COVID-19 Prevention Tips



WASH

COVER

ISOLATE

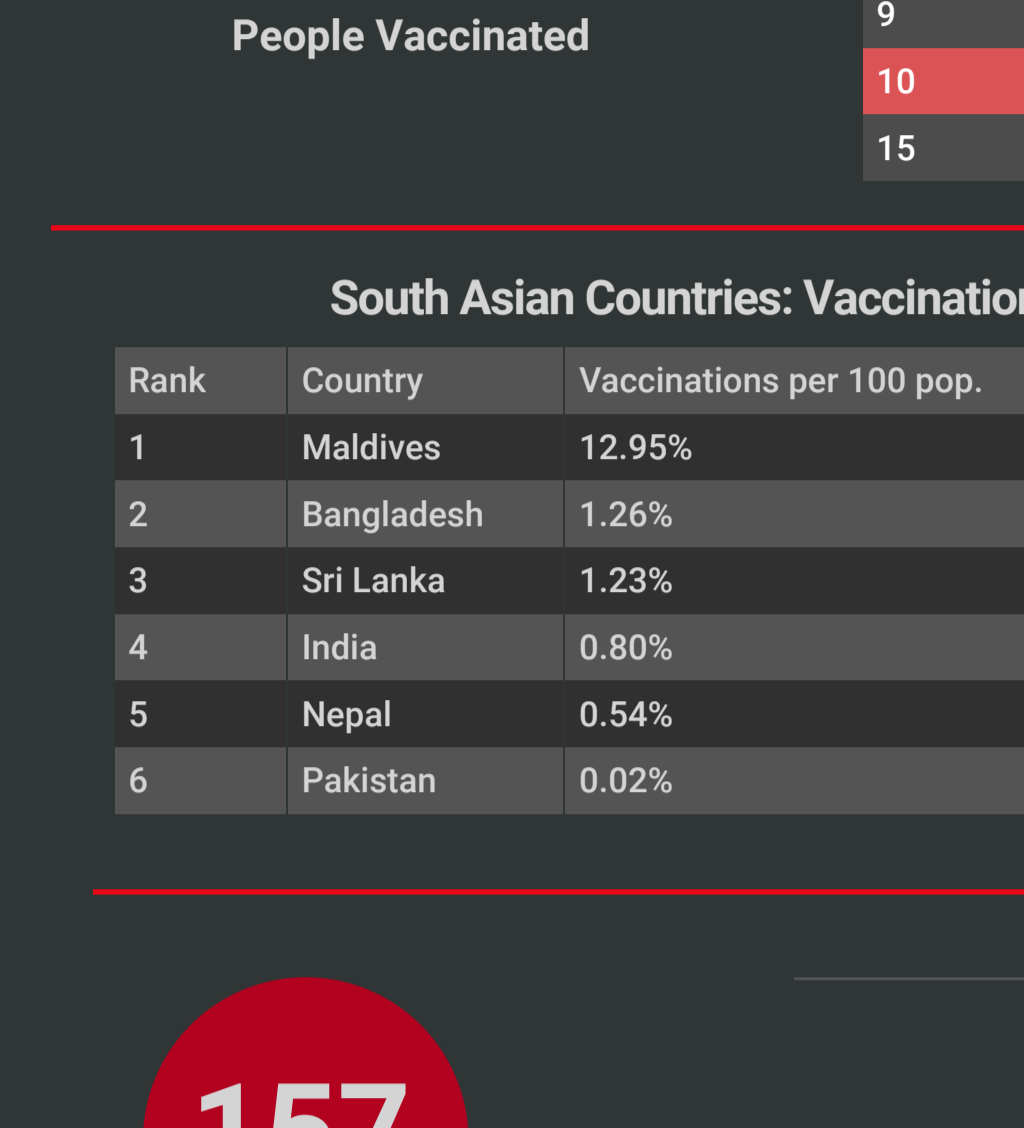
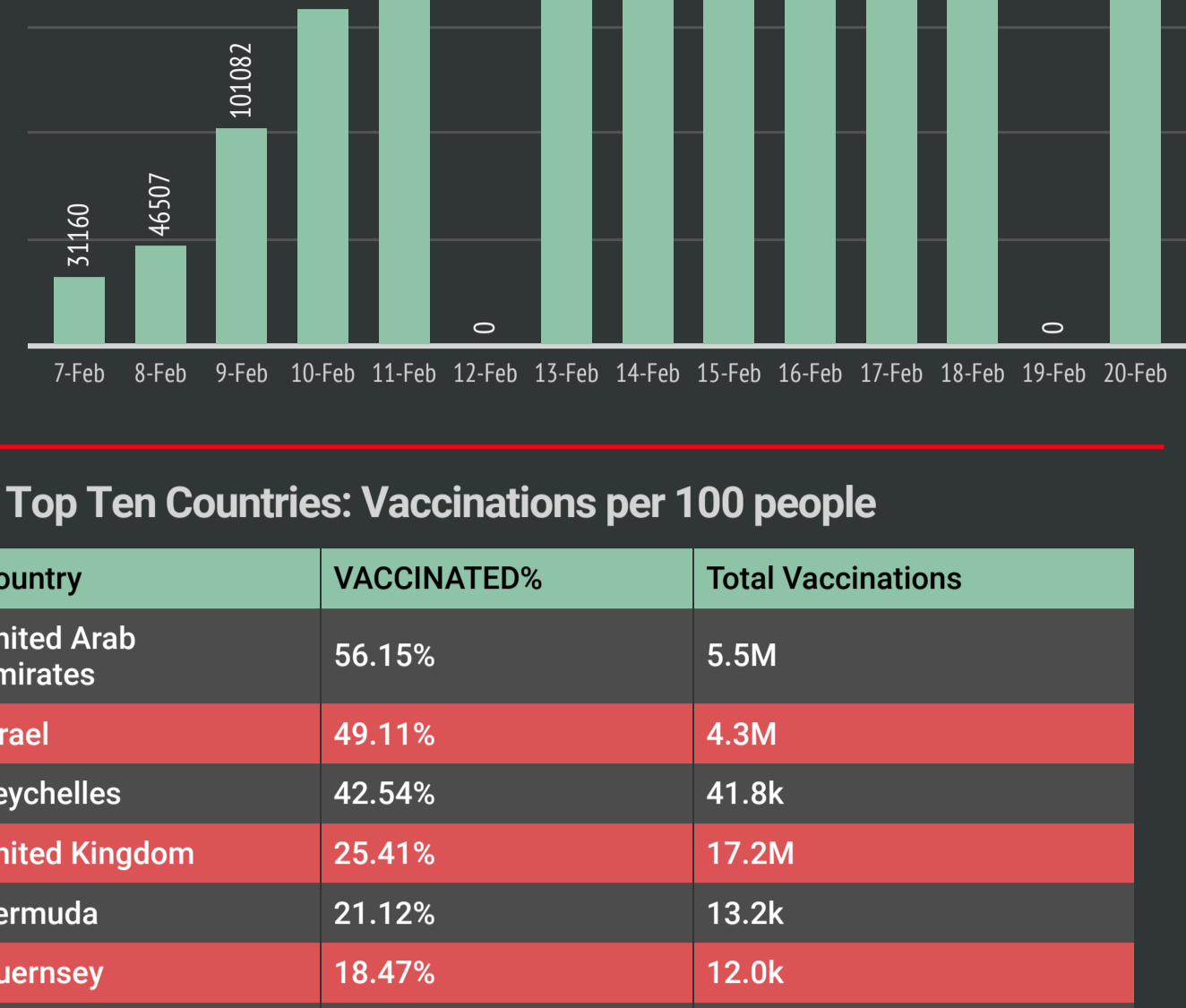
