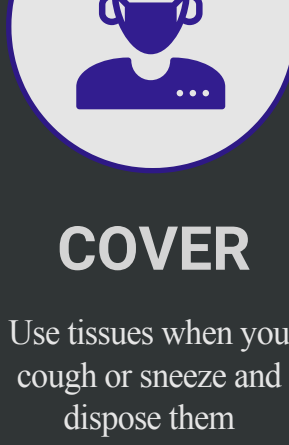

COVID-19 Prevention Tips



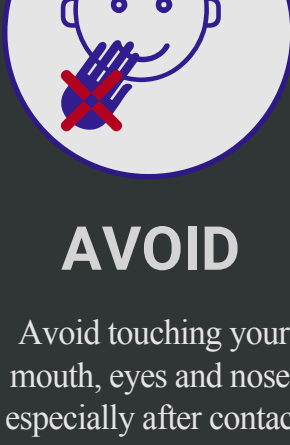
WASH

Wash your hands frequently using soap for at least 20 seconds or sanitise them using alcohol-based handrub.



COVER

Use tissues when you cough or sneeze and dispose them immediately in a closed bin. Use flexed-elbow if tissue is unavailable.



AVOID

Avoid touching your mouth, eyes and nose, especially after contact with any surface.



DISTANCE

Practice social distancing by not shaking hands, hugging, etc.



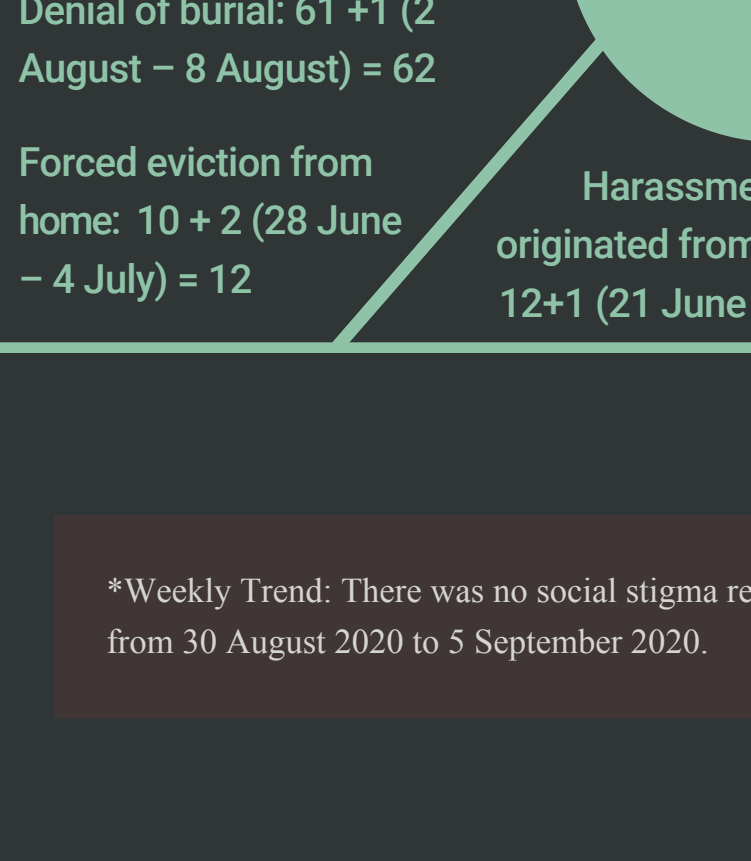
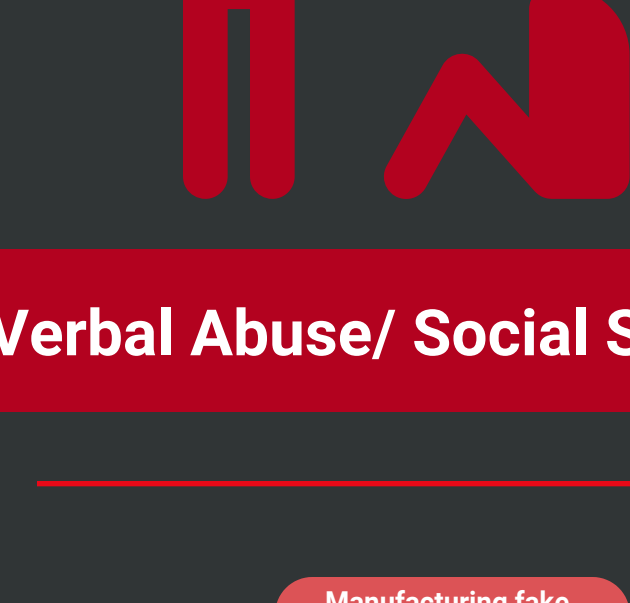
ISOLATE

