WASH

Wash your hands frequently using soap for at least 20 seconds or sanitize them using alcohol-based handrub.



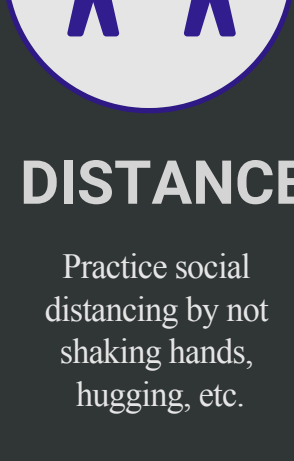
COVER

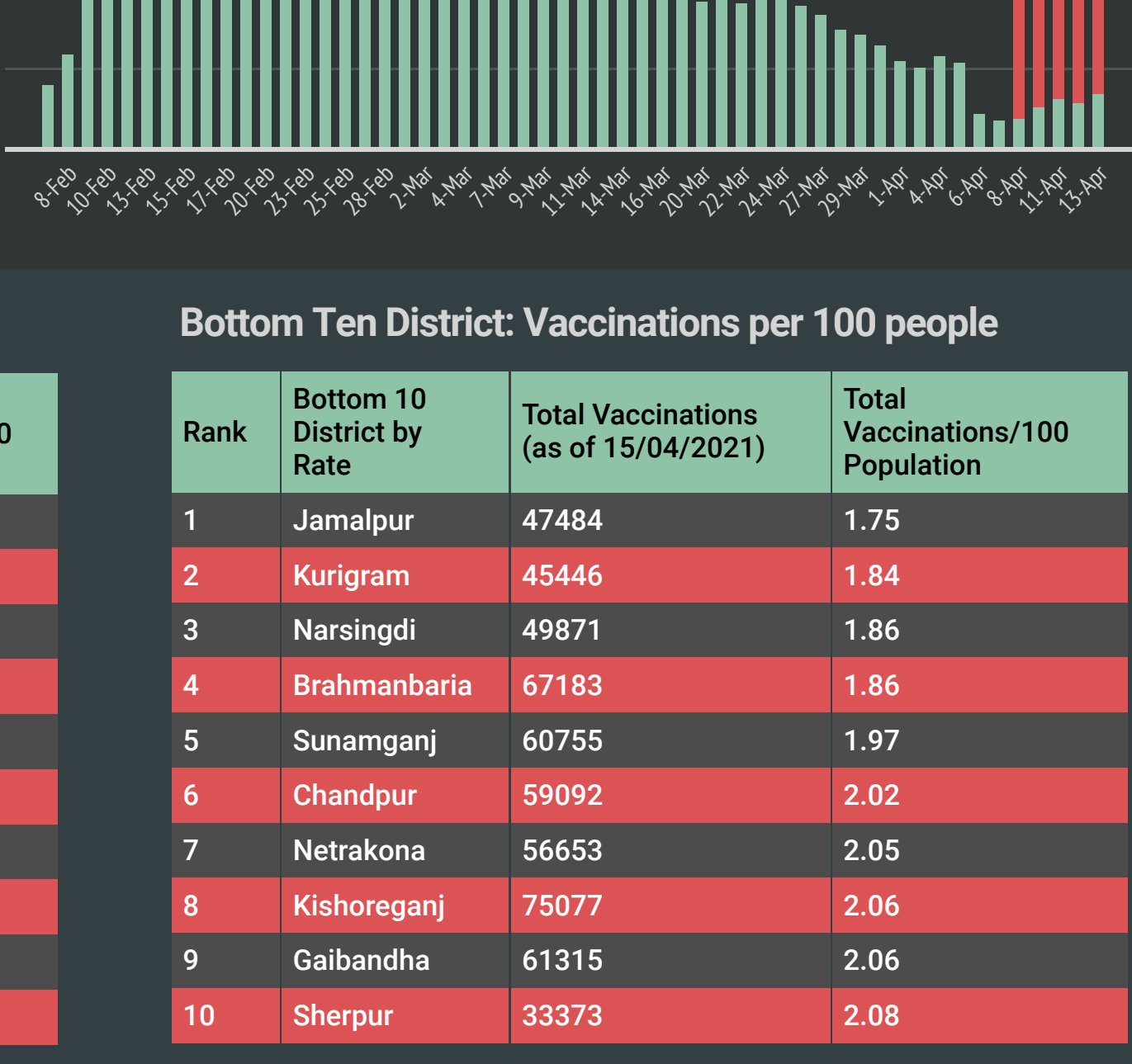

