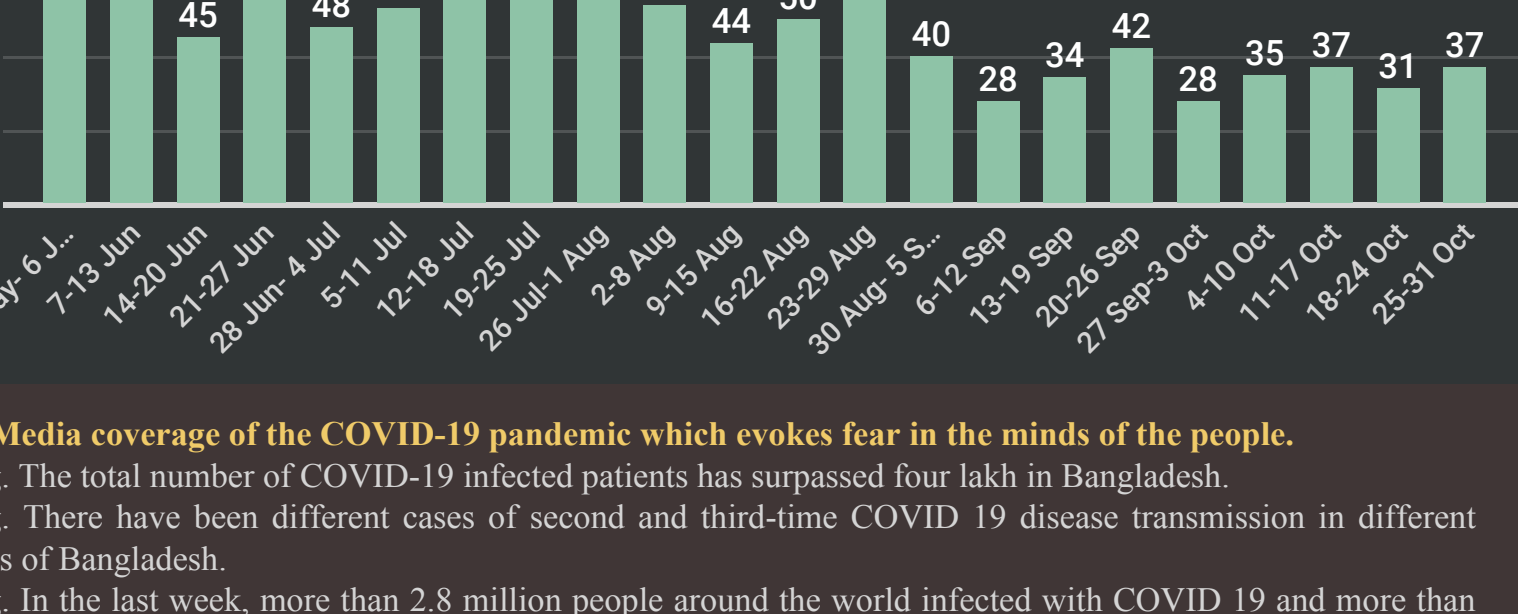


\*Weekly Trend: Protest (1) associated with the COVID-19 pandemic is steadily on the decline from 18 October 2020 to 31 October 2020.

\*Eg. A Left-Wing Party blocked the road and demanded the reopening of the closed 26 state-owned jute mills at Barishal Sadar, Barishal.

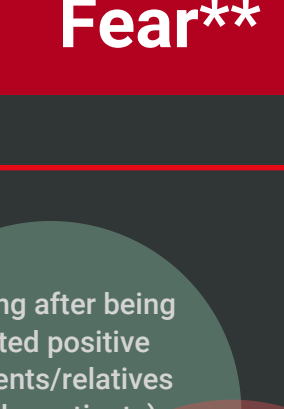

 \*Eg. There have been different cases of second and third-time COVID-19 disease transmission in different parts of Bangladesh.  
 \*Eg. In the last week, more than 2.8 million people around the world infected with COVID-19 and more than 40,000 people died of this disease.  
 \*Eg. Despite falling coronavirus test numbers, Bangladesh is in the second position among the list of worst-affected countries in coronavirus in Asia, stated Reuters, an international news organization.



