COVID-19 Prevention Tips



WASH

Wash your hands frequently using soap for at least 20 seconds or sanitise them using alcohol-based handrub.



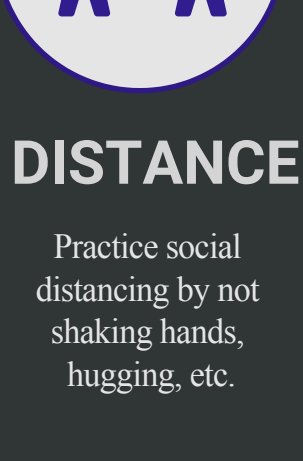
COVER

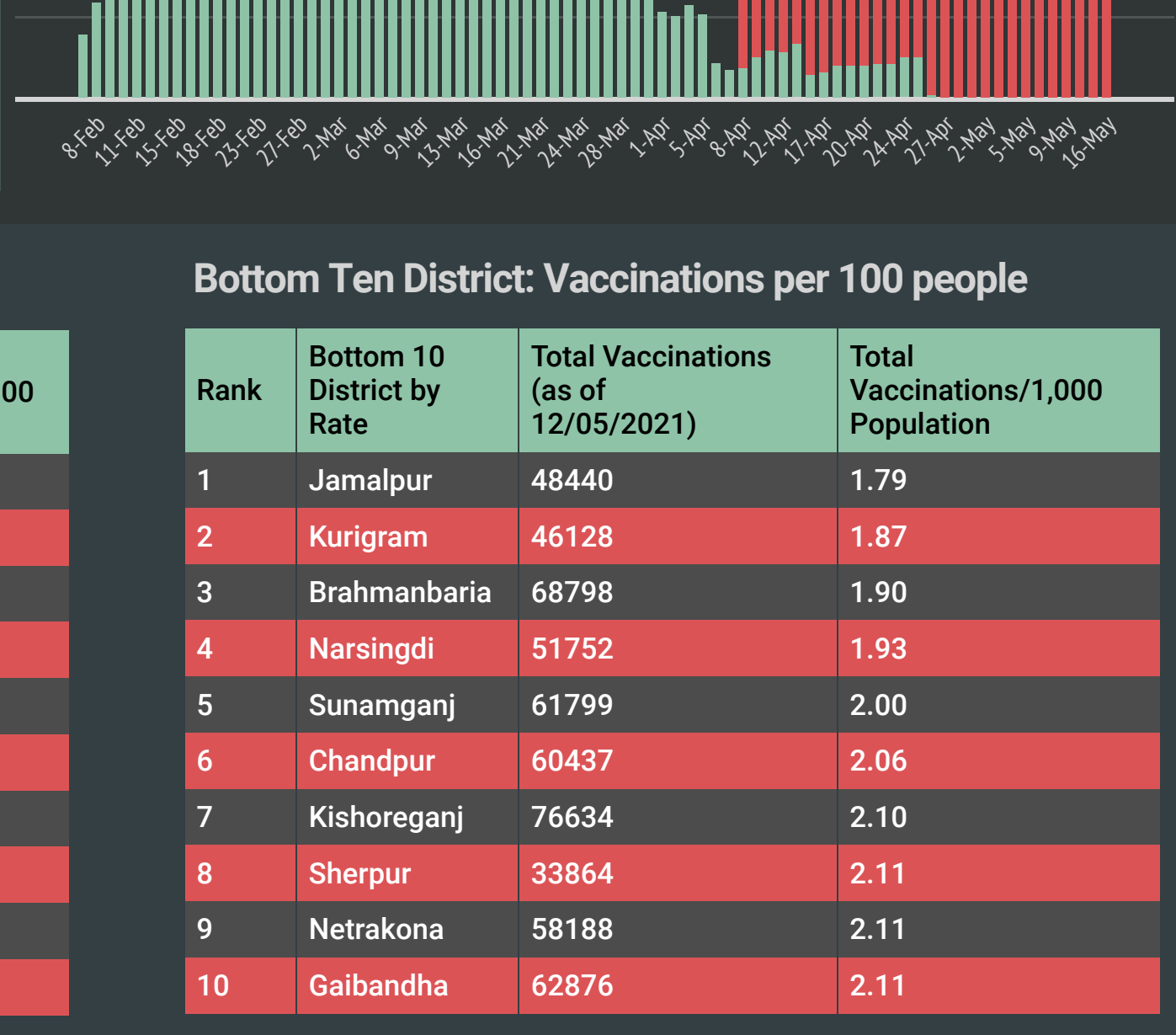

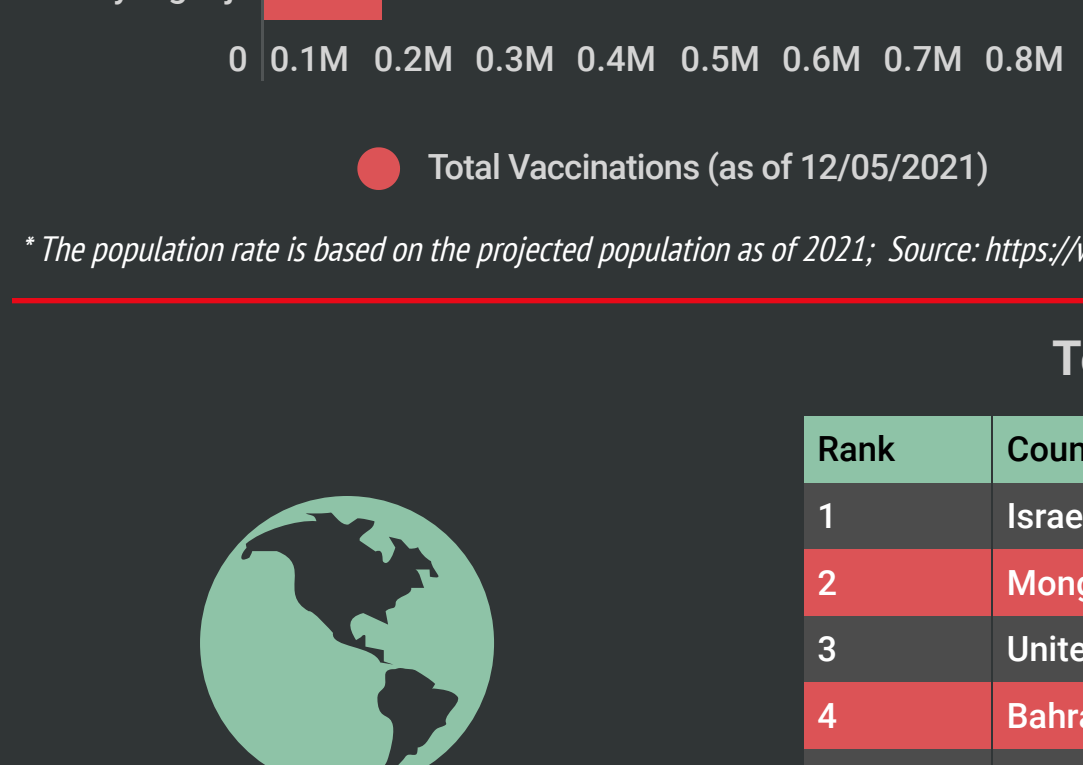

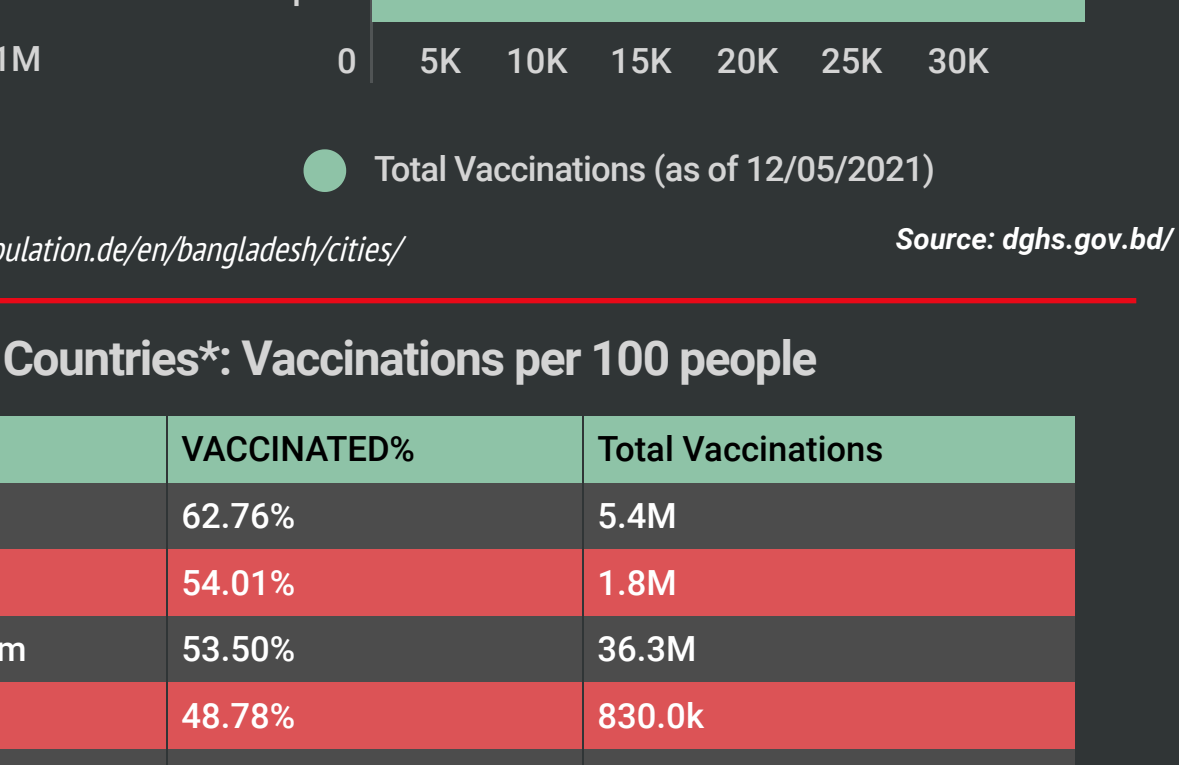

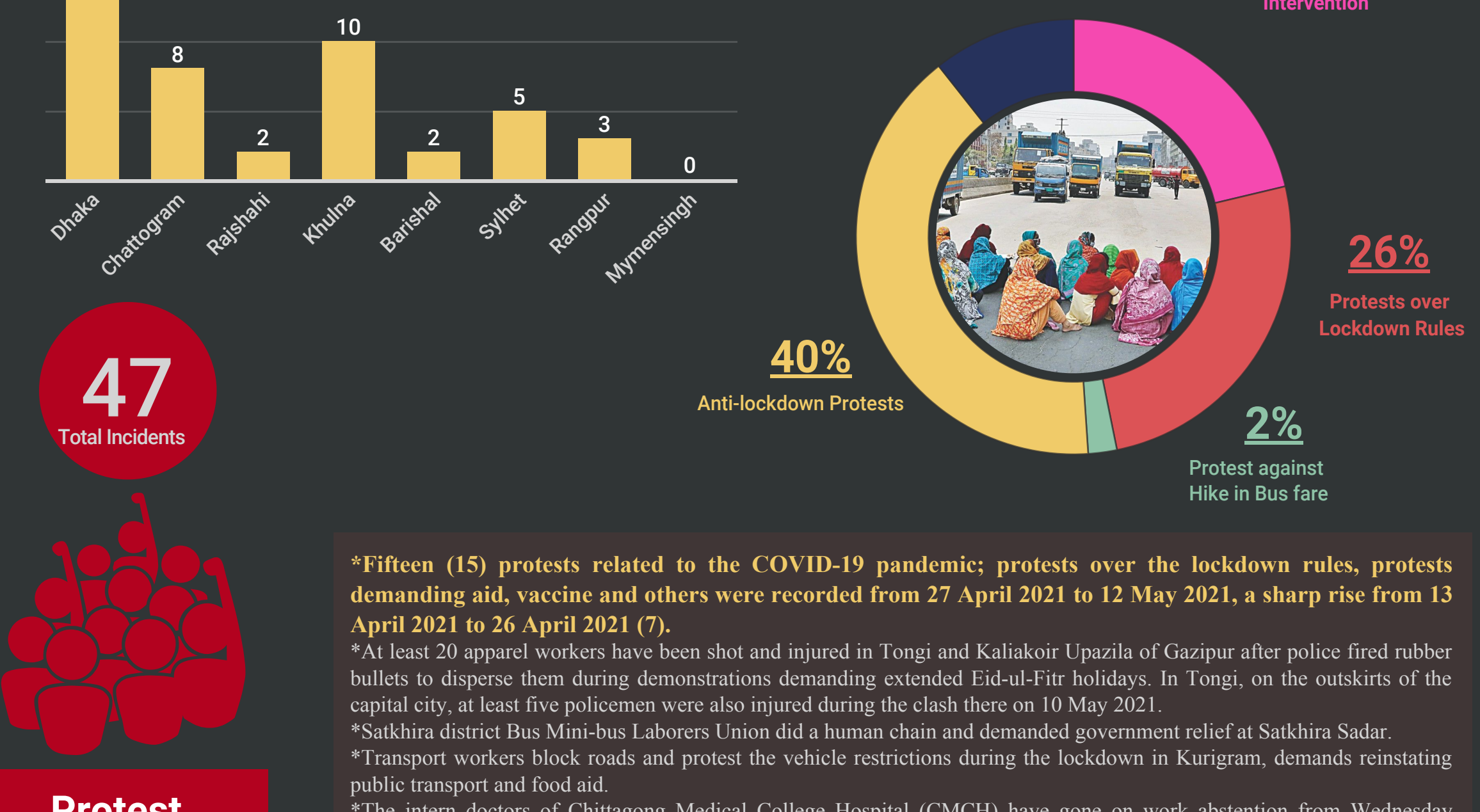

*Fifteen (15) protests related to the COVID-19 pandemic; protests over the lockdown rules, protests demanding aid, vaccine and others were recorded from 27 April 2021 to 12 May 2021, a sharp rise from 13 April 2021 to 26 April 2021 (7).