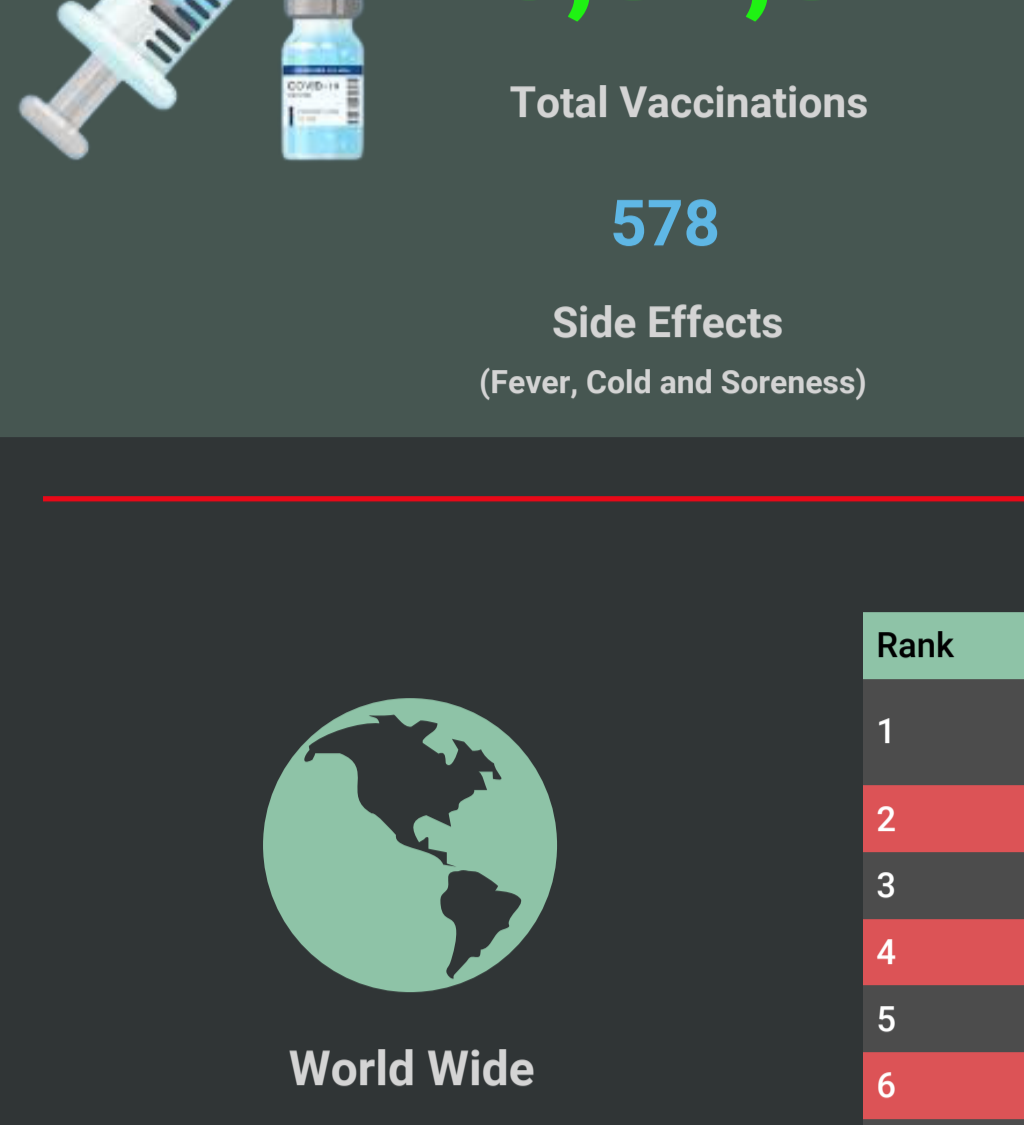
Stay at home if you become ill and help prevent its spread.