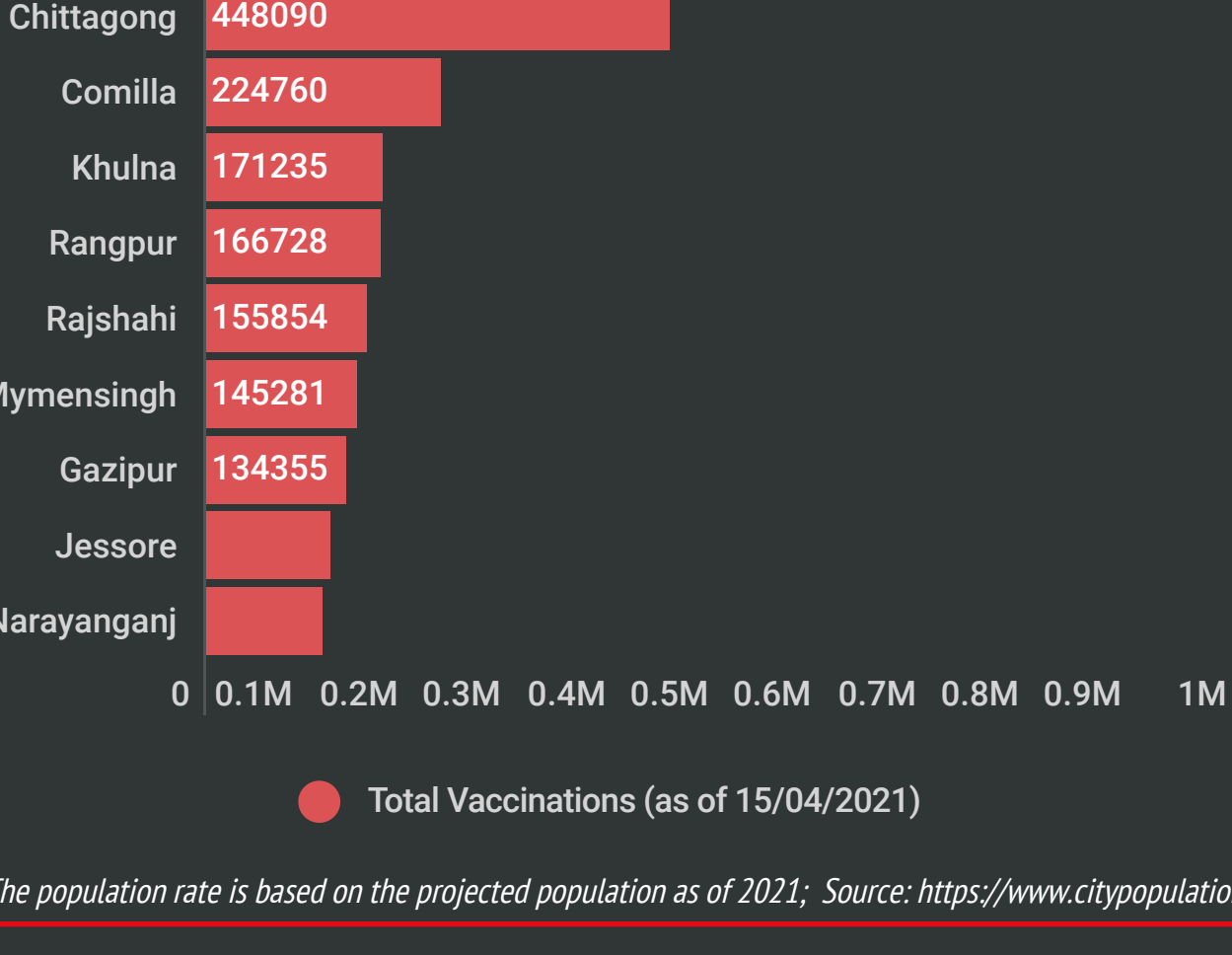

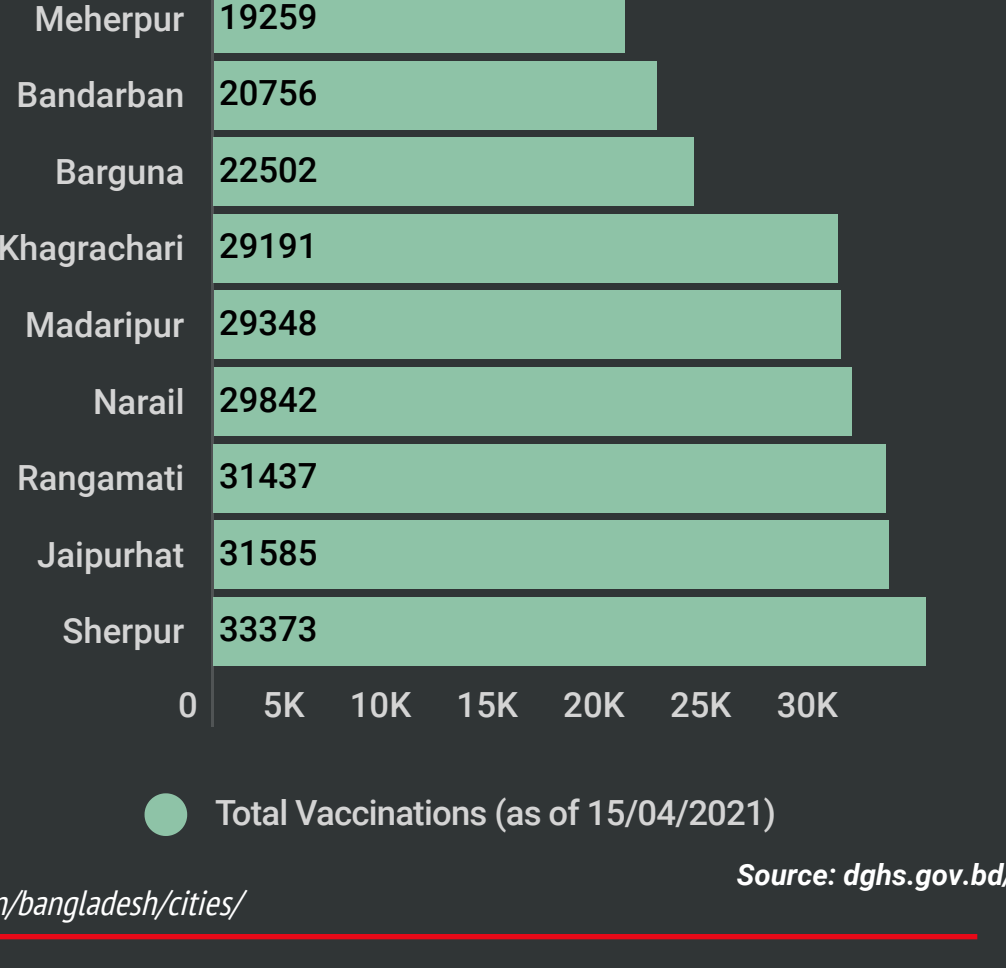

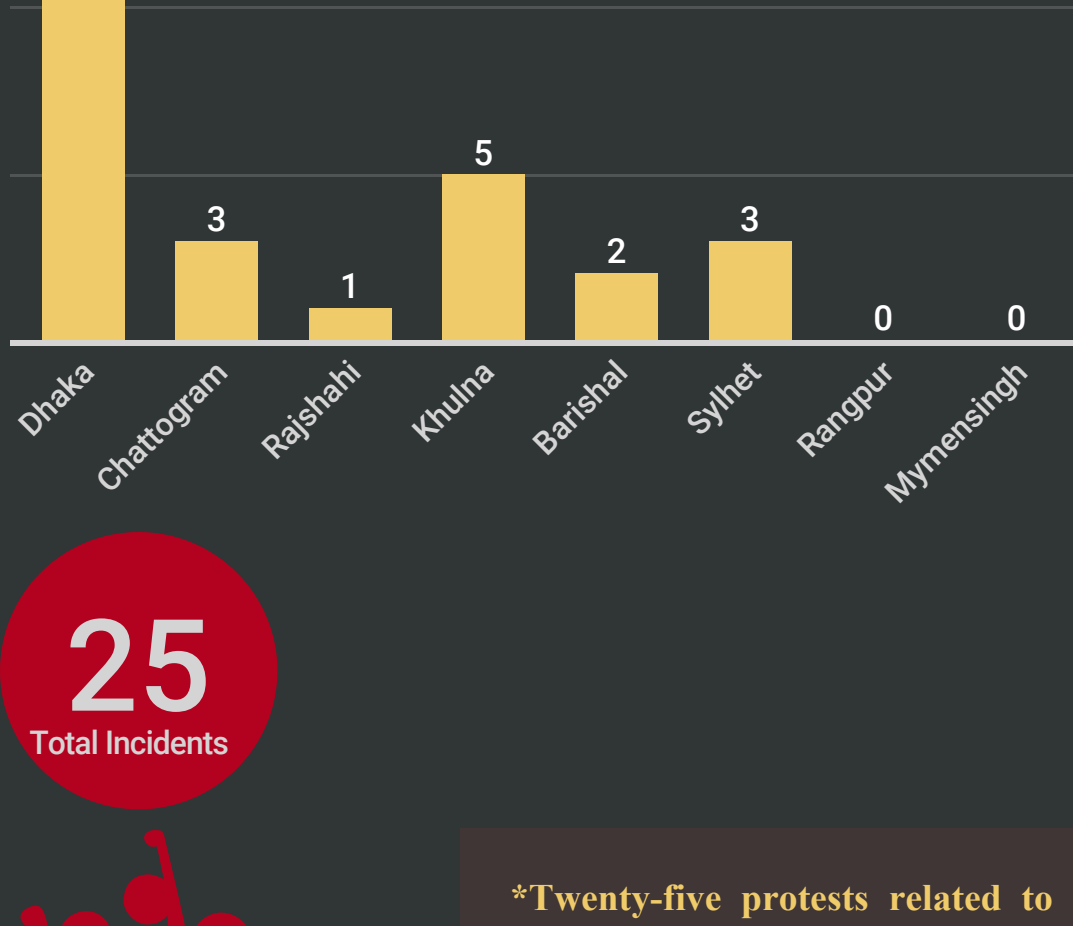

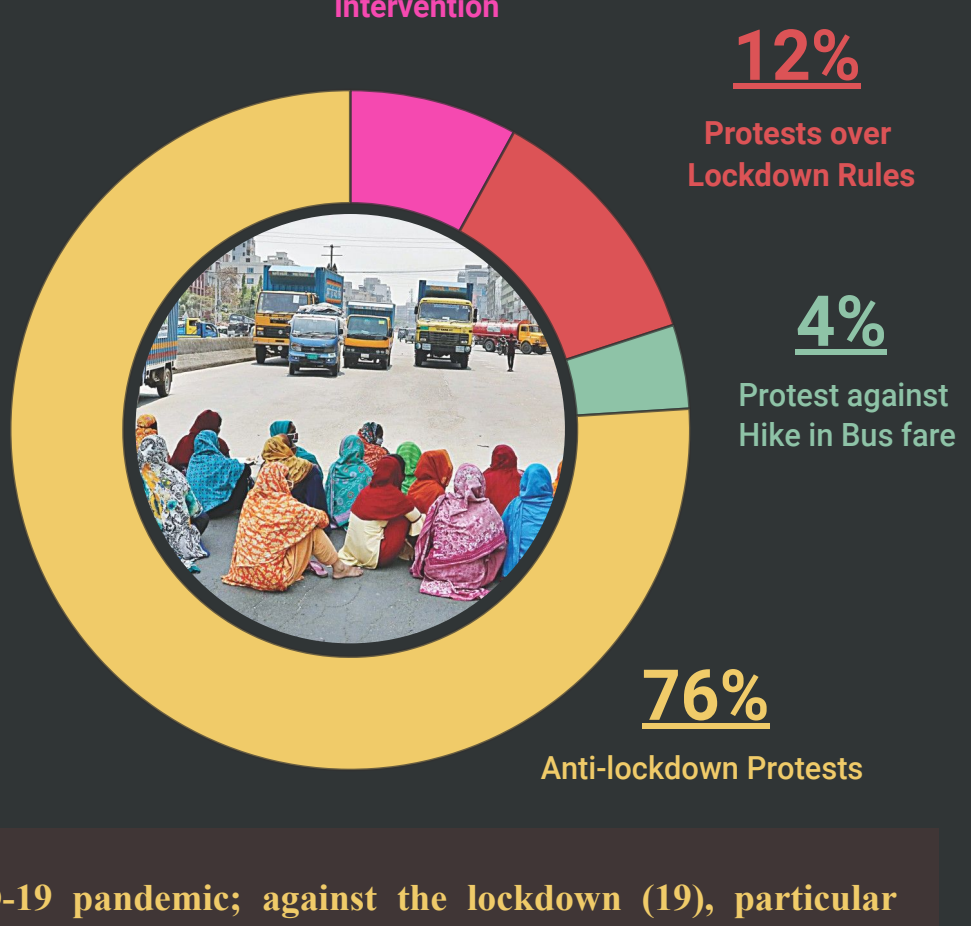

*Twenty-five protests related to the COVID-19 pandemic; against