Covid-19 Related Incident Mapping in Bangladesh

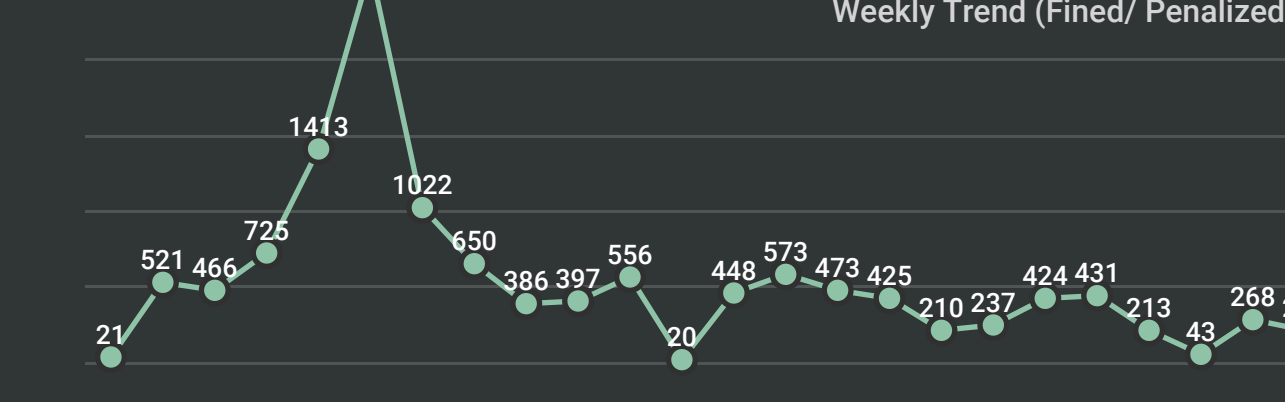
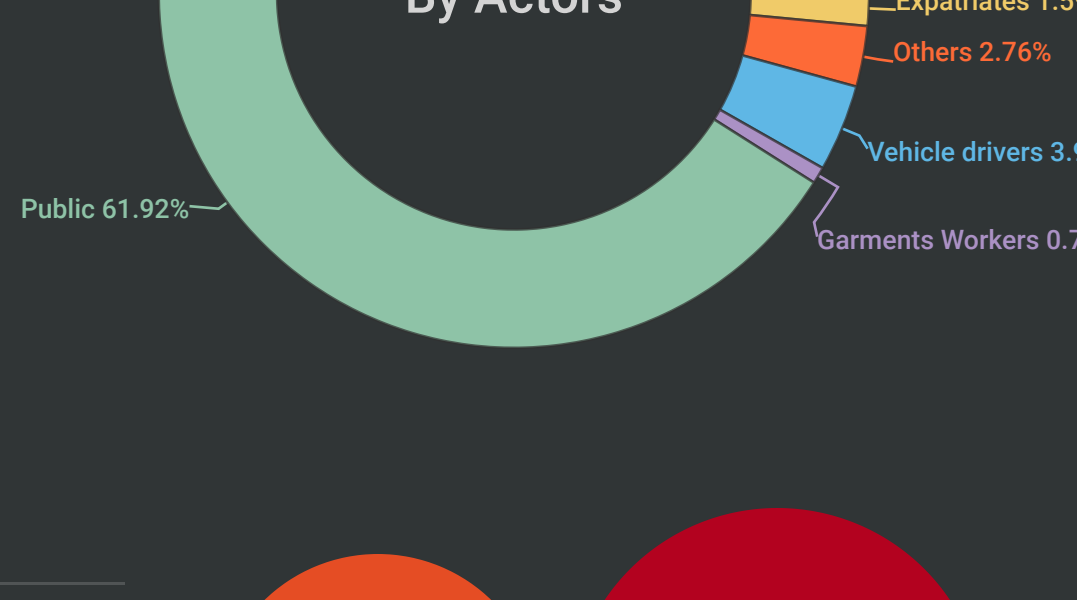
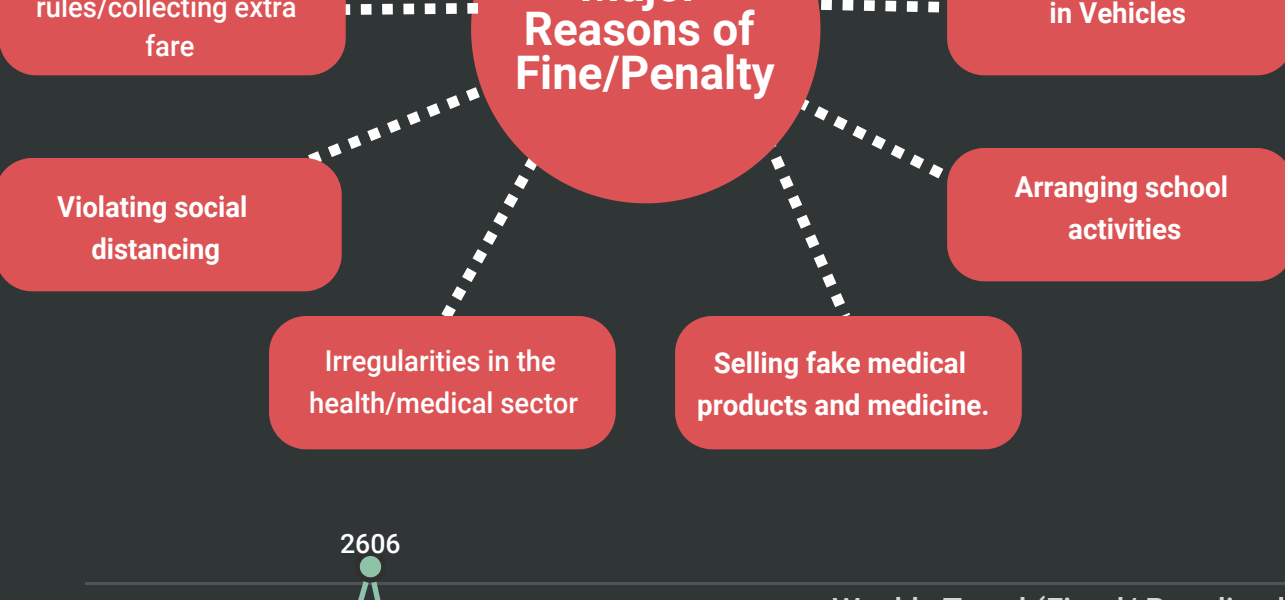