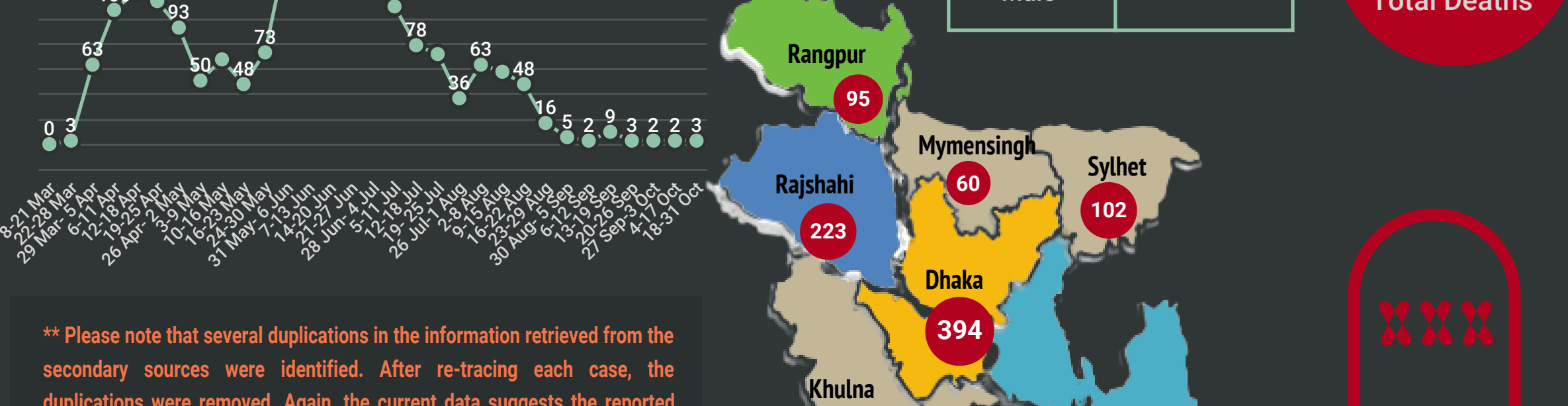

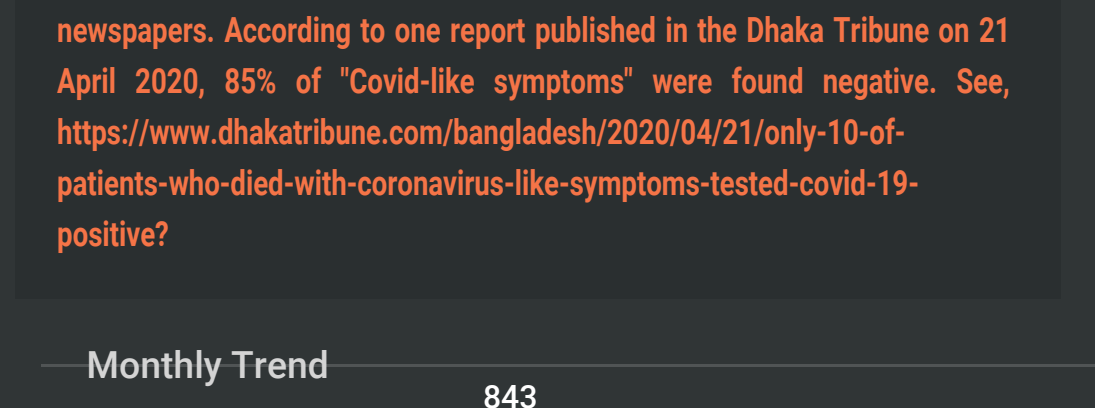

## COVID-like Symptoms\*\*\*

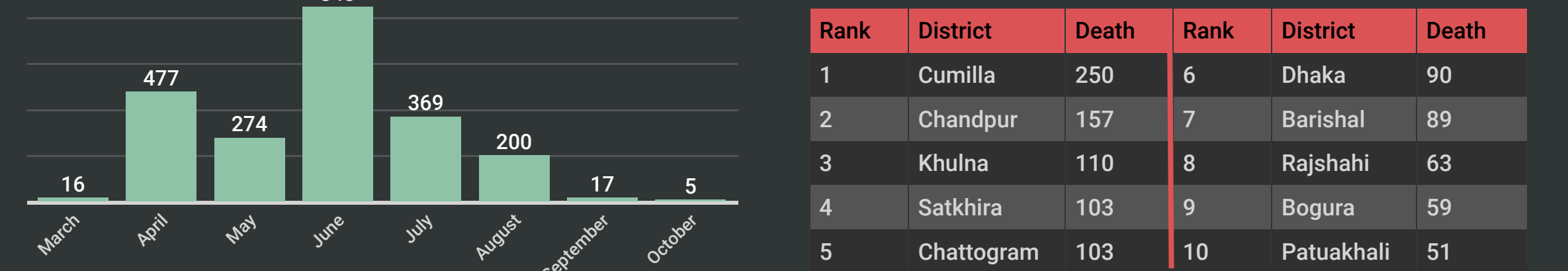

\*Eg. The government has taken a policy that without any mask no one is able to access any services of government or non-government organization. During a cabinet meeting, the cabinet secretary said this.  
 \*Eg. A local Awami League Leader distributed 15,000 masks and cash money among the people in Munshiganj.  
 \*Eg. A social organization, Basma Foundation, distributed food among 2,500 poor families at Sonargaon.  
 \*Eg. The renowned company, LG donated testing kits of coronavirus to ICDDR,b.  
