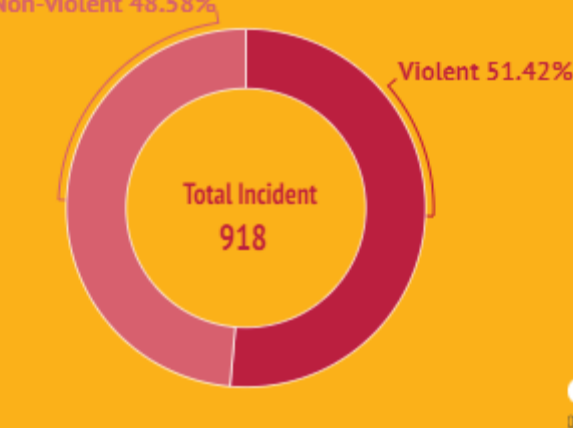


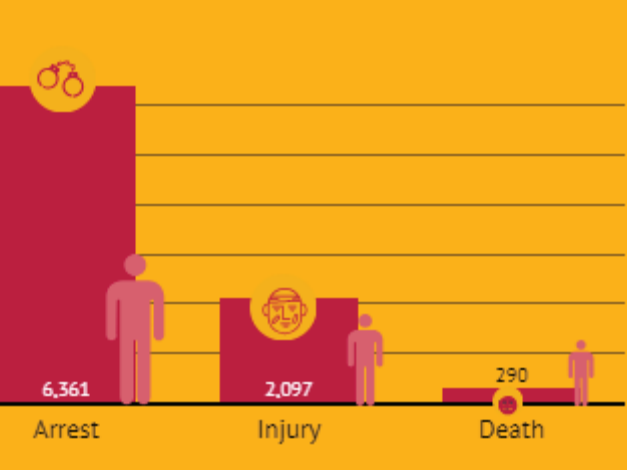
Overview of the conflict incidents in October 2023

Consequences of the conflict incidents in October 2023

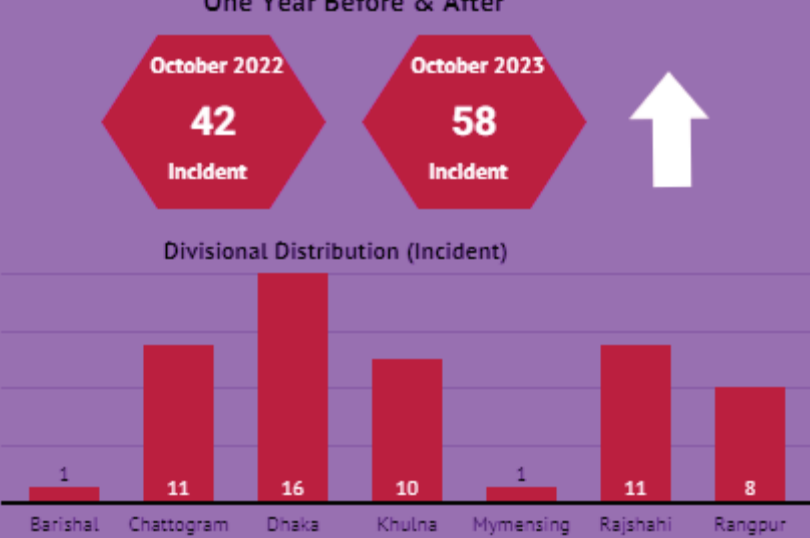
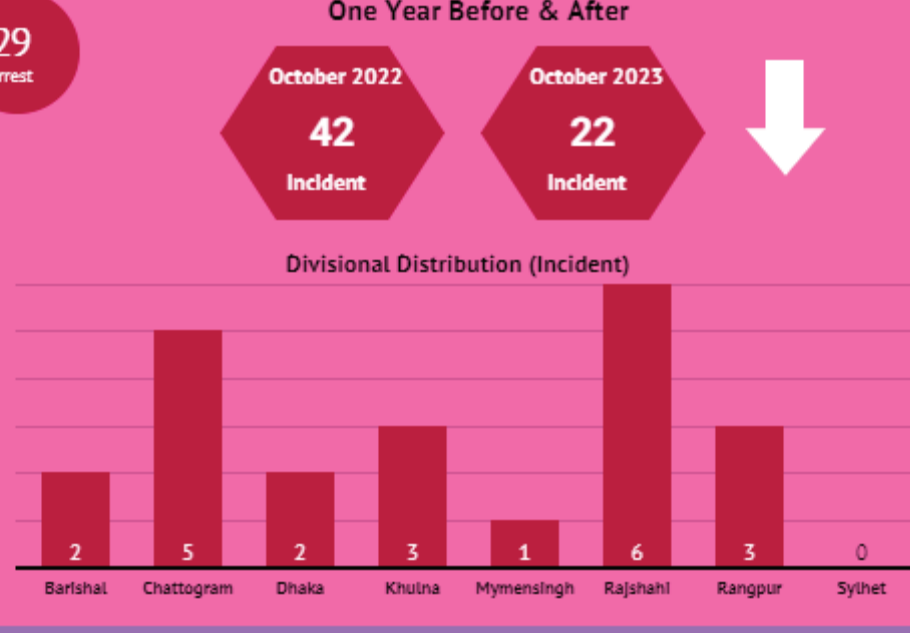


*According to BPO Codebook, "Violent Incidents" are those reported incidents that "involved the intentional use of physical force by an individual or group against another individual or group, in a manner that resulted or could have resulted in death, injury or any other form of physical harm to persons or property." According to BPO Codebook, "Non-violent incidents" are those reported incidents that "did not involve the intentional use of physical force by an individual or group against another individual or group, in a manner that resulted or could have resulted in death, injury or any other form of physical harm to persons or property, e.g. arrest, peaceful protest, rescue, and recovery."