the lockdown (19), particular lockdown rules(3), call for government intervention (2), and hike in bus fare (1) were recorded from 29 March 2021 to 12 April 2021.

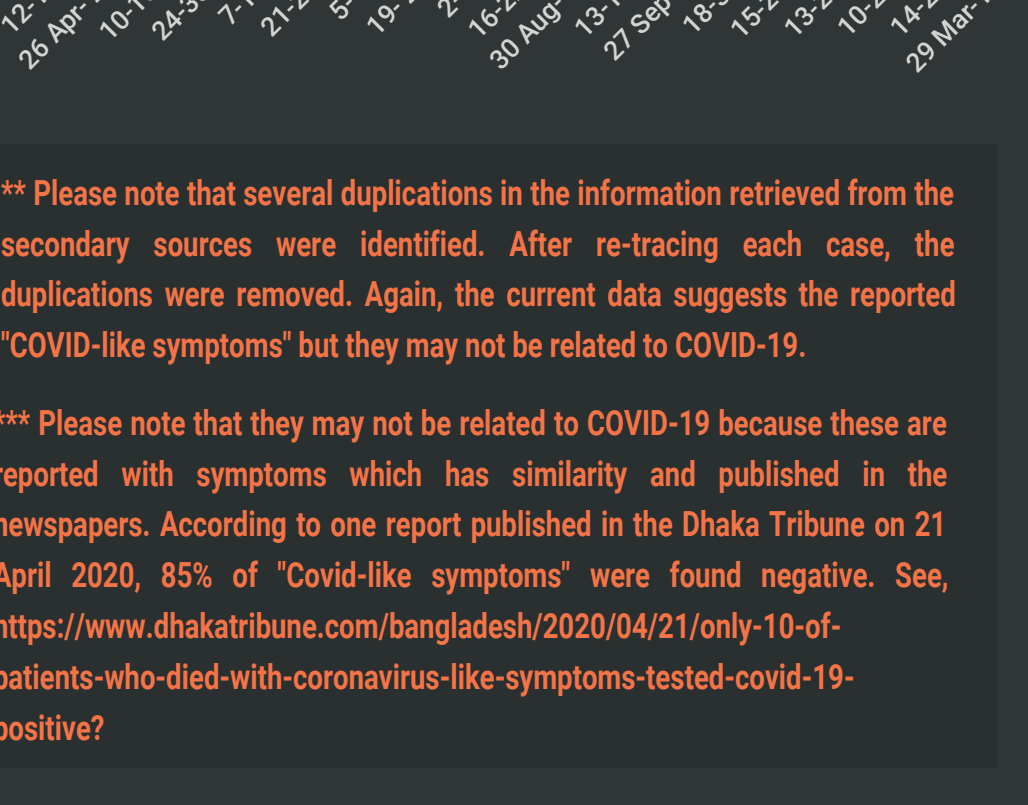
*The owners and workers of shops in the New Market and other shopping places in the area took to the street on 4 April, protesting the government's decision to shut down all shopping malls and markets during the weeklong lockdown. They demanded that the government cancel the lockdown, protesting-lockdown-clash-with-police

* Baam Gonotantrik Jot calls for nationwide protests demanding one month's ration and money for labourers.

