## COVID-19 Prevention Tips



### WASH

Wash your hands frequently using soap for at least 20 seconds or sanitise them using alcohol-based handrub.



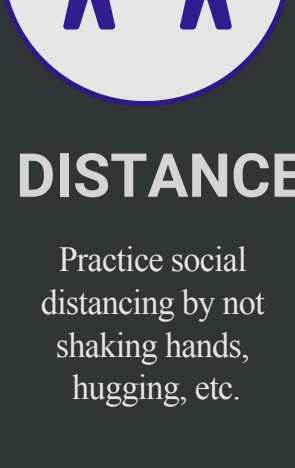
### COVER

Practice social distancing by not shaking hands, hugging, etc.

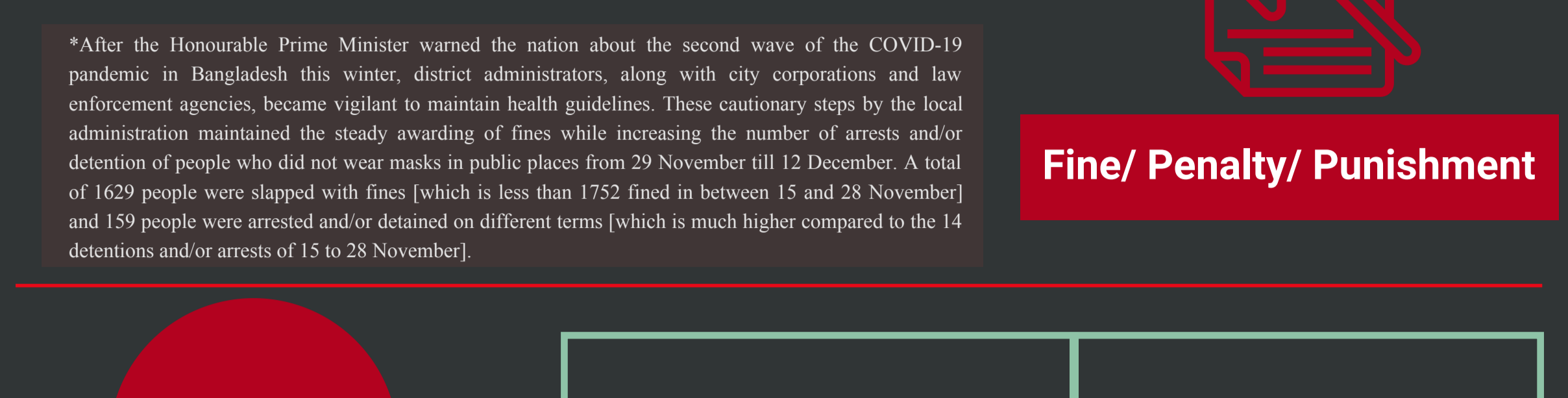
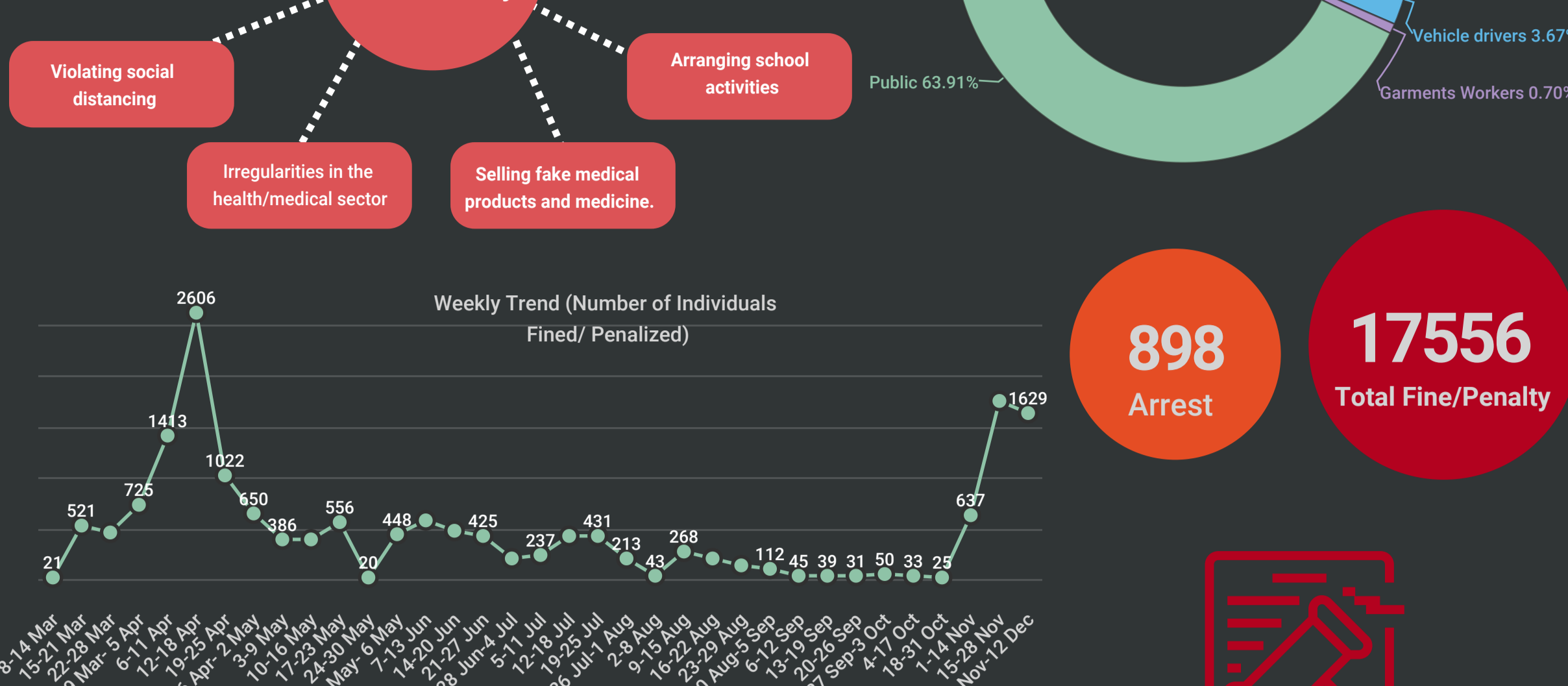


