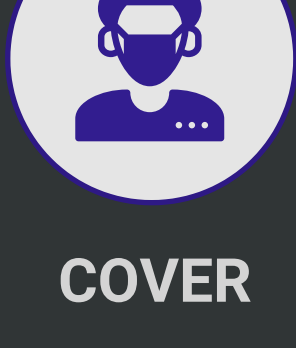

COVID-19 Prevention Tips



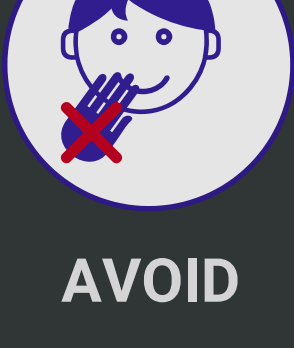
WASH

Wash your hands frequently using soap for at least 20 seconds or sanitise them using alcohol-based handrub.



COVER

Use tissues when you cough or sneeze and dispose them immediately in a closed bin. Use flexed-elbow if tissue is unavailable.



AVOID

Avoid touching your mouth, eyes and nose, especially after contact with any surface.



DISTANCE

Practice social distancing by not shaking hands, hugging, etc.



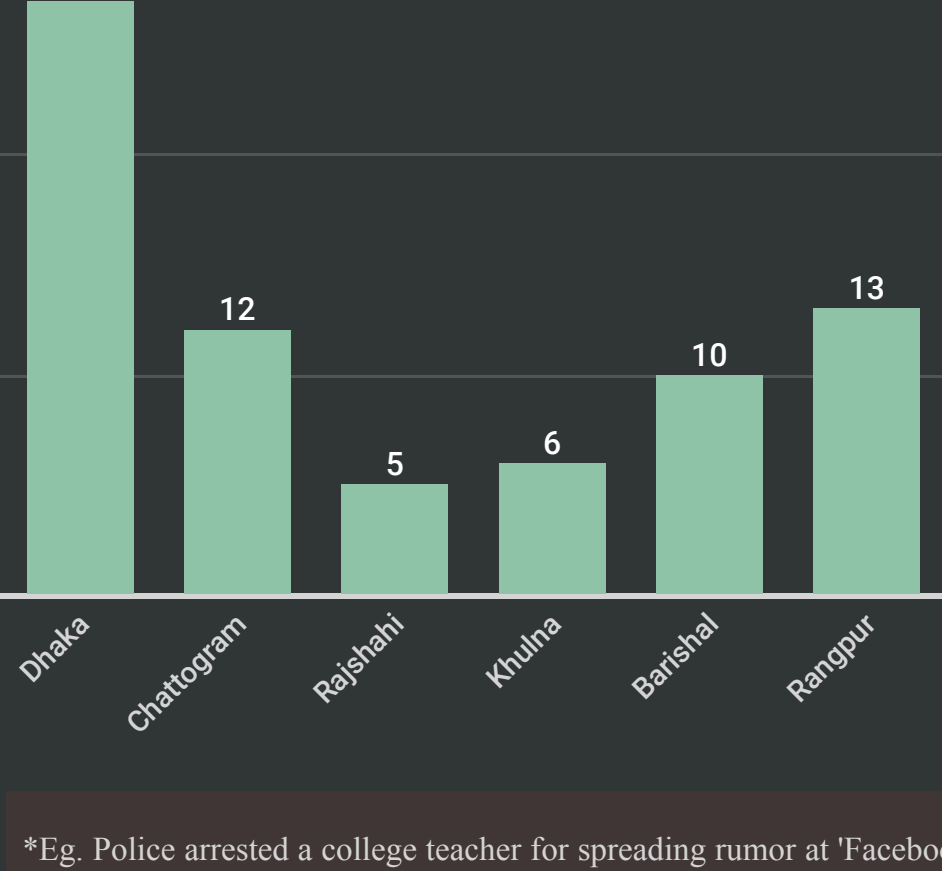
ISOLATE

Stay at home if you become ill and help prevent its spread.