* Agitated motorcycle riders along the ride-sharing services blocked roads in the Shyamoli area in Dhaka, protested at the Bangladesh government decision to impose a ban on carrying passengers by motorcycles.

* A human chain was held at the central Shahid Minar in Sylhet at 3 pm on 3 April to protest against the increase in public transport fares across the country. Speakers at the event said that the decision to increase bus fare by 60% was very unfair. The Jaatri Odhikar Parishad organized the human chain.

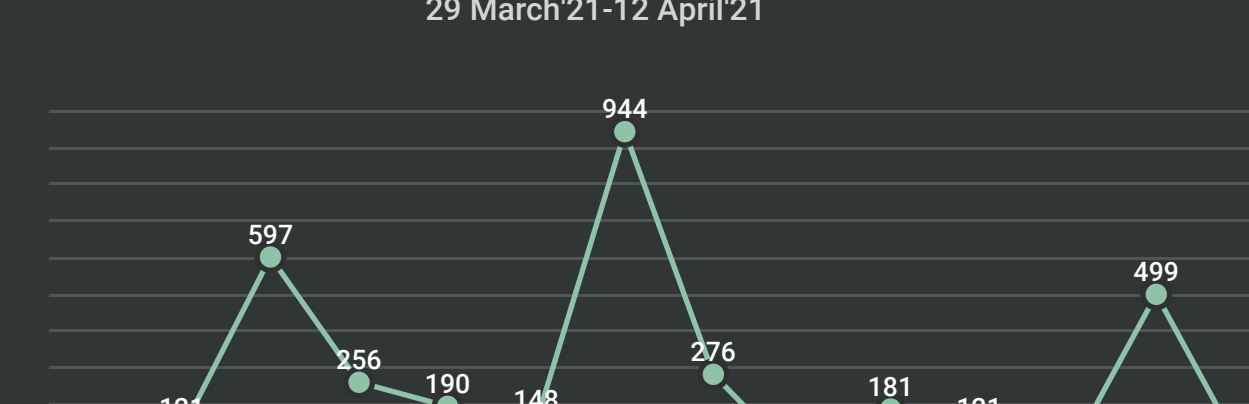

*To contain the sudden rise of the infection rate, the government imposed partial lockdown with specific rules and regulations from 5 April 2021. Since then, local administrations have been vigilant to enforce the penalty for those who disobeyed the lockdown rules and regulations. From 29 March- 12 April 2021, 3510 people, businesses and institutions were fined, and 44 people were arrested.

Report on Fear related to COVID-19 (30 May'20 - 12 April'21)



1,743 News Reports

Media coverage of the COVID-19 pandemic which evokes fear in the minds of the people. 122 news report associated with fear related to the COVID-19 were recorded from 29 March 2021 to 12 April 2021. Some key reports include:

* A research study conducted by the ICDDR,B revealed that the South African variant has accounted for 81% of the positive cases in Dhaka since the third week of March 2021.

* A report revealed that one-third of people suffer mental health problems even after recovering from coronavirus.