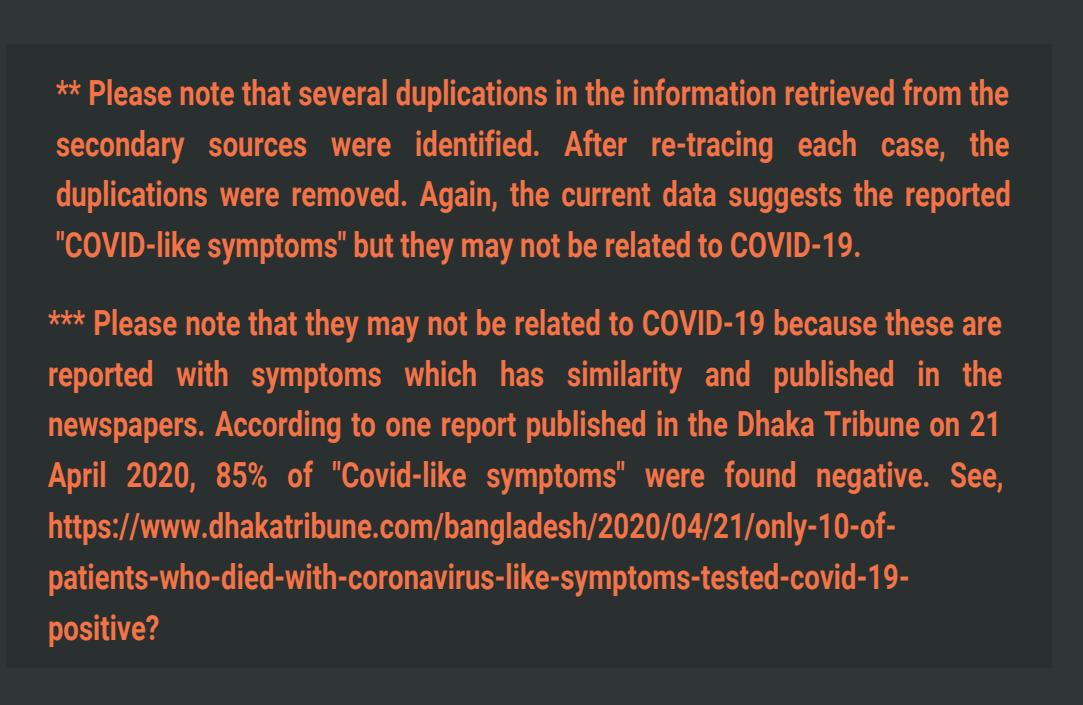
*At least 20 apparel workers have been shot and injured in Tongi and Kaliaokir Upazila of Gazipur after police fired rubber bullets to disperse them during demonstrations demanding extended Eid-ul-Fitr holidays. In Tongi, on the outskirts of the capital city, at least five policemen were also injured during the clash there on 10 May 2021.

*Satkhira district Bus Mini-bus Laborers Union did a human chain and demanded government relief at Satkhira Sadar.

*Transport workers block roads and protest the vehicle restrictions during the lockdown in Kurigram, demands reinstating public transport and food aid.

*The intern doctors of Chittagong Medical College Hospital (CMCH) have gone on work abstention from Wednesday following a clash between two factions of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) that left five of them injured on 28 April 2021.