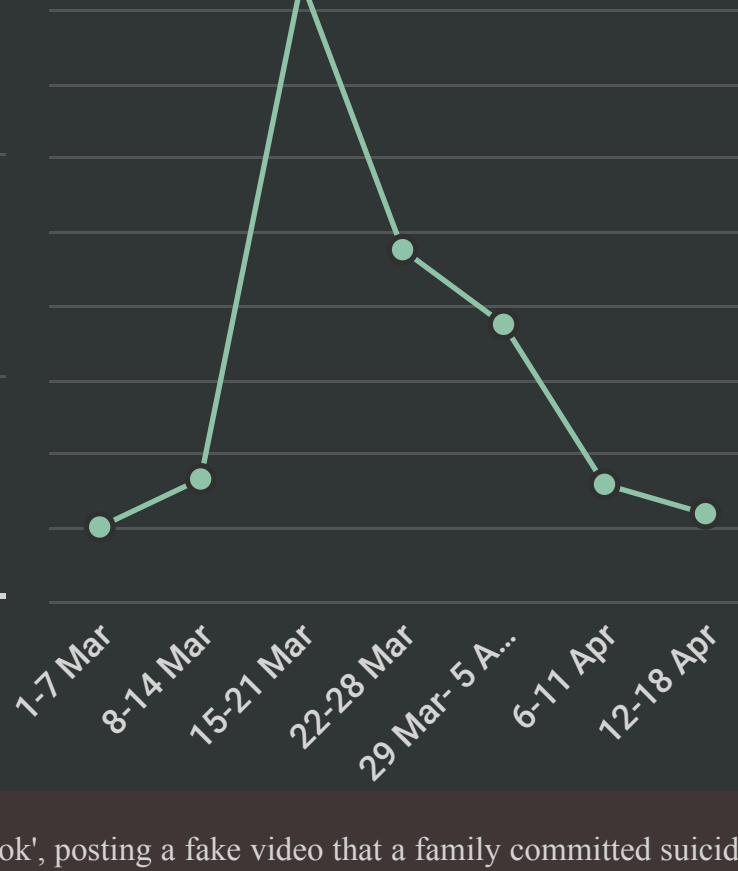
Covid-19 Related Incident Mapping in Bangladesh