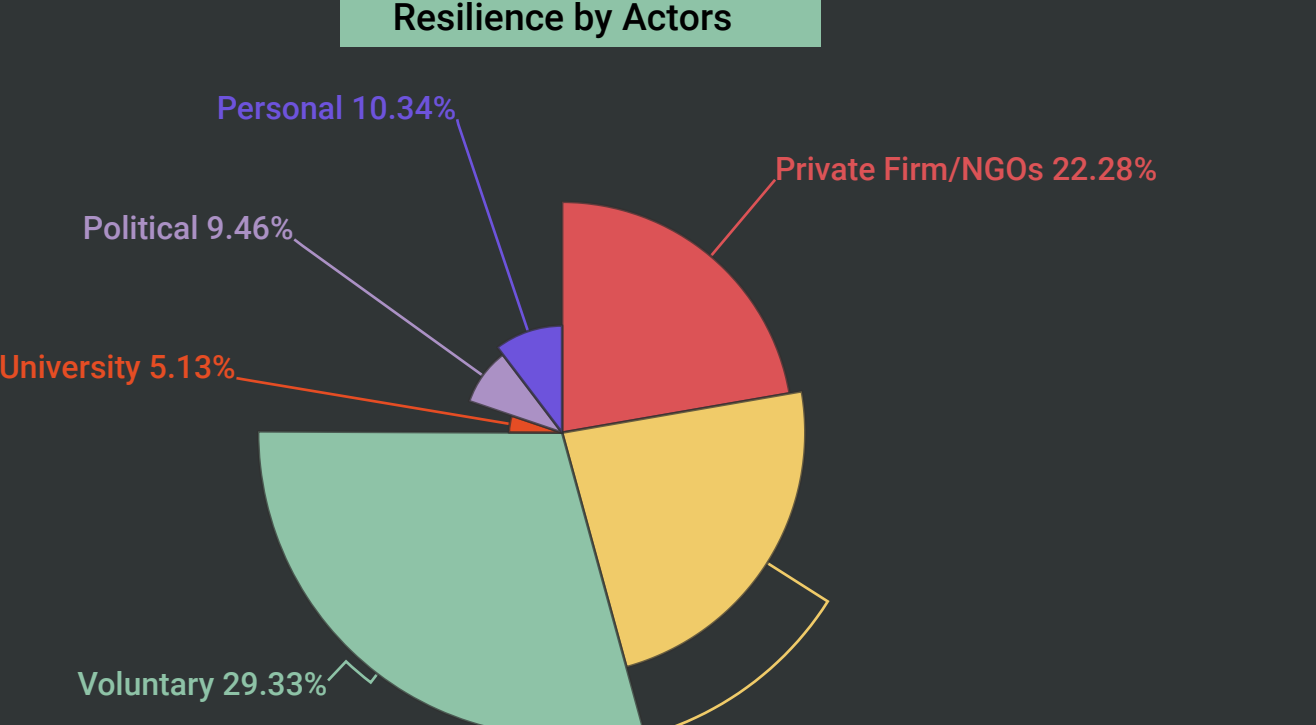
* In the midst of the second wave of the COVID-19 pandemic, due to the mechanical error of the lab, sample testing at Sir Salimullah Medical College Hospital had been suspended for a week at the RT-PCR lab.

* According to the Worldometers statistics, Bangladesh is now in 33rd in terms of COVID-19 infection rate, since March 1, 2021, the infection rate keeps rising noticeably, and from below 4%, the infection rate jumps to 19% and it's still growing.

*Covid-19 has rapidly spread across the country and 31 districts don't have any ICU unit according to the Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS), health authorities confirmed that despite the direct order of Prime Minister to build a separate ICU unit in every district Sadar hospital, local authorities yet to pay attention to this. Meanwhile, emergency COVID-19 patients had to suffer as the crisis for ICU unit seat is critical amid the second wave of the pandemic.

* 93 news report associated with COVID-19 resilience were recorded from 29 March 2021 to 12 April 2021.

* A freedom fighter distributed 500 face mask among the people at Morrelganj, Bagherhat.

* An organization called 'Best Initiative of Bhola' establishes 'wall of humanity' in Bhola Sadar to help people in the time of corona with rations and raise awareness.

*Bangladesh Svecchasebak League started a free ambulance service for the general people at Khulna Sadar.