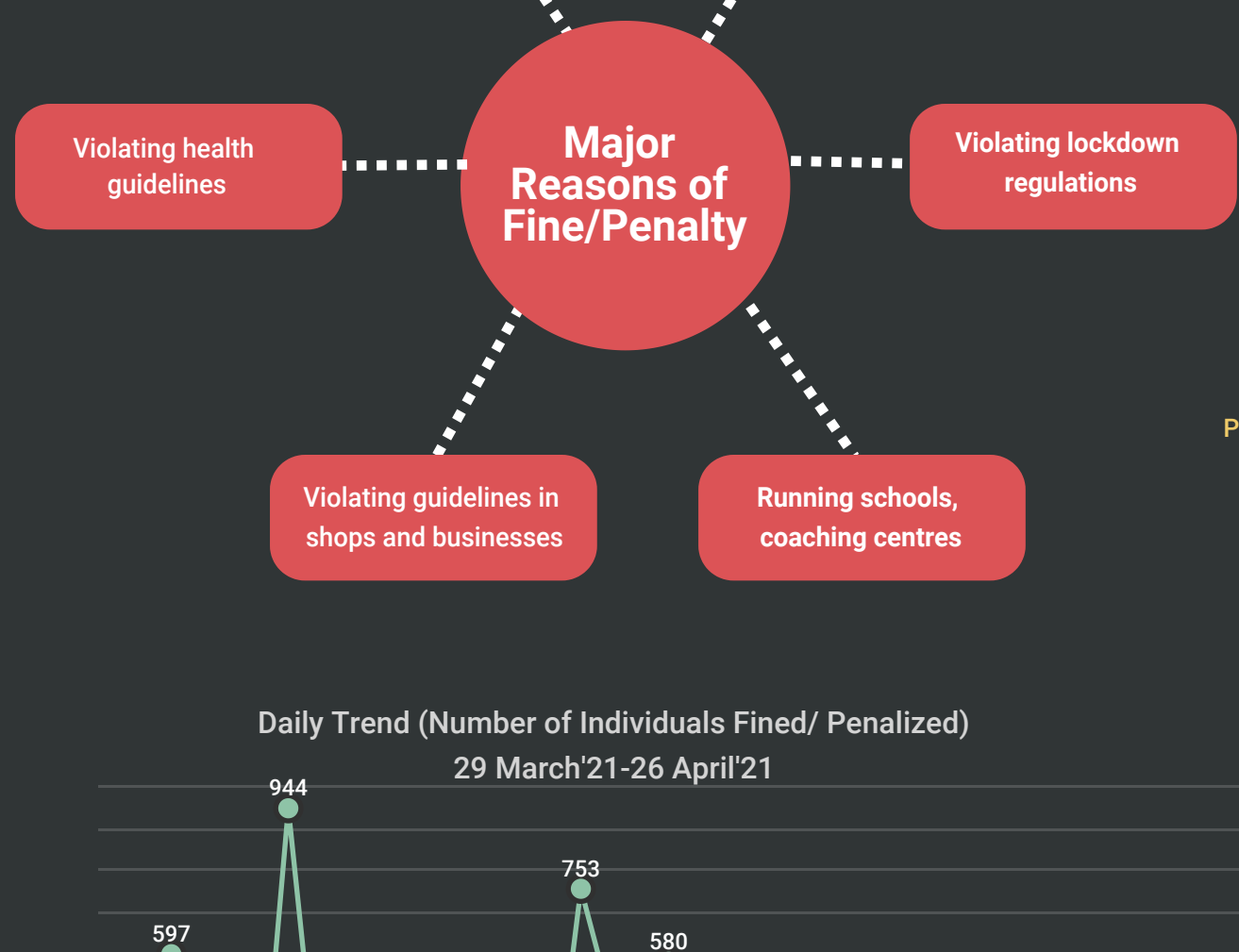

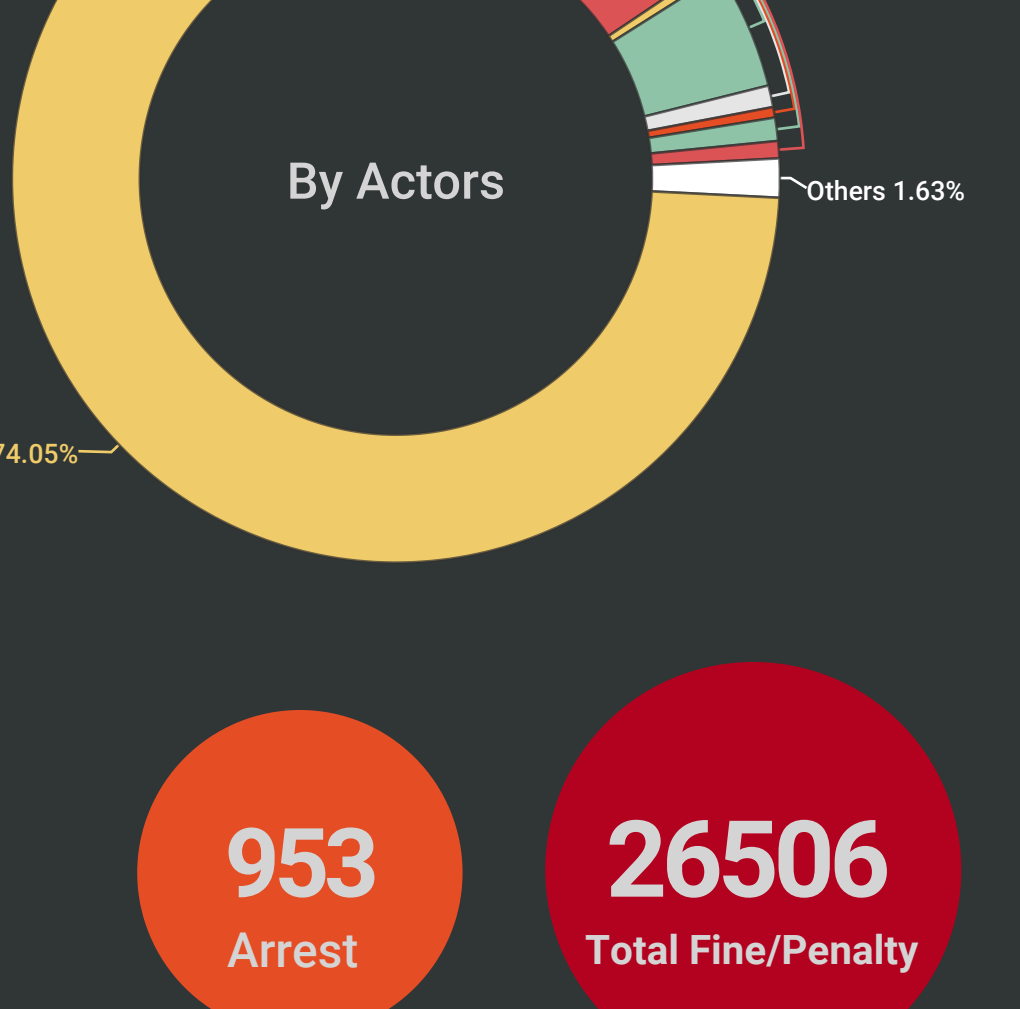

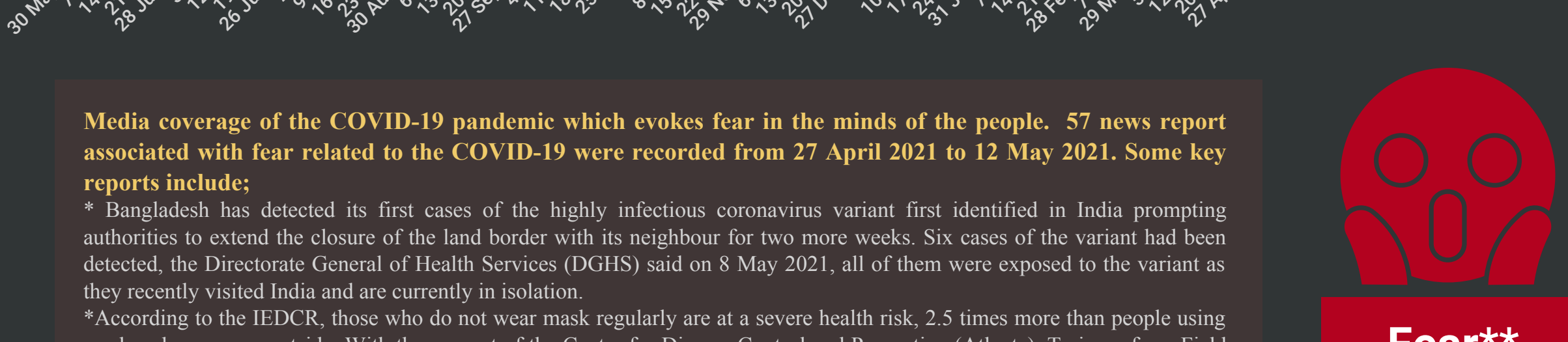
Daily Trend (Number of Individuals Fined/ Penalized)



*The number of the fines/penalty fell drastically since the shopping malls reopened on 25th April 2021. Most of the fines were awarded at the shopping malls, drivers and passengers of the public transport for not maintaining health guidelines in public places. 763 fines were awarded, and no arrest was reported from 27 April to 12 May.

Report on Fear related to COVID-19 (30 May'20 - 12 May'21)