### ISOLATE

Update: 1 March - 12 December 2020

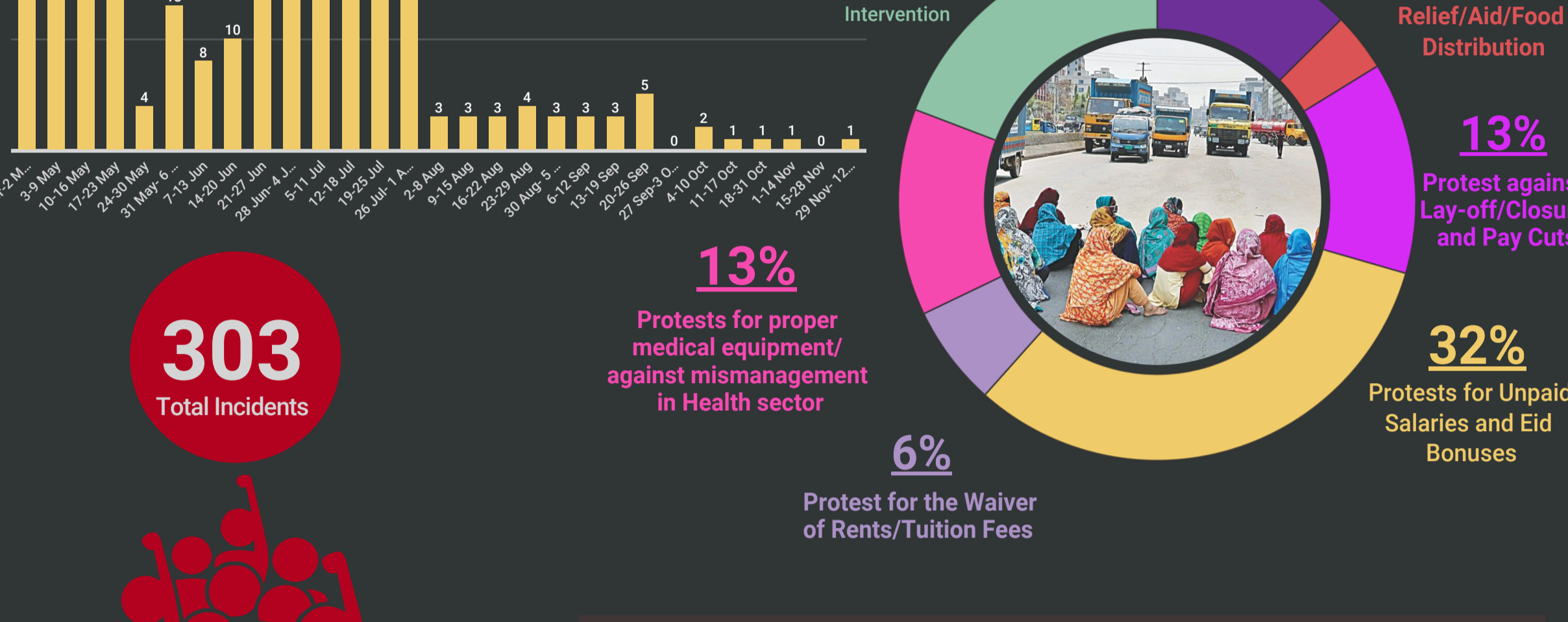


\*After the Honourable Prime Minister warned the nation about the second wave of the COVID-19 pandemic in Bangladesh this winter, district administrators, along with city corporations and law enforcement agencies, became vigilant to maintain health guidelines. These cautionary steps by the local administration maintained the steady awarding of fines while increasing the number of arrests and/or detention of people who did not wear masks in public places from 29 November till 12 December. A total of 1629 people were slapped with fines [which is less than 1752 fined in between 15 and 28 November] and 159 people were arrested and/or detained on different terms [which is much higher compared to the 14 detentions and/or arrests of 15 to 28 November].