* Jahangirnagar University students organized a street puppet show to attract people to raise awareness among people regarding health directives that everyone needs to follow to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

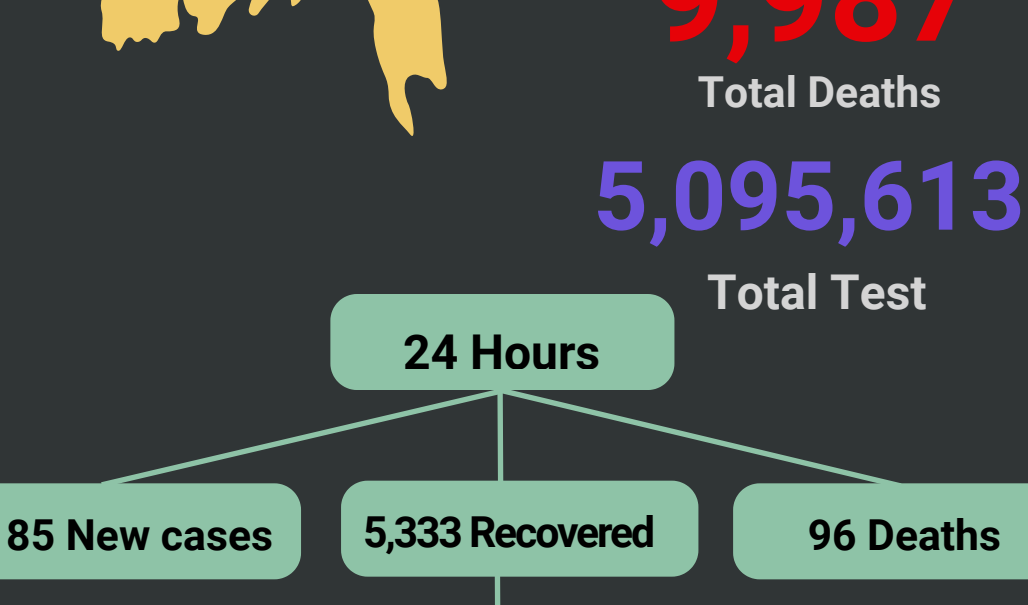
*BRAC has reached more than 12,00,000 families and gave them instructions about the health guidelines against the coronavirus across the country.

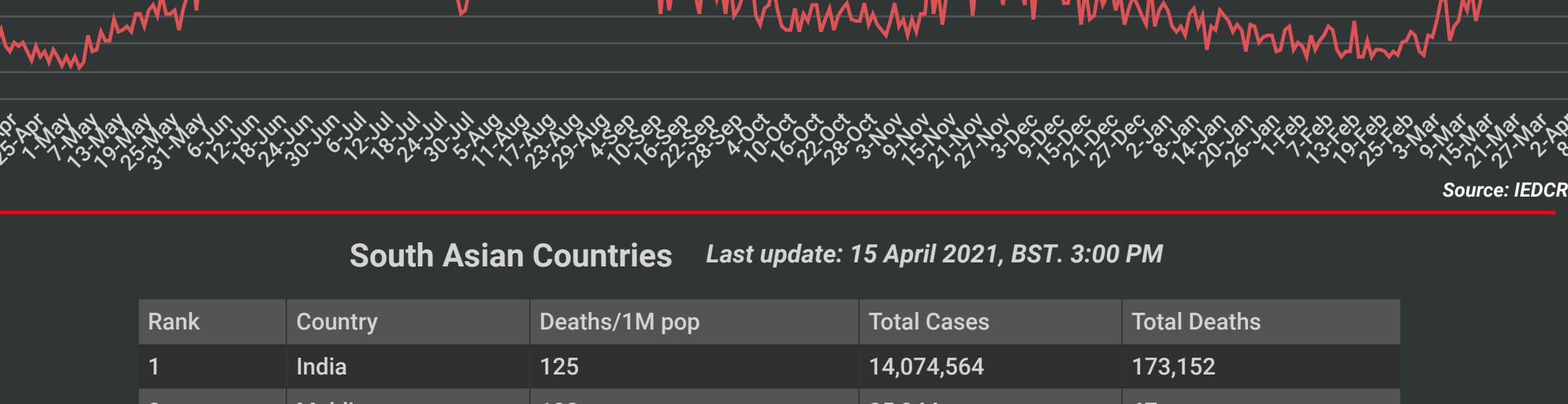