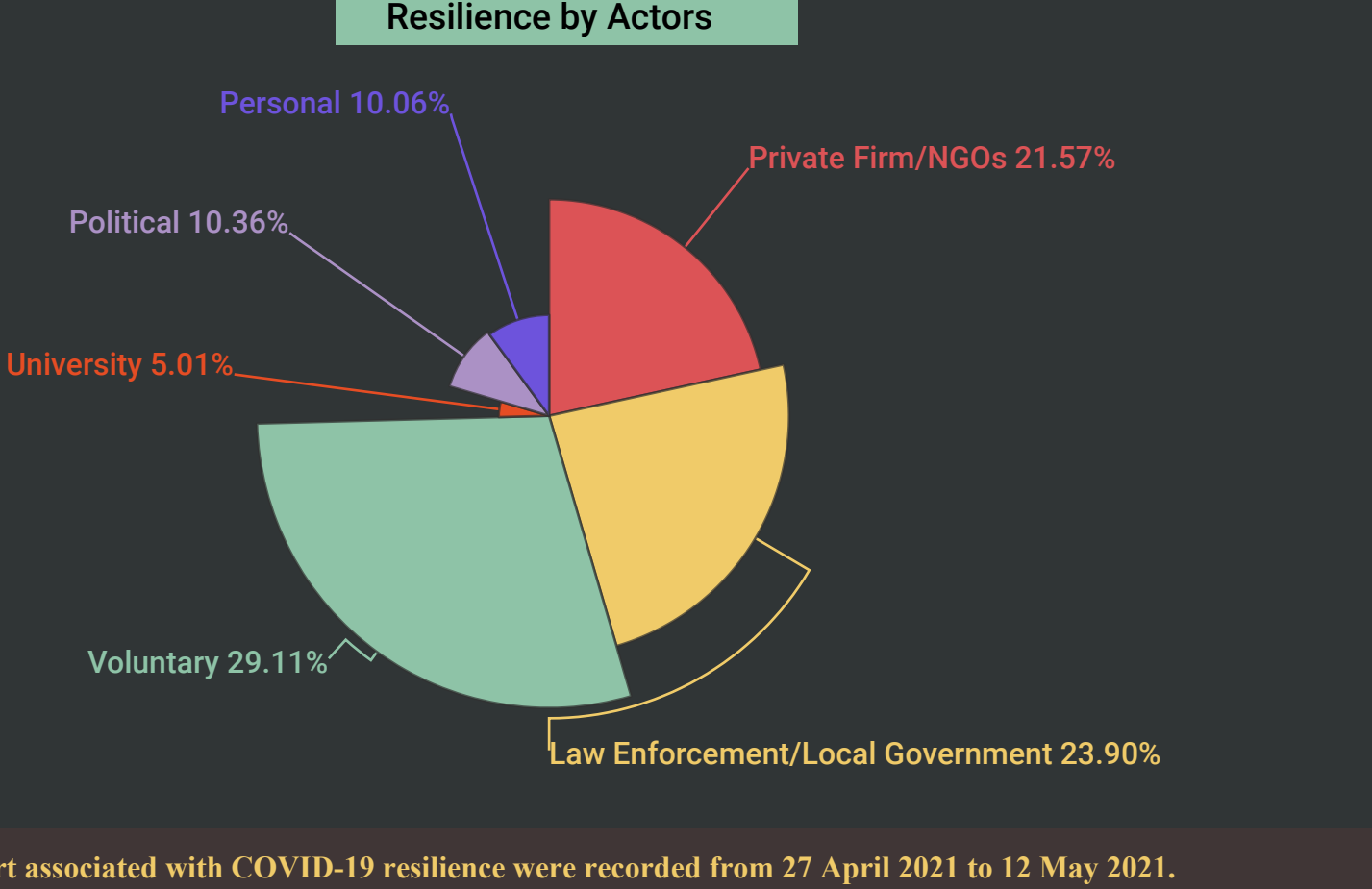
Media coverage of the COVID-19 pandemic which evokes fear in the minds of the people. 57 news report associated with fear related to the COVID-19 were recorded from 27 April 2021 to 12 May 2021. Some key reports included;

* Bangladesh has detected its first cases of the highly infectious coronavirus variant first identified in India prompting authorities to extend the closure of the land border with its neighbour for two more weeks. Six cases of the variant had been detected, the Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS) said on 8 May 2021, all of them were exposed to the variant as they recently visited India and are currently in isolation.

*According to the IEDCR, those who do not wear mask regularly are at a severe health risk, 2.5 times more than people using masks whenever go outside. With the support of the Centre for Disease Control and Prevention (Atlanta), Trainees from Field Epidemiology Training Program has conducted a survey regarding the increase of COVID-19 infection across the country, the survey included a total 148 COVID-19 positive and 245 COVID-19 negative (after recovering from the infection) participants.

* 76 news report associated with COVID-19 resilience were recorded from 27 April 2021 to 12 May 2021.

*A group of volunteers in orange jackets have been helping to move Covid-19 patients into the Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH). They did so while maintaining all safety measures, including wearing face masks, face shields and gloves. During a visit to the Covid-19 unit of DMCH, it was seen that the volunteers, mostly belonging to the third gender community, were also helping already admitted Covid-19 patients as well as transporting them to nearby places via their battery-run auto-rickshaws. A team of 15, of whom 10 are from the hijra community, and five males, are assisting both tested and suspected Covid patients waiting in front of the Covid-19 unit of DMCH from morning till night.