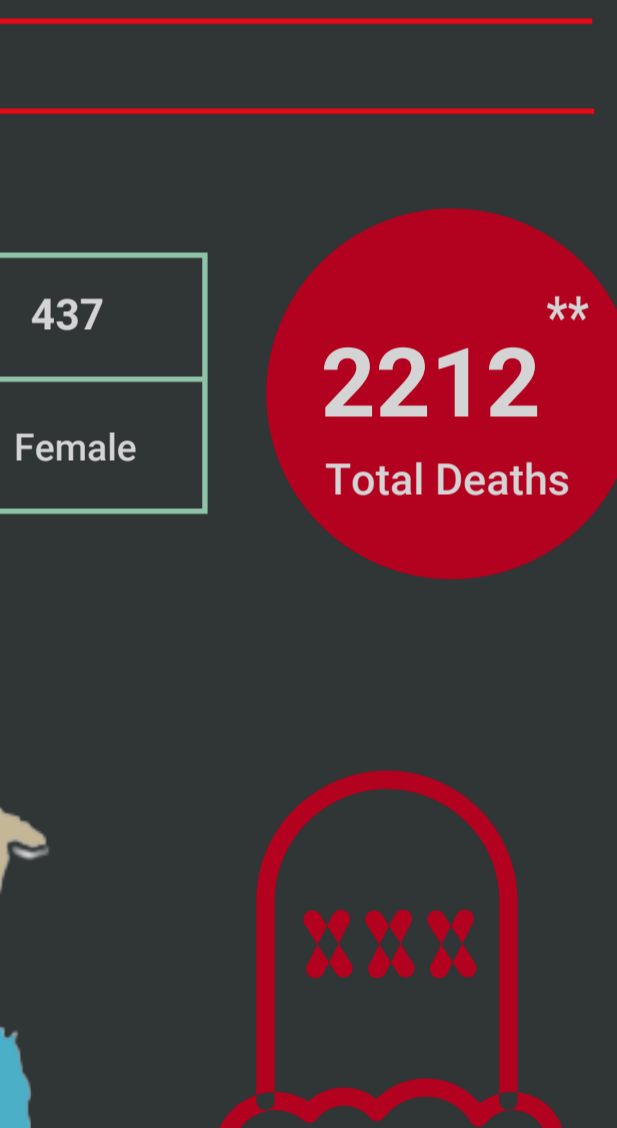
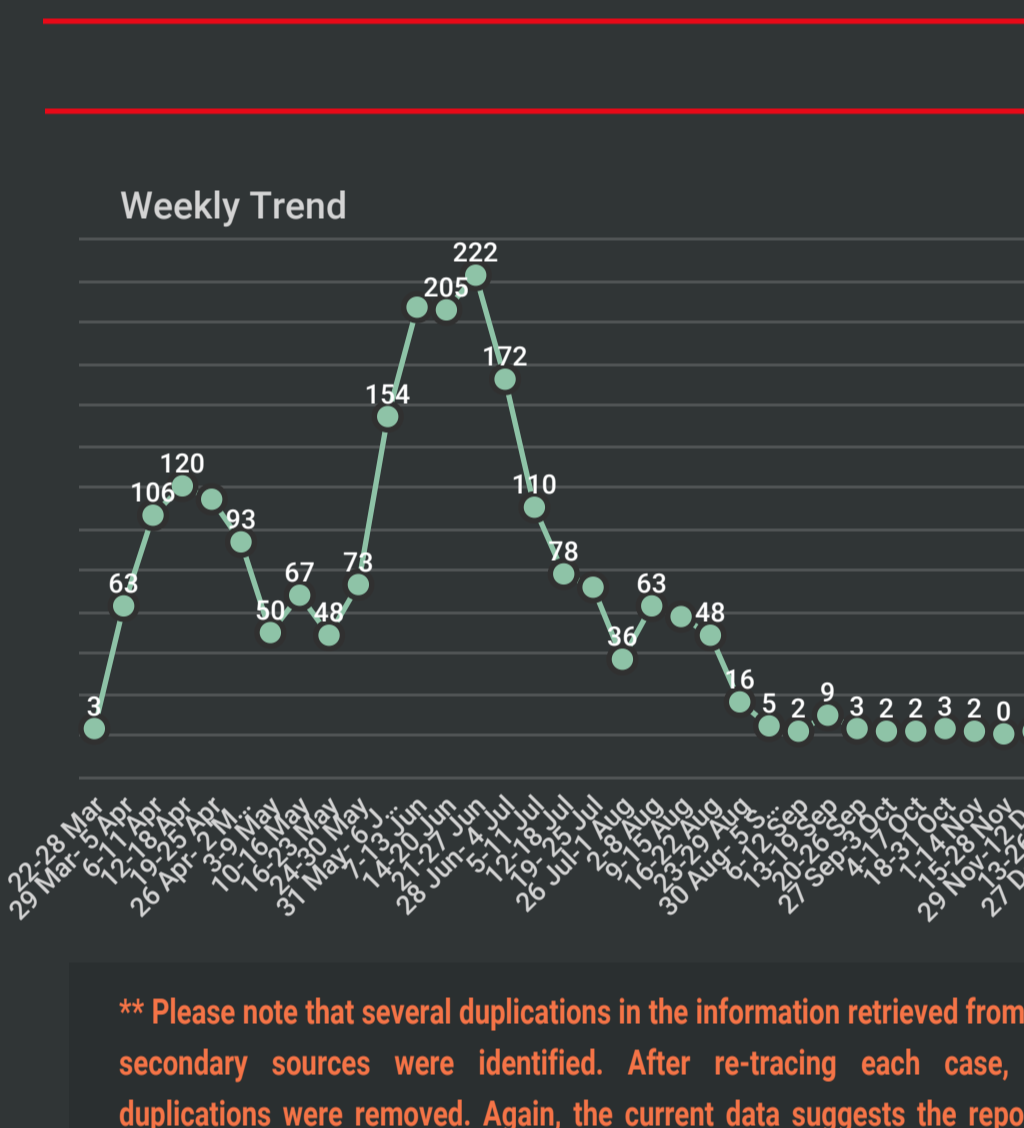
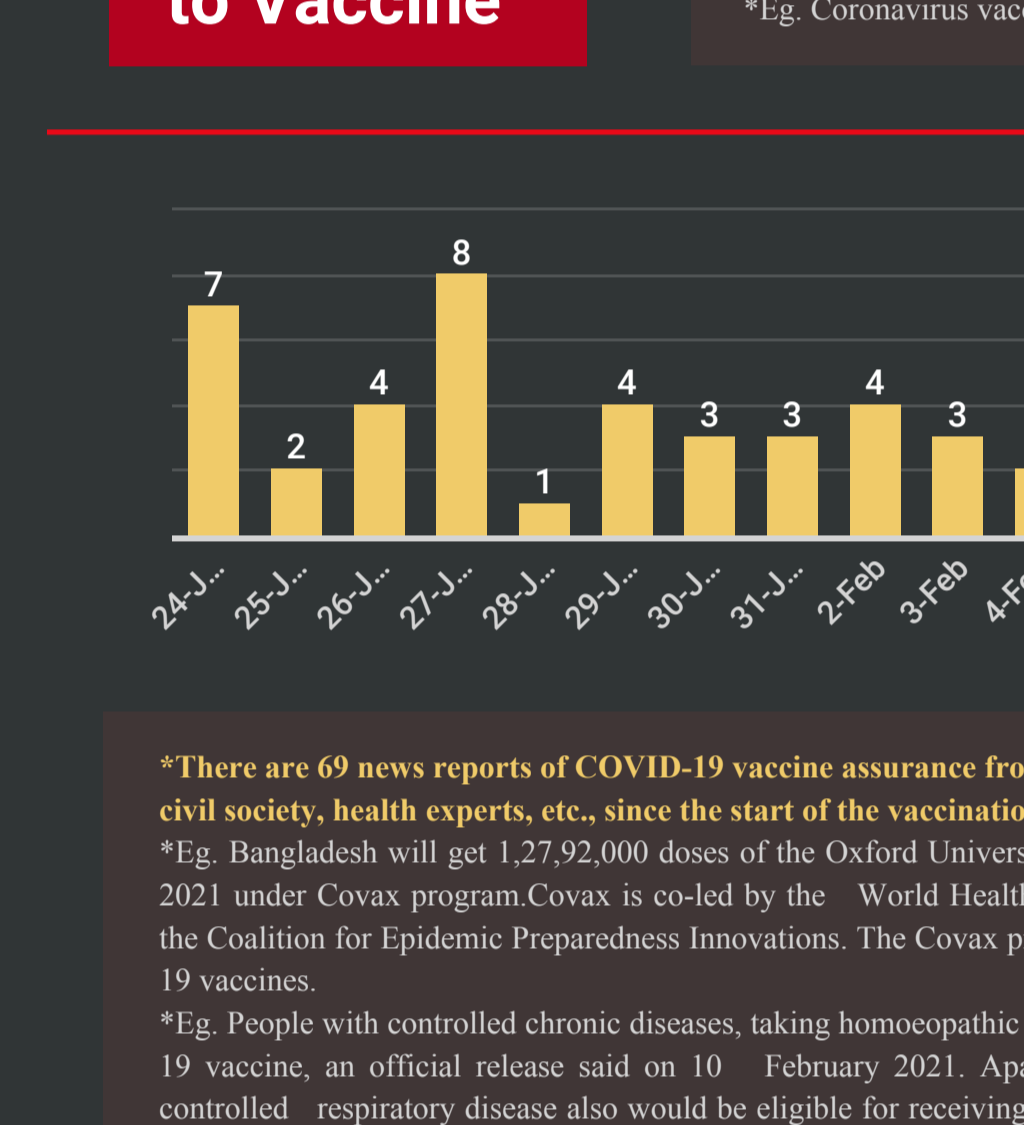


*There are 157 news reports associated with the COVID-19 vaccine roll-out since the start of the Bangladesh vaccination process.

*Eg. Bangladesh received the first lot of the purchased Oxford-AstraZeneca Covid-19 vaccines from the Serum Institute of India (SII), with its first consignment landing in Dhaka on 25 January 2021 morning. Nine freezer vans carried five million dosages from the airport that arrived in boxes by a special Air India flight from Mumbai airport around 11 am.

*Eg. Bangladesh is set to begin its COVID-19 vaccination campaign today by inoculating 25 frontline healthcare providers, freedom fighters, journalists and law enforcers at Kurmitola General Hospital in the capital.