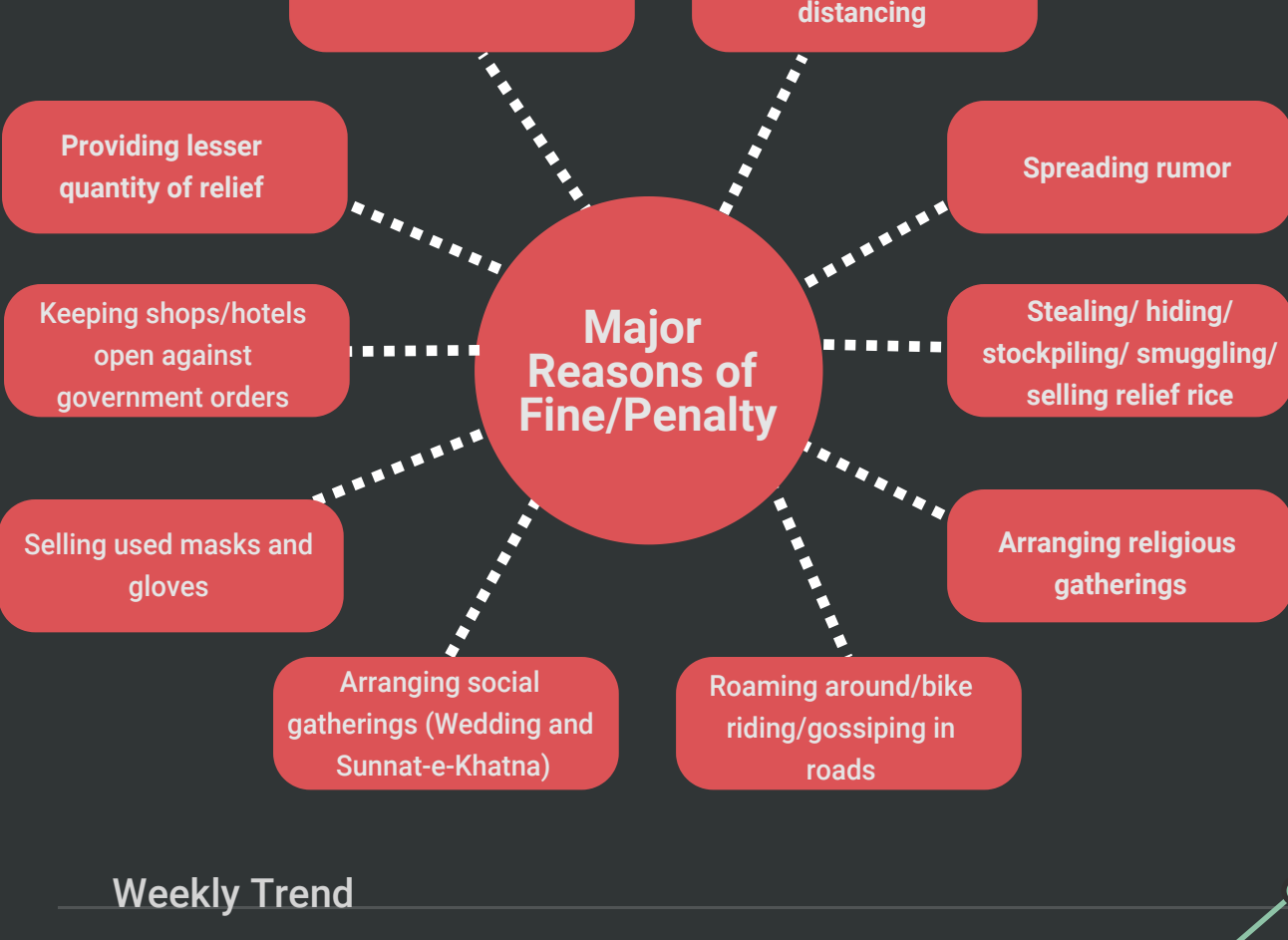

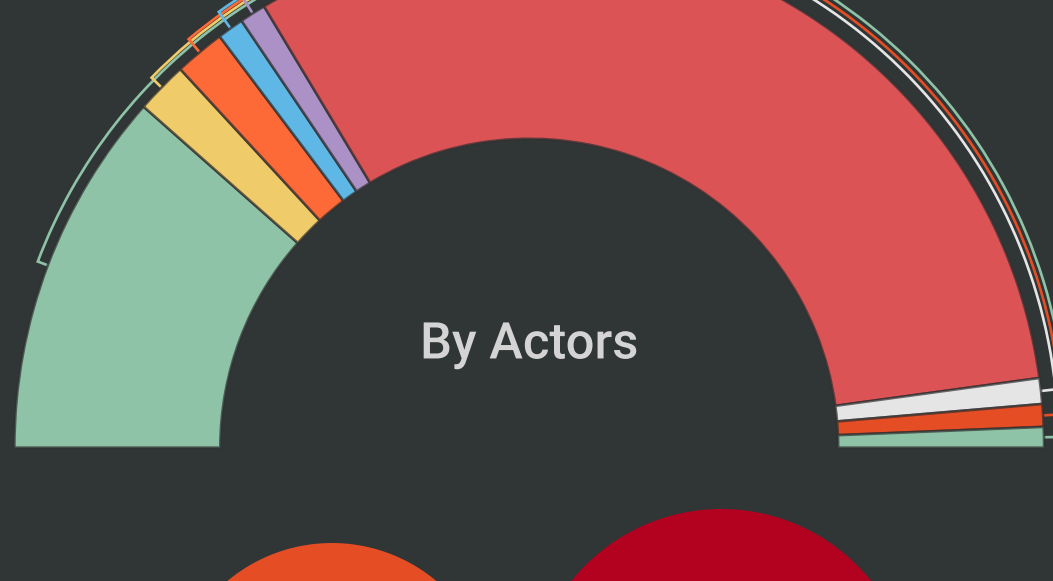
Rumors

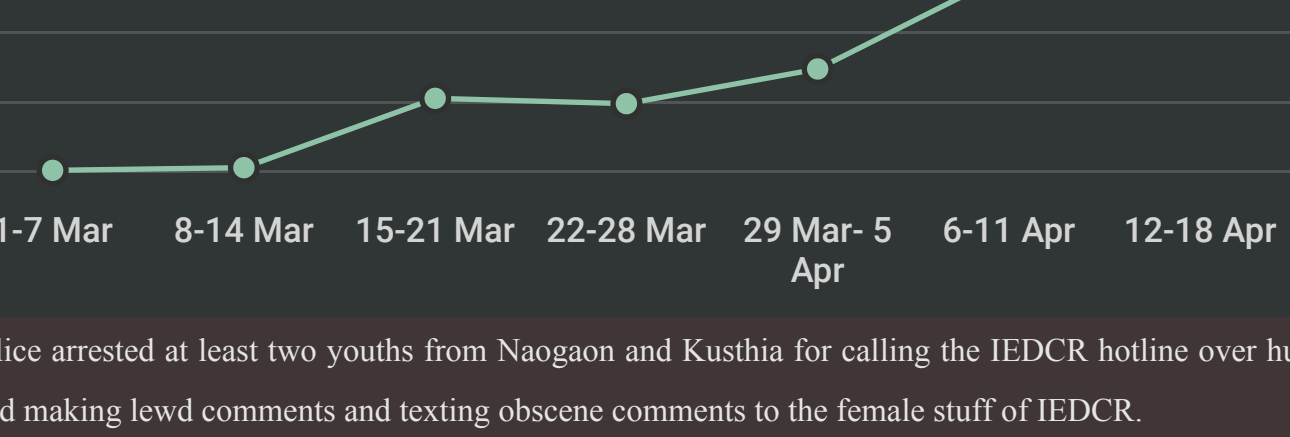

*Eg. Police arrested at least two youths from Naogaon and Kusthia for calling the IEDCR hotline over hundred times and making lewd comments and texting obscene comments to the female staff of IEDCR.
 *Eg. Police detained more than 500 people on the entryward of Narayanganj while they tried to escape from the city as they were suffering badly with the lack of food and financial support. Later police send them back to their home.
 *Eg. Ministry of Local Government closed four Union Parishad Chairman and five members allegedly for corruption.