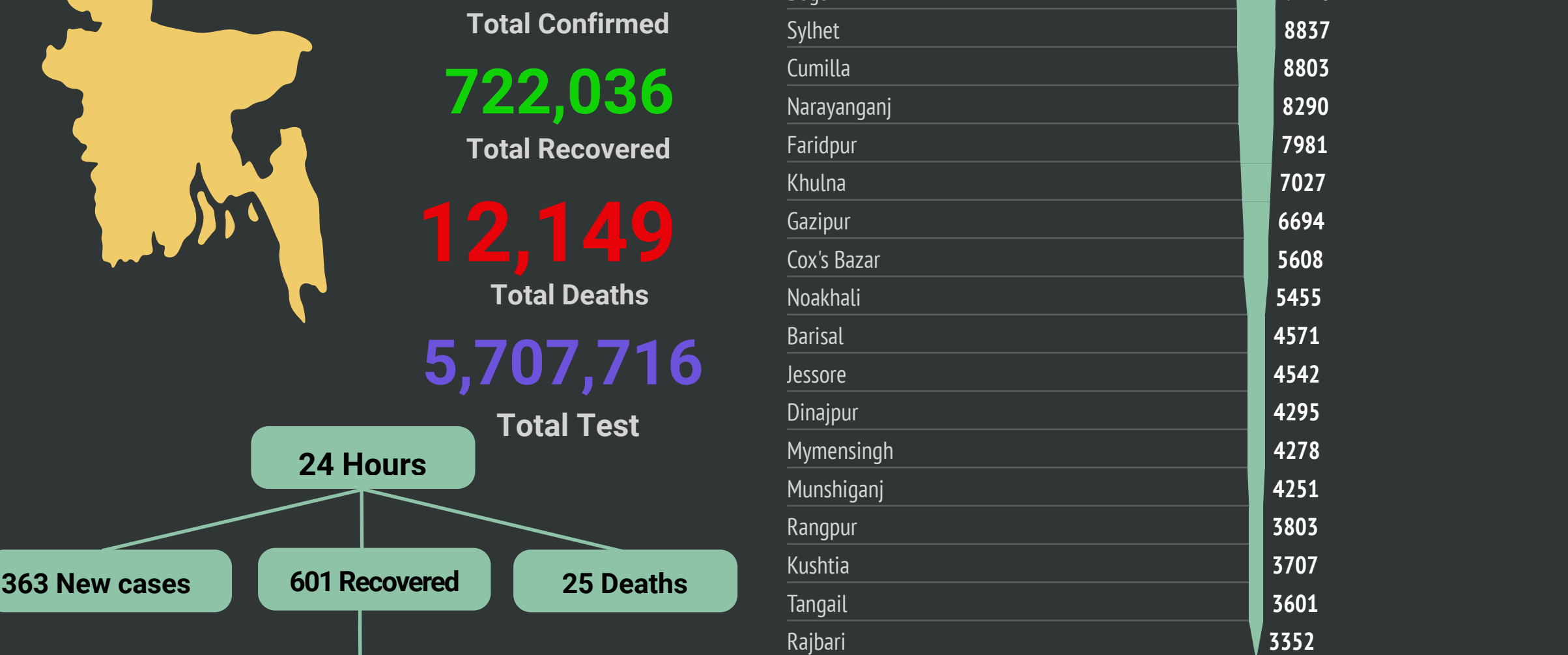
*Due to the increased demand for liquid oxygen for Covid-19 patients, AKS Steel Industry has started producing oxygen in their steel manufacturing factories and provided it to the hospitals across the country without charging any fees and GPHI Steel Company decided to go on producing oxygen if necessary, by reducing the steel production in their factories. Both companies claimed that the purity level of their produced liquid oxygen is 99.99%.

District wise distribution (Top 20)

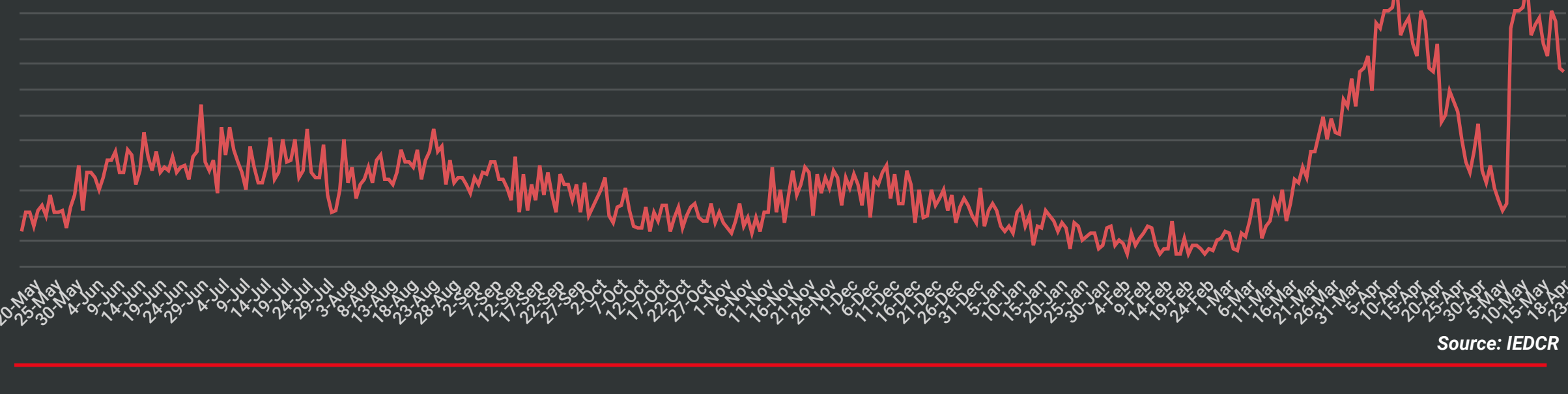