* Four hospitals and diagnostic centres in Dhaka were heavily fined by law enforcement agencies for using expired surgical equipment, masks, irregularities in COVID-19 testing from 23-29 August. Four clinics in Natore were also fined for not maintaining health rules from 30 August-5 September. * People are fined in most of the cases for not wearing masks in public, not maintaining health rules, violating social distancing in public. Also, three people were arrested in charge of manufacturing fake medicine for coronavirus in Narayanganj on 31 August 2020.

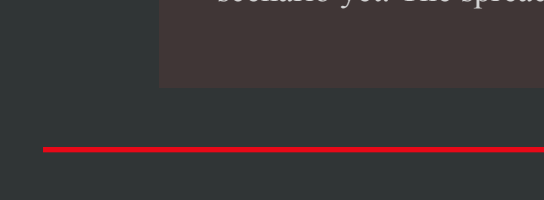

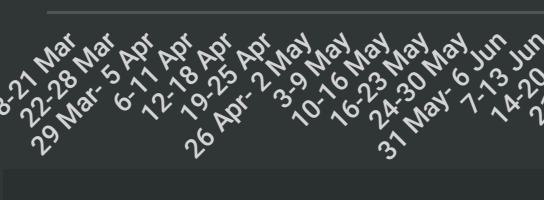