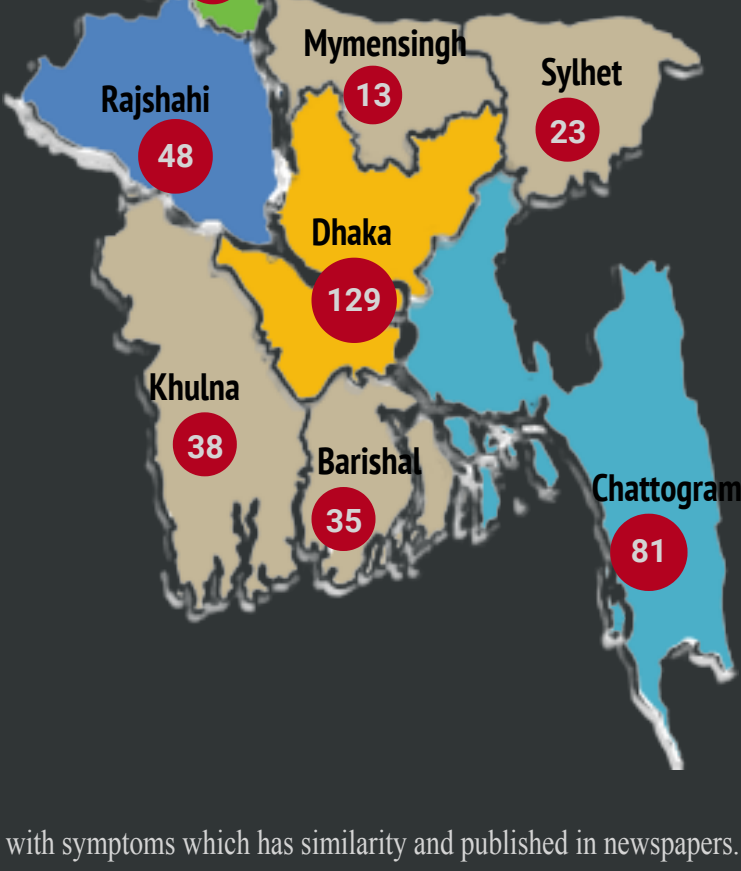
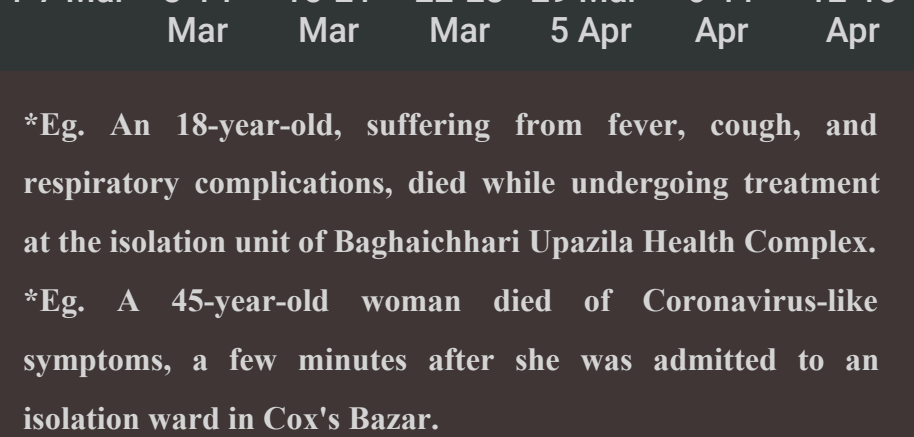


Verbal Abuse/ Social Stigma



*Eg. A woman was thrown in the forest after being suspected as a COVID patient by her husband and children in Tangail.
 *Eg. A civil engineer (52) had died with breathing problems as no hospital admitted him for treatments and he died without any kind of treatment in Savar, Dhaka.
 *Eg. In Gazipur Sadar, an elderly woman died but her family denied to receive her dead body as they were afraid that she was infected with COVID 19.
 *Eg. A landlord has been accused of expelling a female doctor from home in Noakhali.