1 Sexual assault

Rajshahi has the highest incident rates*

E.g. A minor girl was abducted and then raped by a youth (Noyan Matbar, 20) and police arrested the accused at Munshiganj.
E.g. A first grader girl was raped by the peon of a primary school and Rapid Action Battalion arrested the accused at Natore.
E.g. A mentally challenged girl was raped by a man and police arrested the accused at Jashore.



Khulna has the highest incident rates*

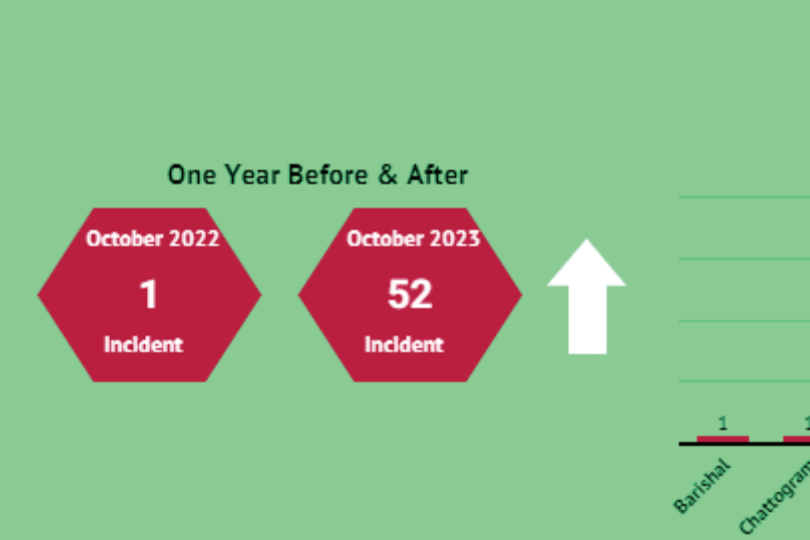
E.g. A man killed his wife due to his extramarital affair in Raouan, Chattogram. the accused husband was arrested.
E.g. A housewife (Romana Akter) was hacked to death by her husband over a trivial issue at Munshiganj. Police arrested two.

3 Political Violence

Dhaka has the highest death rates*

E.g. An Awami League member who was also a Union Parishad member were killed by another Awami League member in Shaikupa, Jhenaidah.
E.g. Fifty individuals were injured in a violent clash between the supporters of the former and present MP, Major General Abdus Salam and Anwarul Abedin, over extending influence in Nandail, Mymensingh.

52 Incident, 0 Death, 104 Injury, 636 Arrest



4 Violence against Minorities

4a Ethnic Violence

7 Incident, 4 Death, 2 Arrest, 15 Injury

E.g. A man from a small ethnic minority group (Anil) was reportedly killed by a local in Mahadebpur, Naogaon. A case was filed.
E.g. An elderly couple (Amir & Khadiza) was hacked to death by hill tract-based miscreants in Rangunia, Chattogram, over previous enmity. The victim's son was also injured while trying to protect them.



4b Religious Violence

7 Incident, 1 Death, 3 Arrest, 4 Injury, 6 Idols Destroyed

* Six Idols were destroyed in the October 2023.
E.g. Unidentified criminals broke into a temple in Munshiganj town and stole five idols of Hindu deities.
E.g. A Hindu female Ansar-VDP member, Asha Rani Mohanto (28), was killed after returning from the duty of guarding Pujamandap in Shibganj, Bogura.
E.g. At least three people were injured in the attack on the members of the Bangladesh Hindu Buddhist Christian Unity Council allegedly by Jubo League and Chhatra League men, in Cumilla.



6 Gunfight

1 Incident, 0 Arrest, 2 Death, 0 Injury

E.g. Two Rohingya men (Sanaulah and Ahmed), allegedly members of Rohingya terrorist organization ARSA, were killed in a gunfight between ARSA and ASA over establishing supremacy in the Camp in Ukhia, Cox's Bazar.

7 Border Issue

13 Incident, 16 Arrest, 3 Death, 1 Injury

E.g. A man (Akhas Ali, 35) was shot to death by the Border Security Force of India at Panchagarh.
E.g. A man, Md. Nuruzzaman (50), was shot to death by the Indian Border Security Forces in Baliadangi, Thakurgaon, Rangpur.



8 Violent Extremism

8 Incident, 17 Arrest, 0 Death, 0 Injury

E.g. Rapid Action Battalion reportedly arrested six members, including a key leader, of the banned militant outfit Ansar al-Islam from different areas in Dhaka.
E.g. Anti-Terrorism Unit of Police arrested a member (Arif) of banned militant outfit Ansarulha Bangla Team from Vatara, Dhaka.