 \*Eg. The Malaysian community in Bangladesh organized a community service project by providing COVID-19 food relief to the Abhinia Kabir Foundation and locals affected by the pandemic.  
 \*Eg. The health ministry allowed 10 privately owned hospitals and diagnostic centers to issue COVID-19 certificates for outbound international passengers and added that all airports, land ports, and seaports are requested to accept the COVID-19 certificate issued by the private RT-PCR labs.

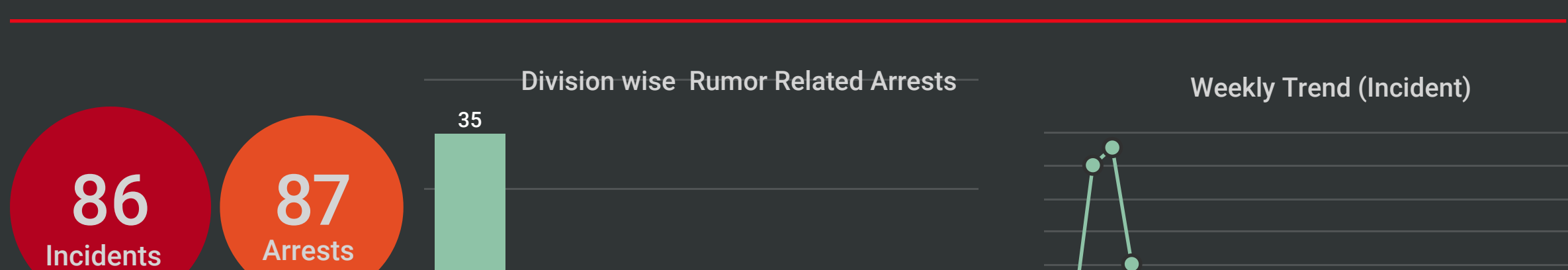

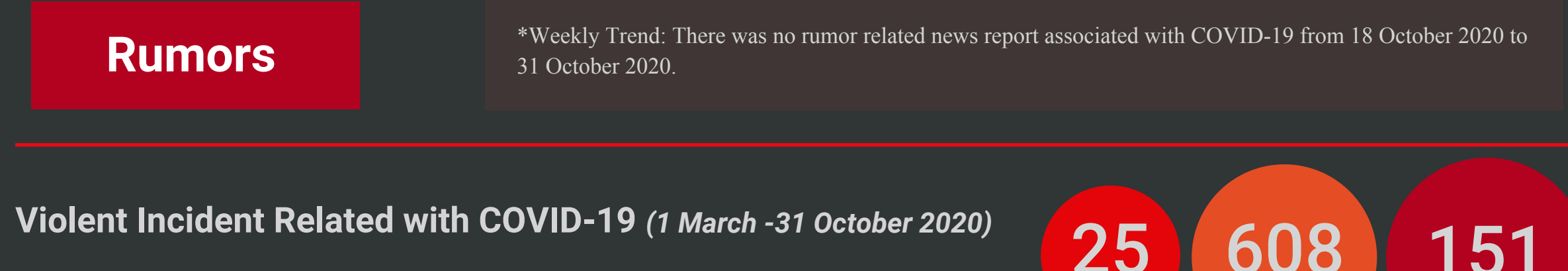
## Violent Incident Related with COVID-19 (1 March - 31 October 2020)