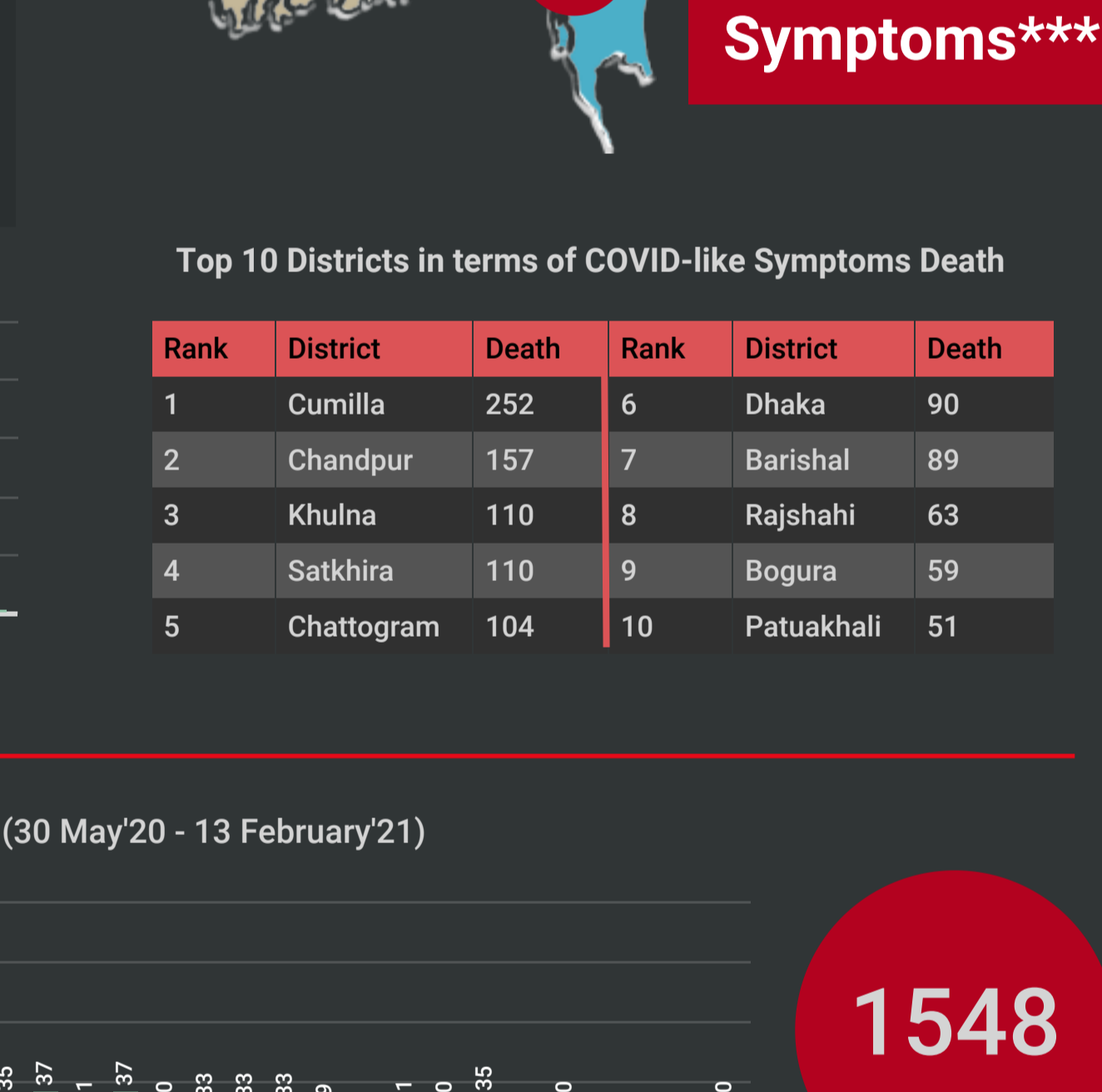
*Eg. Bangladesh is set to kick off its mass vaccination against COVID-19 across the country tomorrow as the health authorities said they had found no serious side effects among the 567 people in the weeklong observation after they were vaccinated in the first run on 27-28 January.



*There are 69 news reports of COVID-19 vaccine assurance from different stakeholders, including the government, civil