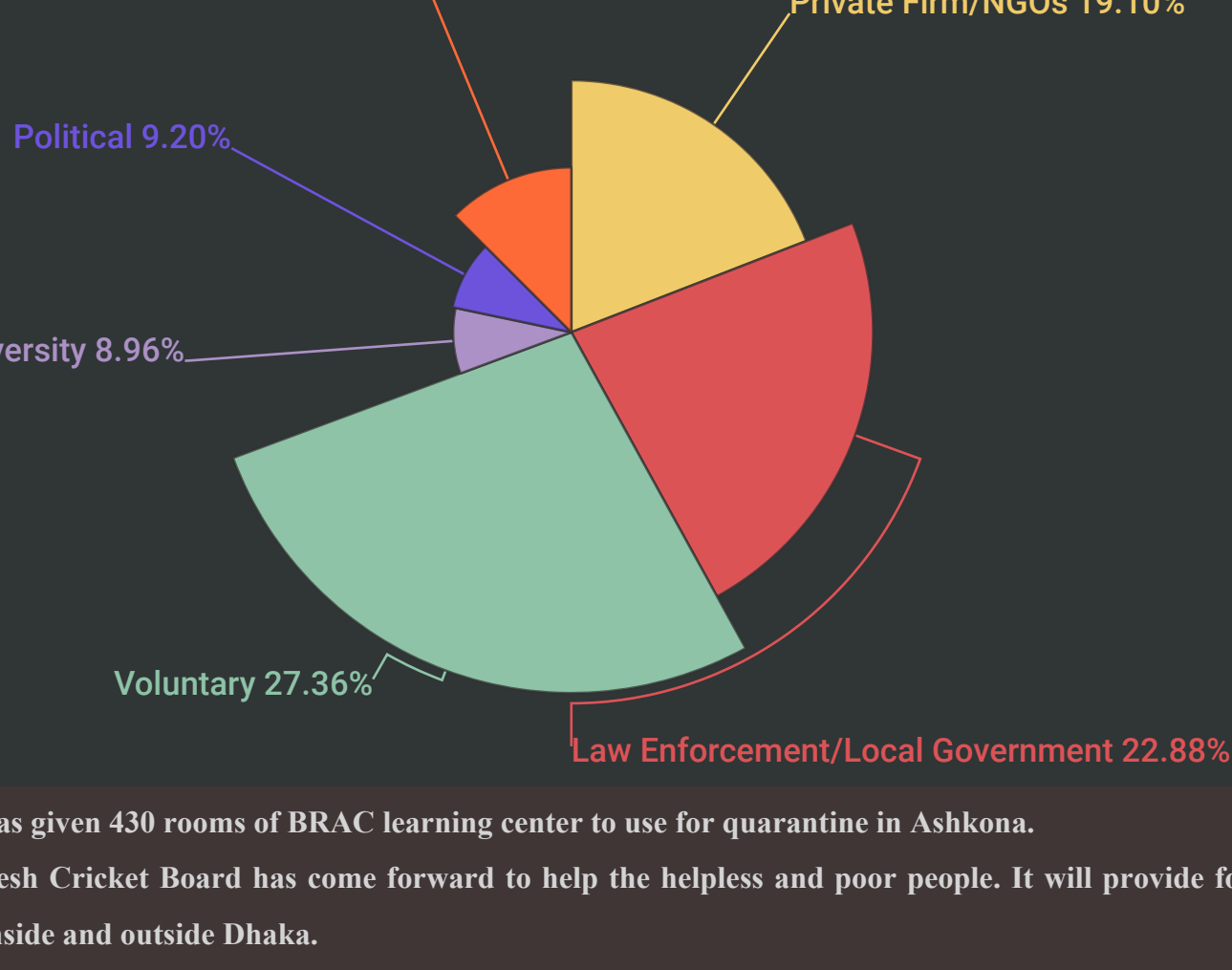

Paranoia

*Eg. As the number of Corona victims are increasing in Dhaka and Narayanganj, residents of these areas are fleeing or trying to return to their respective villages by truck, rented microbus and sometimes using the riverways.
 *Eg. Fear spread among people after a rickshaw puller died at his own rickshaw suffering from severe cardio-respiratory distress, suspecting him as a COVID-19 patient. Later Civil Service and Police recovered the dead body at Chapainavabganj district town.
 *Eg. People in a village in Bogura became panicked after hearing that a person has returned from Dhaka with Coronavirus symptoms.
 *Eg. In Manikganj Sadar, a man died with COVID 19 symptoms. Locals were afraid to collect his body while the administration buried his body. His sample was collected for the test.
 *Eg. A man carrying coronavirus symptom, fled away while the medical team came to the home in Noakhali.