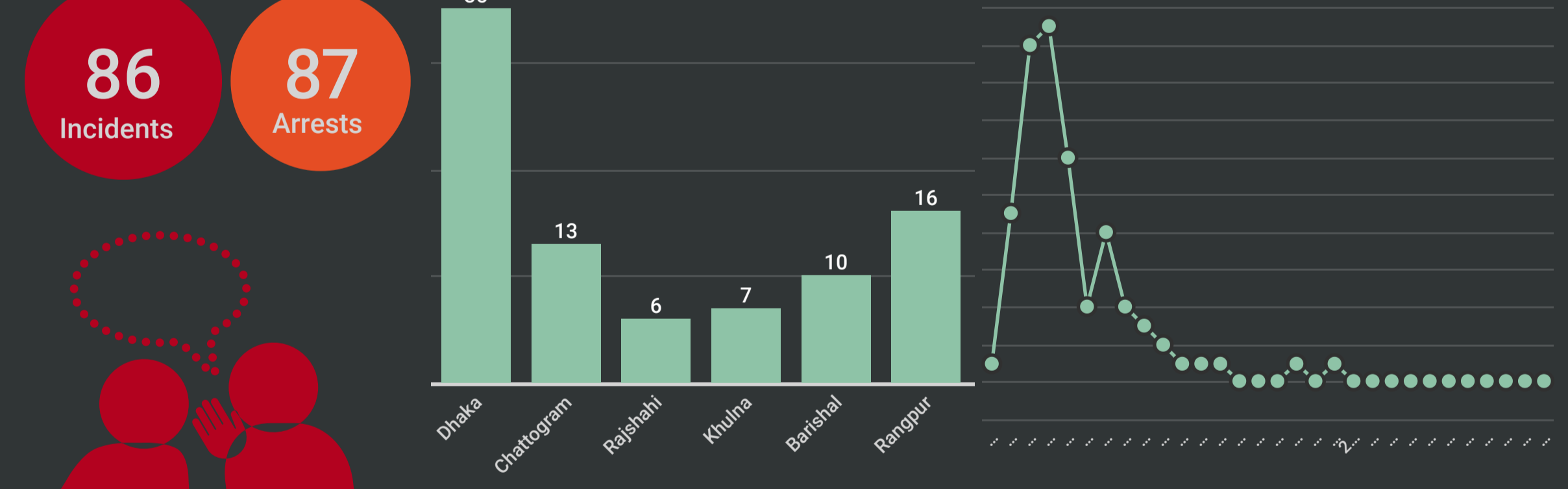
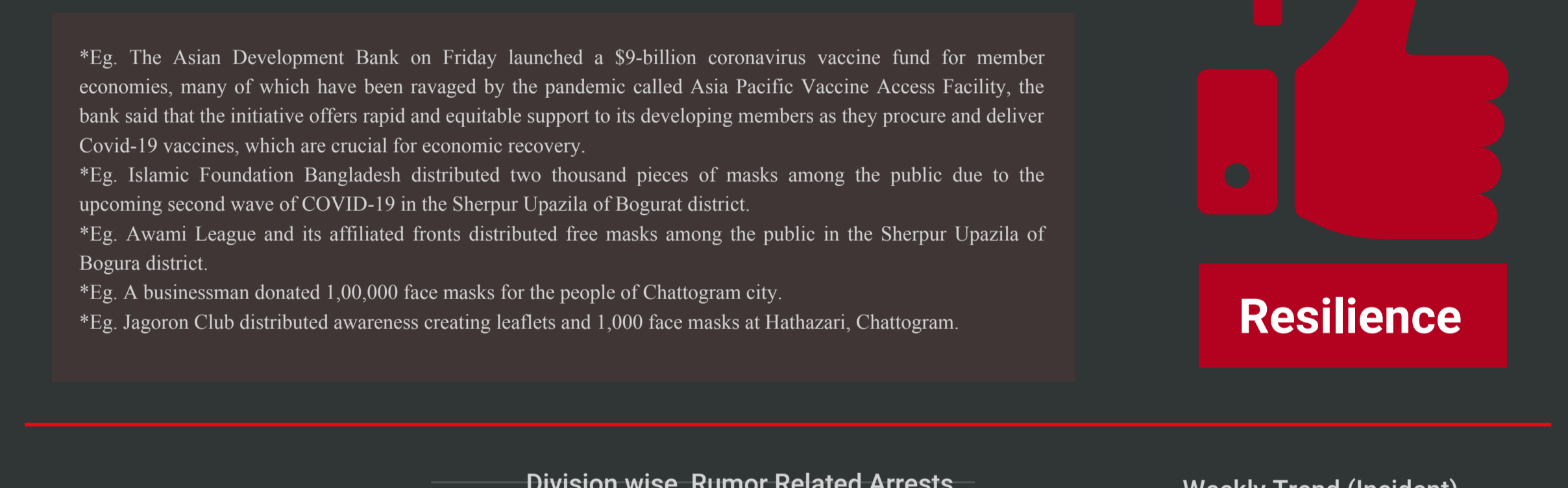
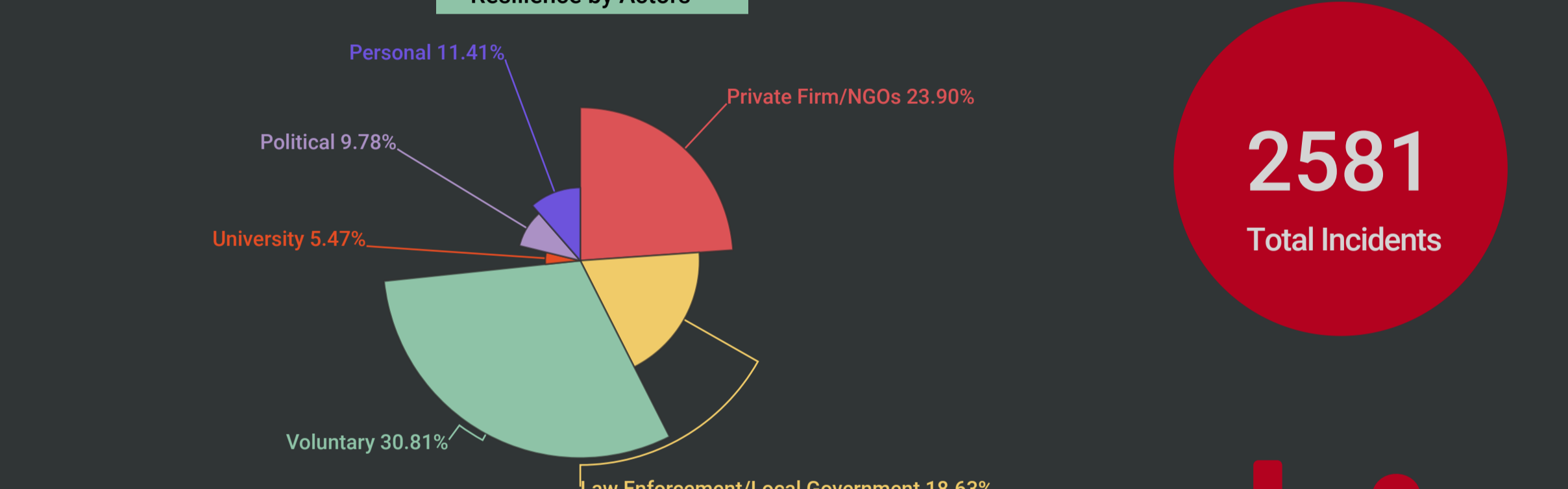
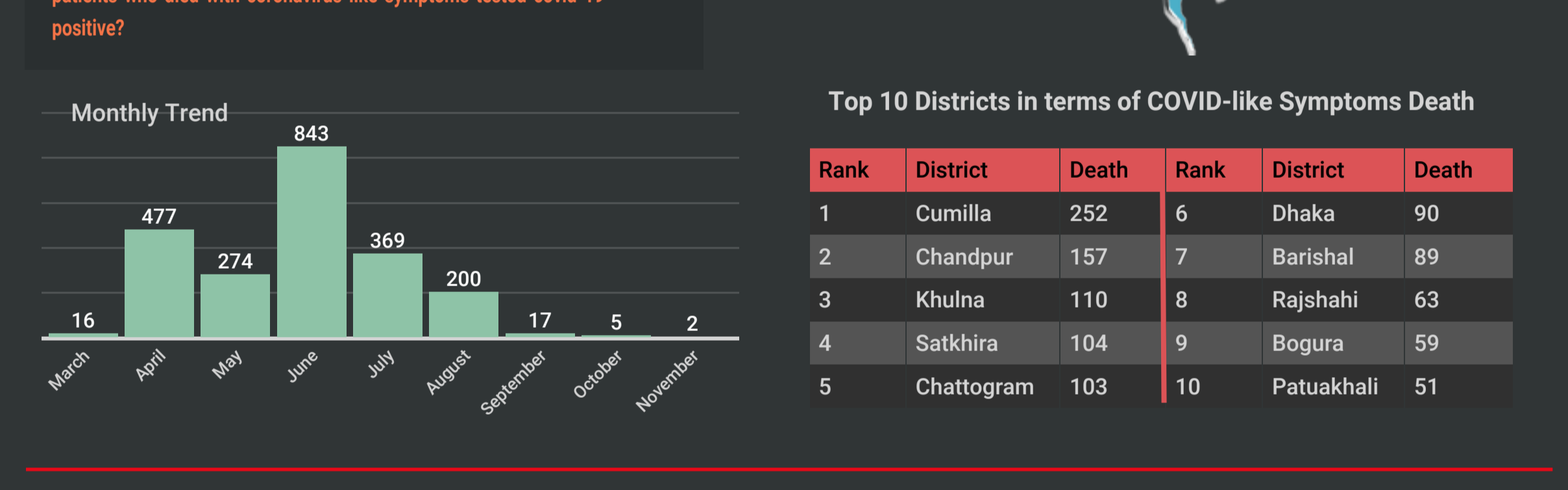
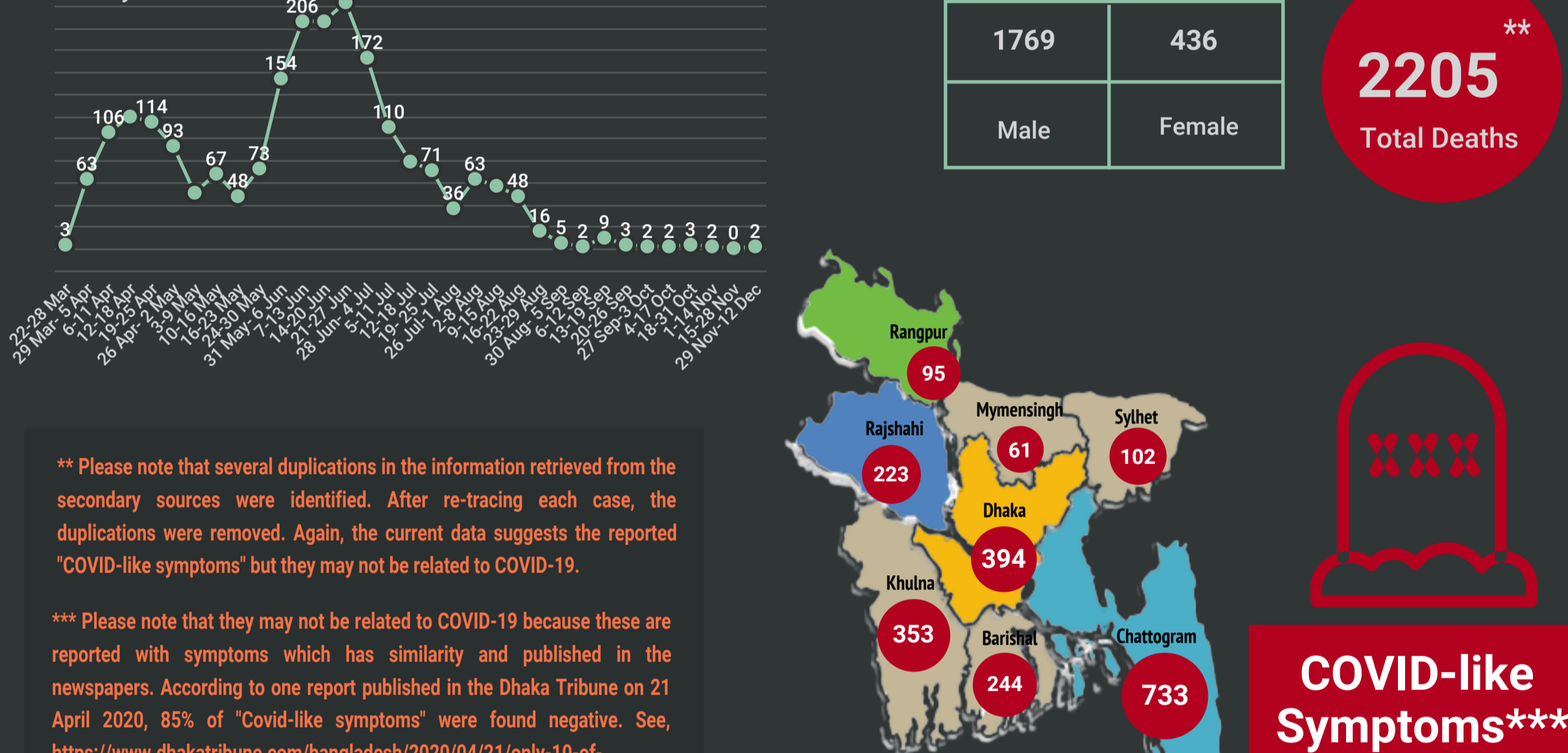