society, health experts, etc., since the start of the vaccination process in Bangladesh.

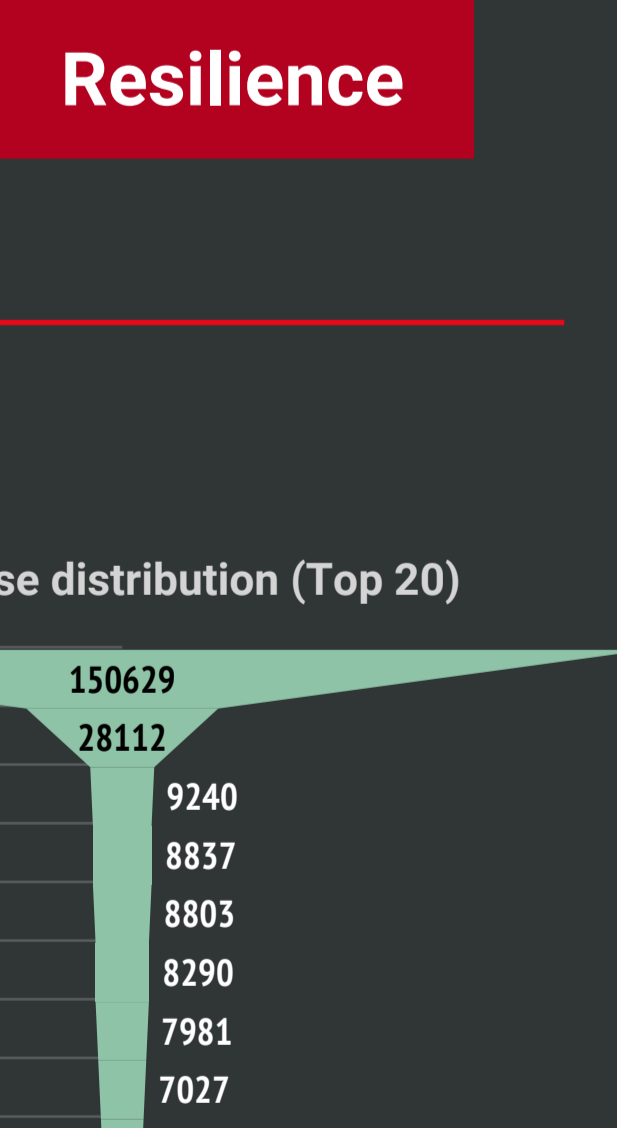
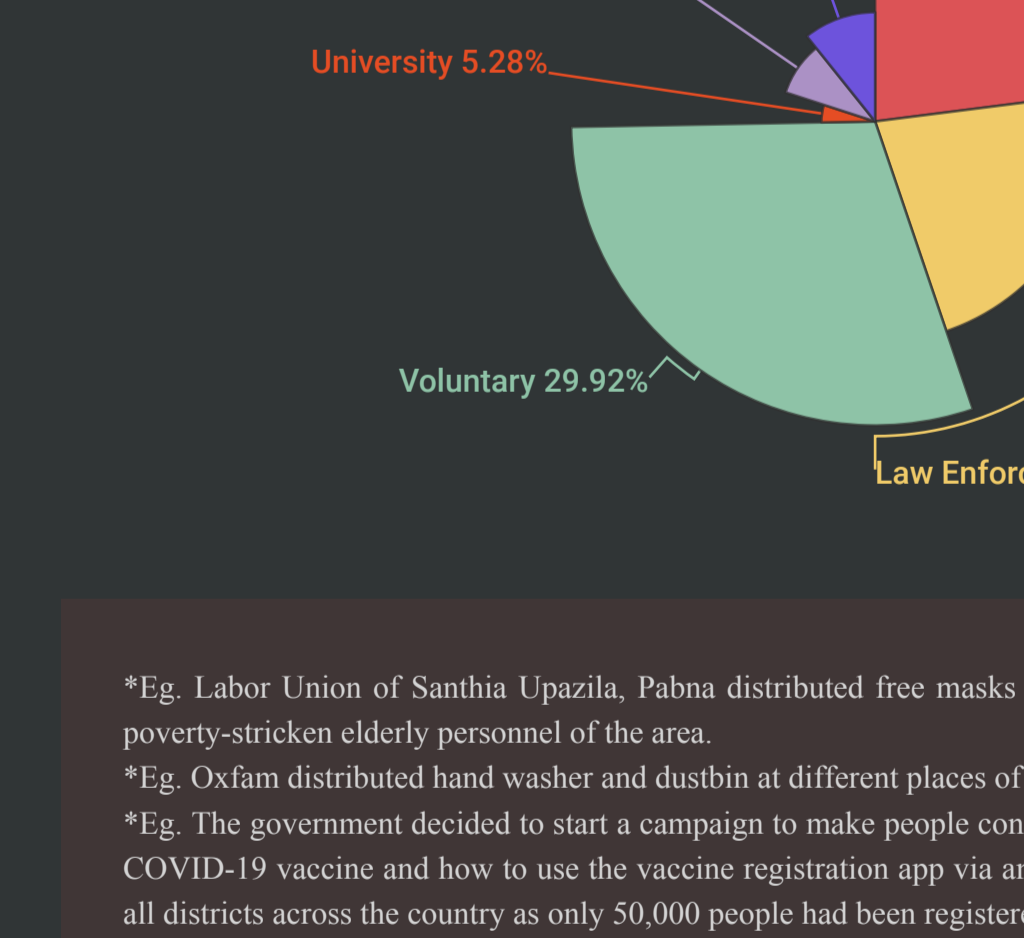
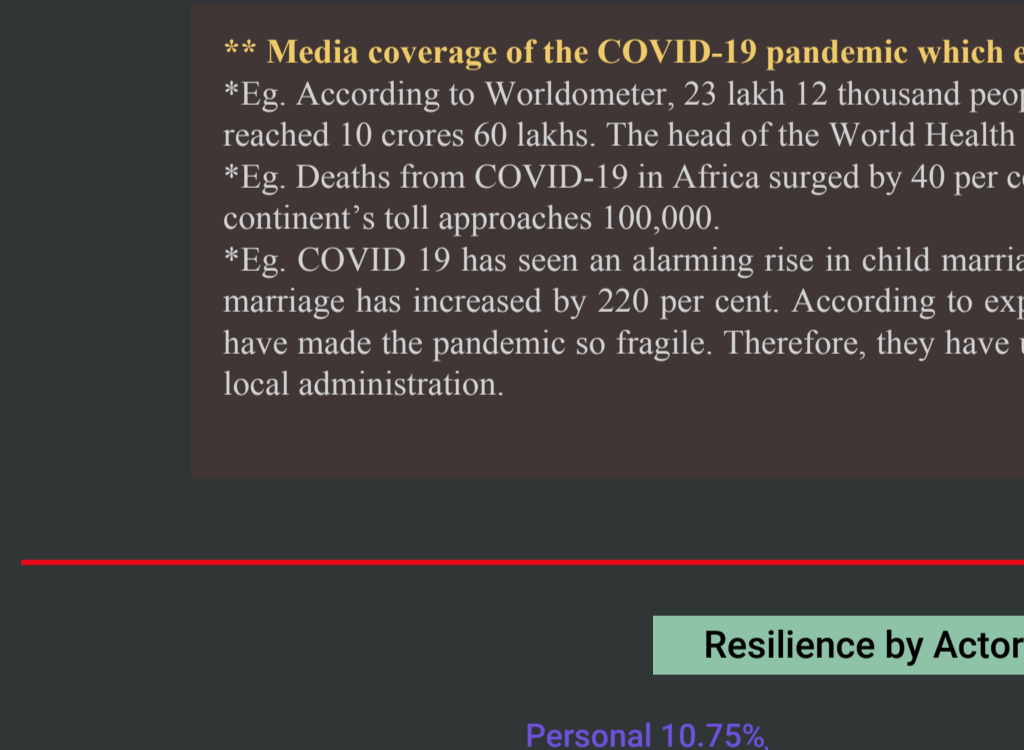
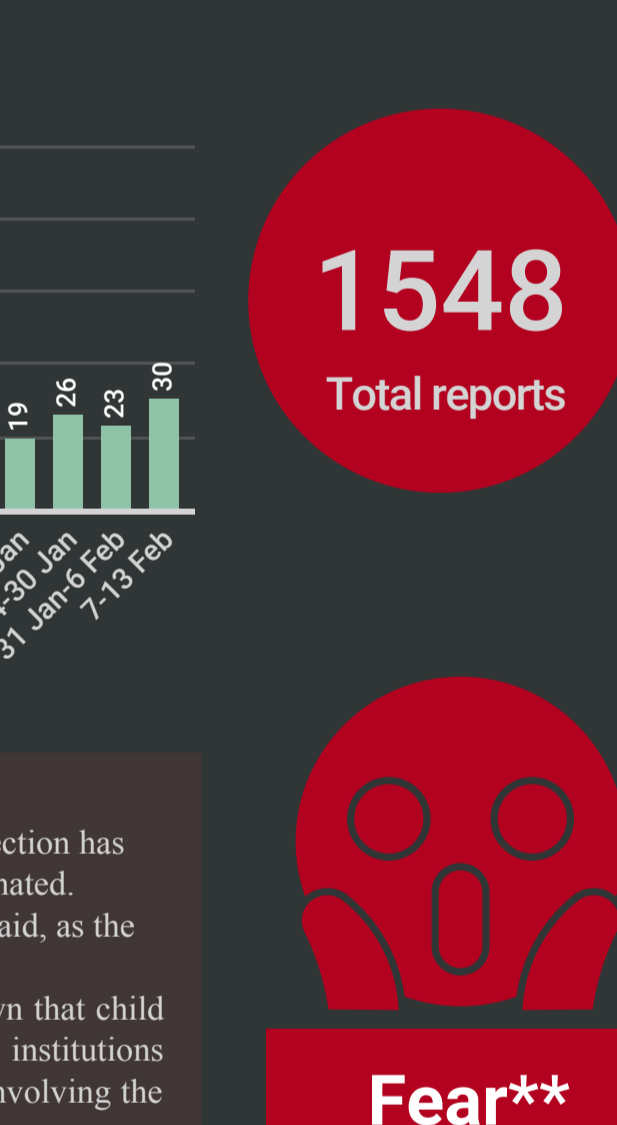
*Eg. Bangladesh will get 1,27,92,000 doses of the Oxford University-AstraZeneca COVID-19 vaccine in the first half of 2021 under Covax program. Covax is co-led by the World Health Organization (WHO), the