Resilience

*Eg. BRAC has given 430 rooms of BRAC learning center to use for quarantine in Ashkona.
 *Eg. Bangladesh Cricket Board has come forward to help the helpless and poor people. It will provide food for 20,000 people both inside and outside Dhaka.
 *Eg. Members of Army Bangladesh installed anti-COVID-19 booth in Jashore Sadar Upazila, Jashore.
 *Eg. Dhaka University Teachers' Association decided to help poor students.
 *Eg. A businessman distributed necessary food items among 1000 peoples in Keshabpur, Jashore.
 *Eg. 300 PPE have been provided to the Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujib Medical College and Hospital by the Awami League in Dhaka.

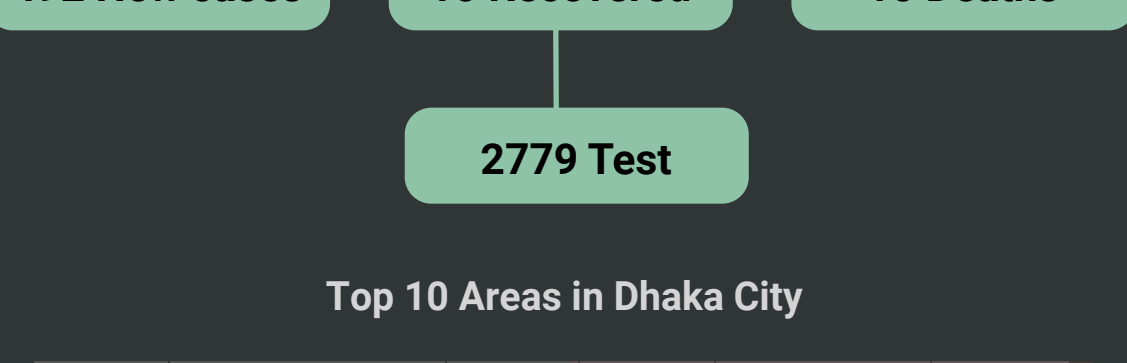

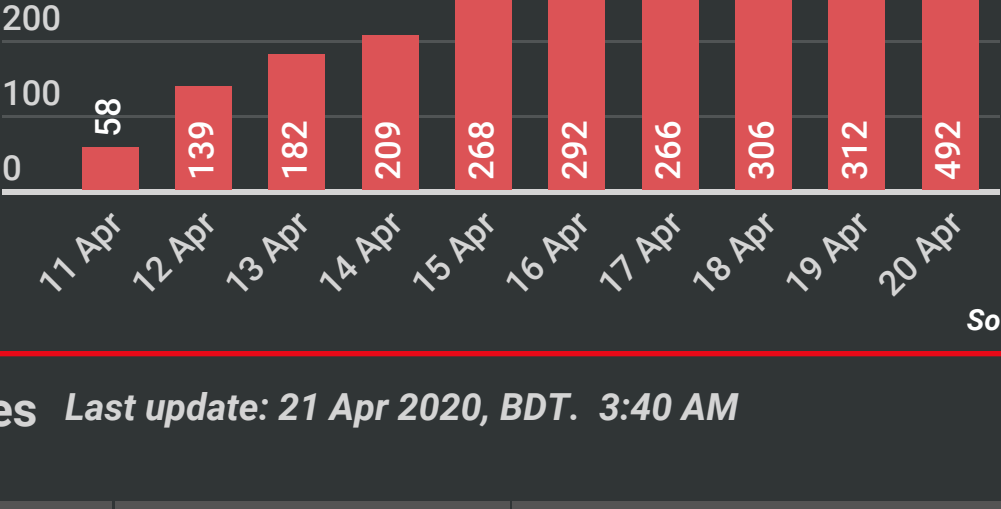

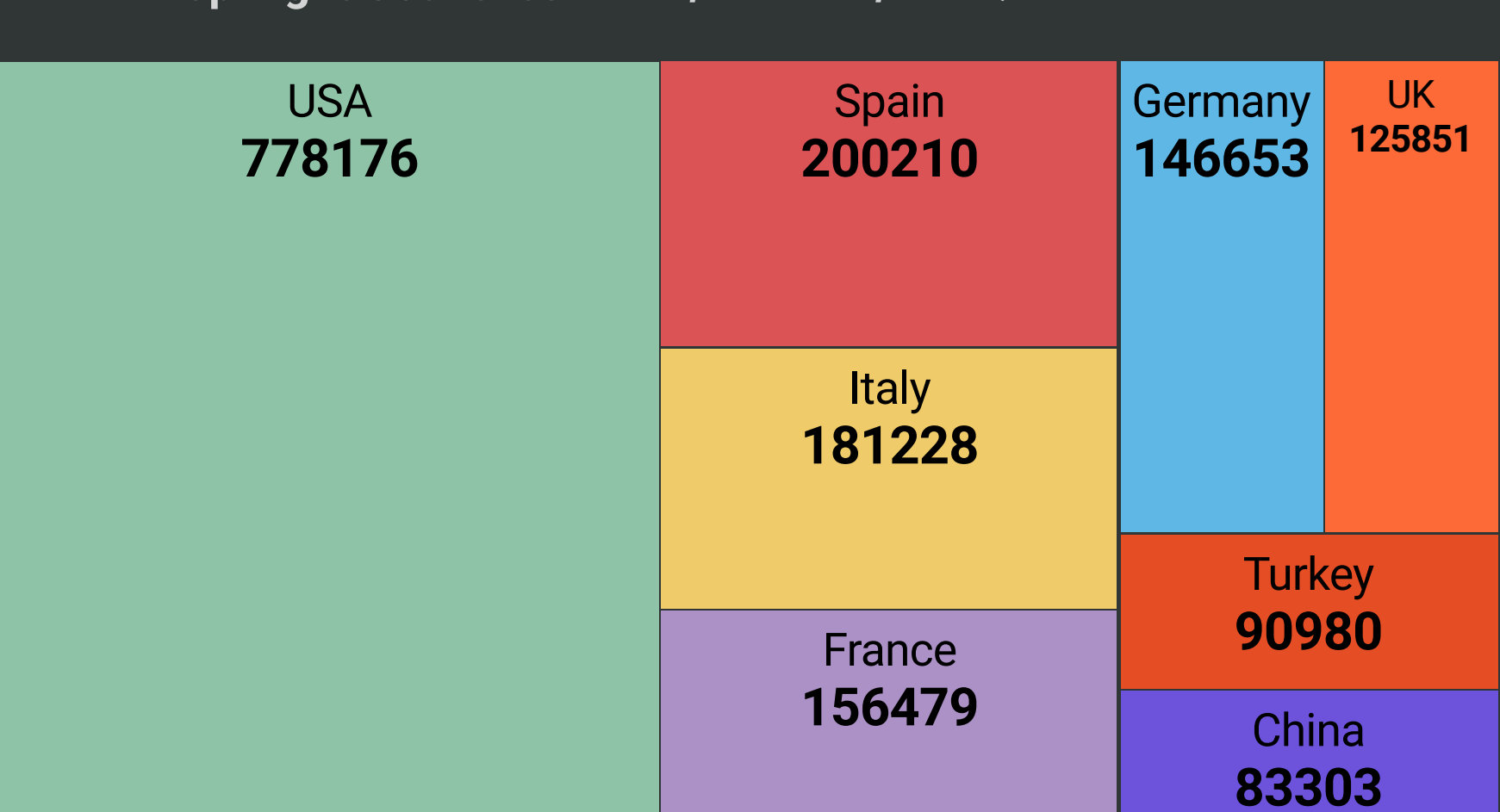