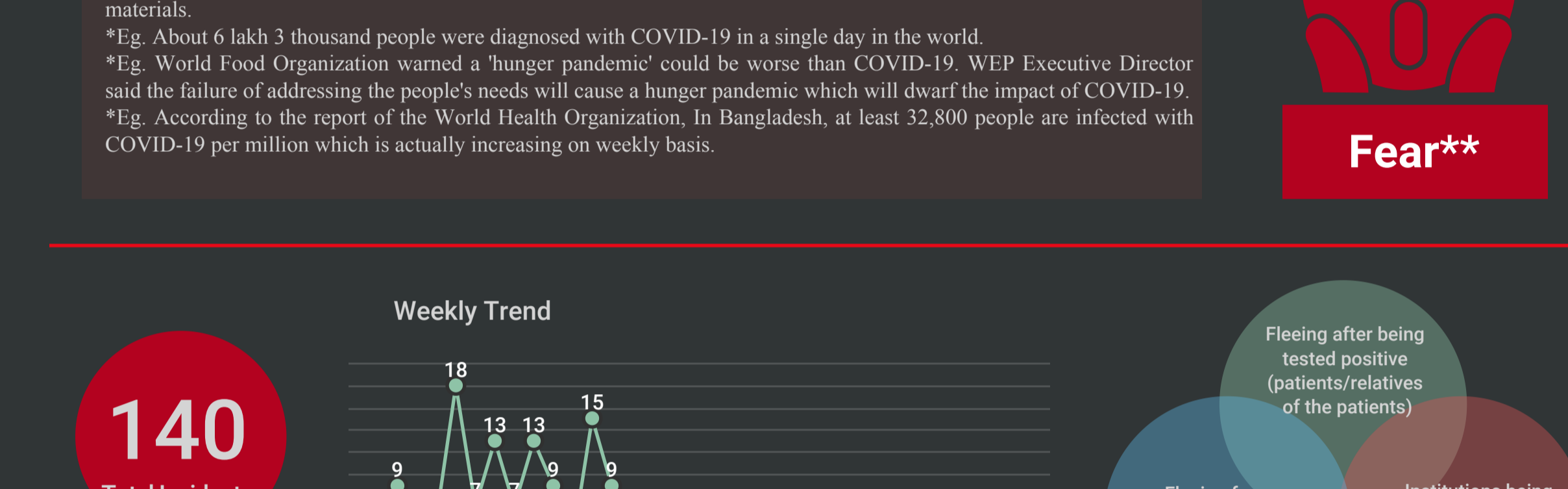
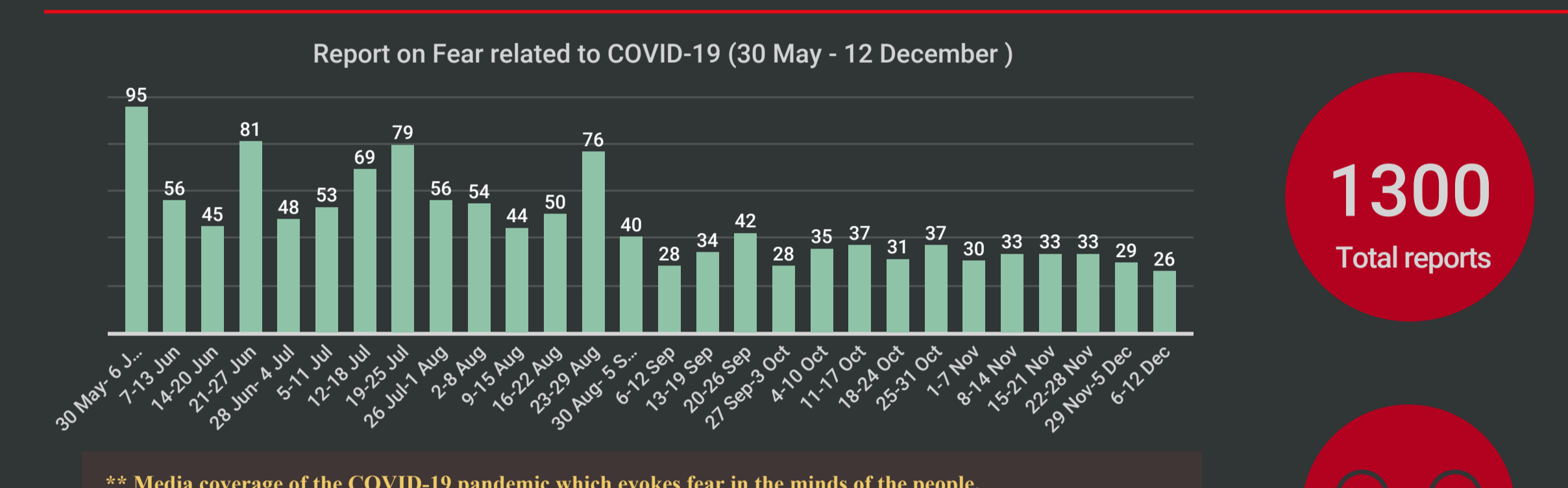
**Verbal Abuse/ Social Stigma**

\*Weekly Trend: There was no social stigma related news report associated with COVID-19 from 29 November 2020 to 12 December 2020.



\*Weekly Trend: Protest (1) associated with the COVID-19 pandemic is steadily on the decline from 29 November 2020 to 12 December 2020.

\*Eg. Doctors of Kuwait-Bangladesh Government Hospital dedicated to COVID-19 treatment held a sit-in protest at the hospital's Director's office as the authorities of the hotel allocated for their accommodation forced them out on 23 September 2020. Some agitated doctors protested against this and demanded to solve their accommodation immediately.