Gavi vaccine alliance, and the Coalition for Epidemic Preparedness Innovations. The Covax program to ensure equitable worldwide access to COVID-19 vaccines.

*Eg. People with controlled chronic diseases, taking homoeopathic and/or traditional medicine can now receive the Covid-19 vaccine, an official release said on 10 February 2021. Apart from controlled chronic diseases, people with the controlled respiratory disease also would be eligible for receiving coronavirus inoculations, it said adding along with a priority group of people, different professionals.

*Eg. Labor Union of Santhia Upazila, Pabna distributed free masks and food, and walking sticks among the poverty-stricken elderly personnel of the area.

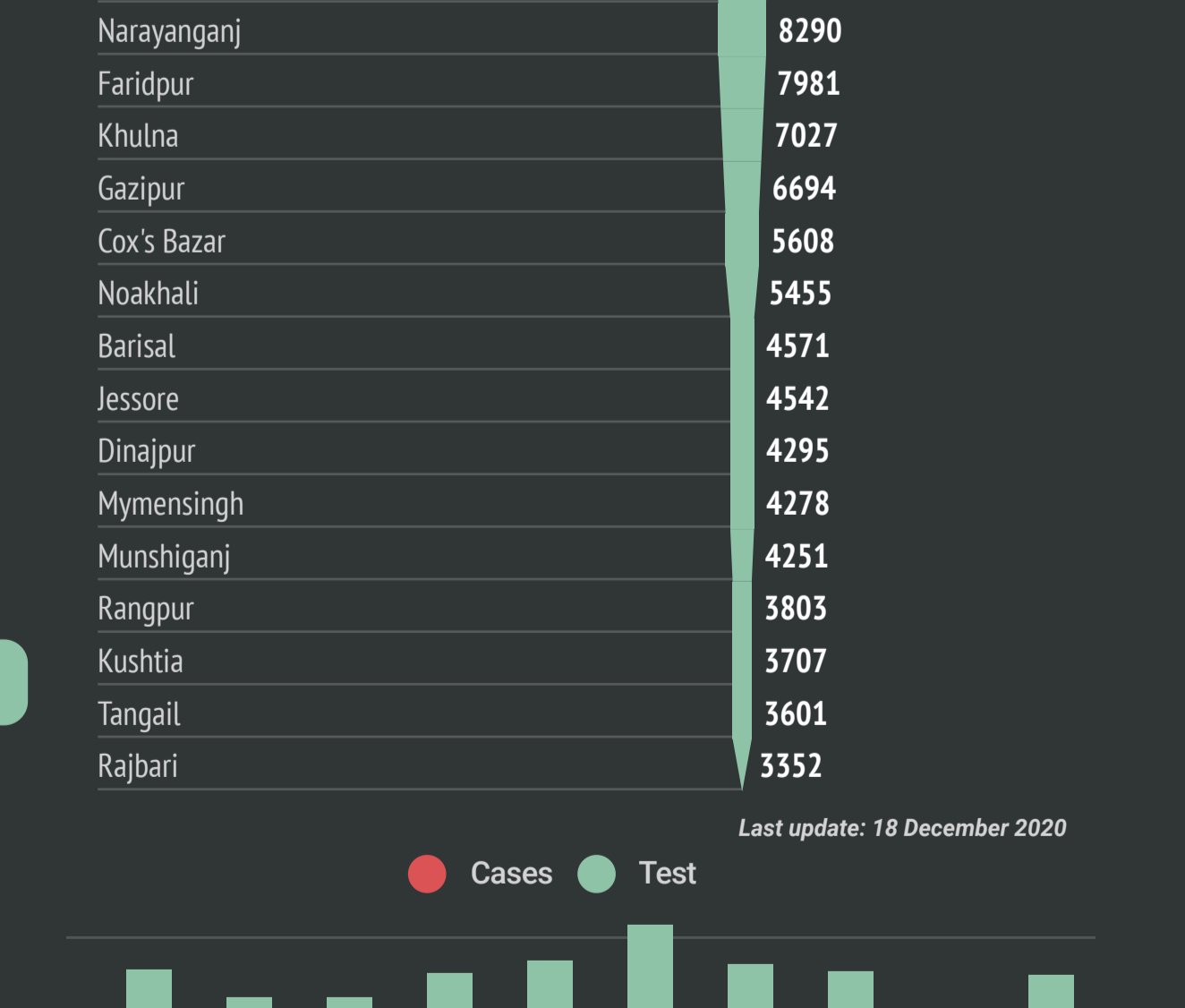
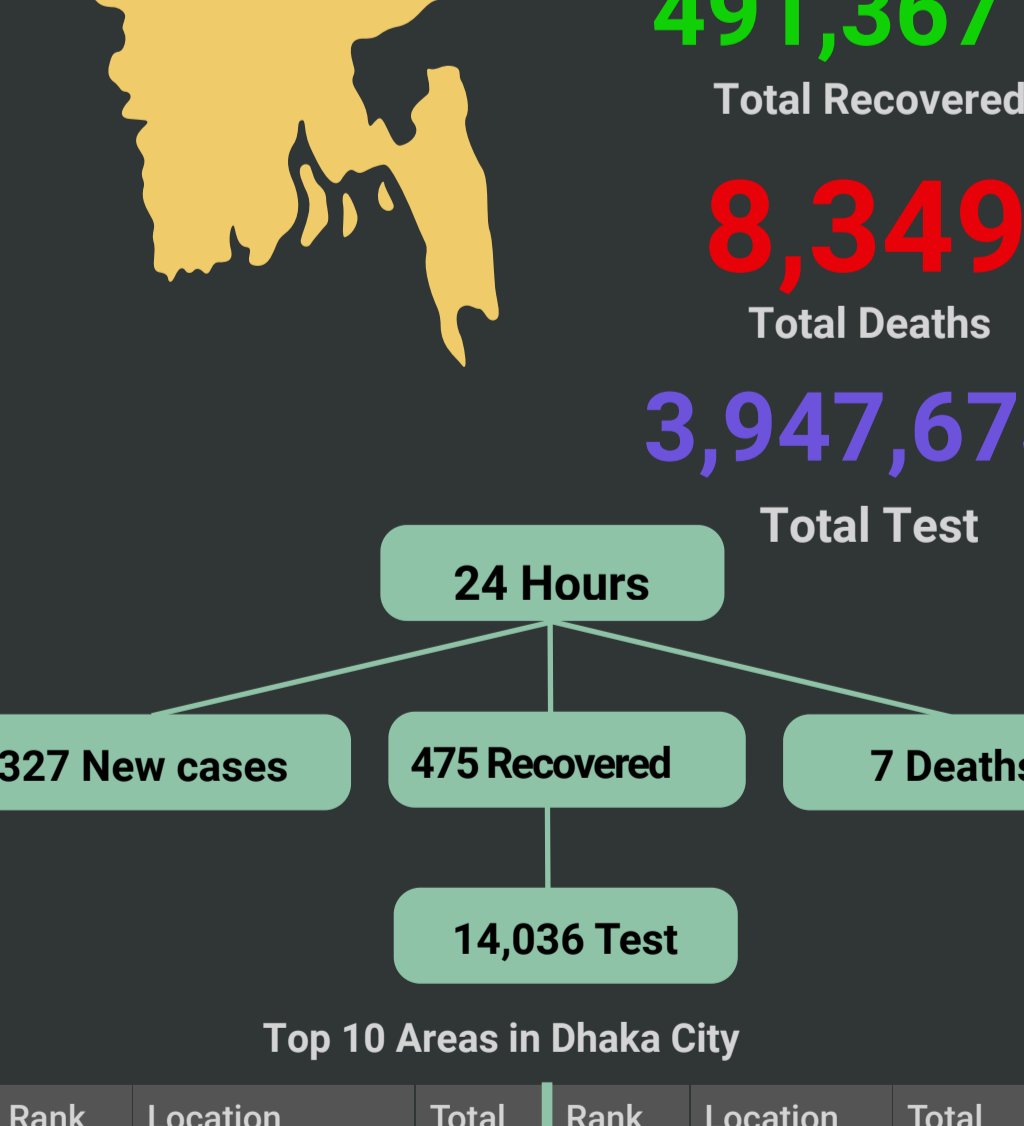
*Eg. Oxfam distributed hand washer and dustbin at different places of Teknaf, Cox's Bazar.

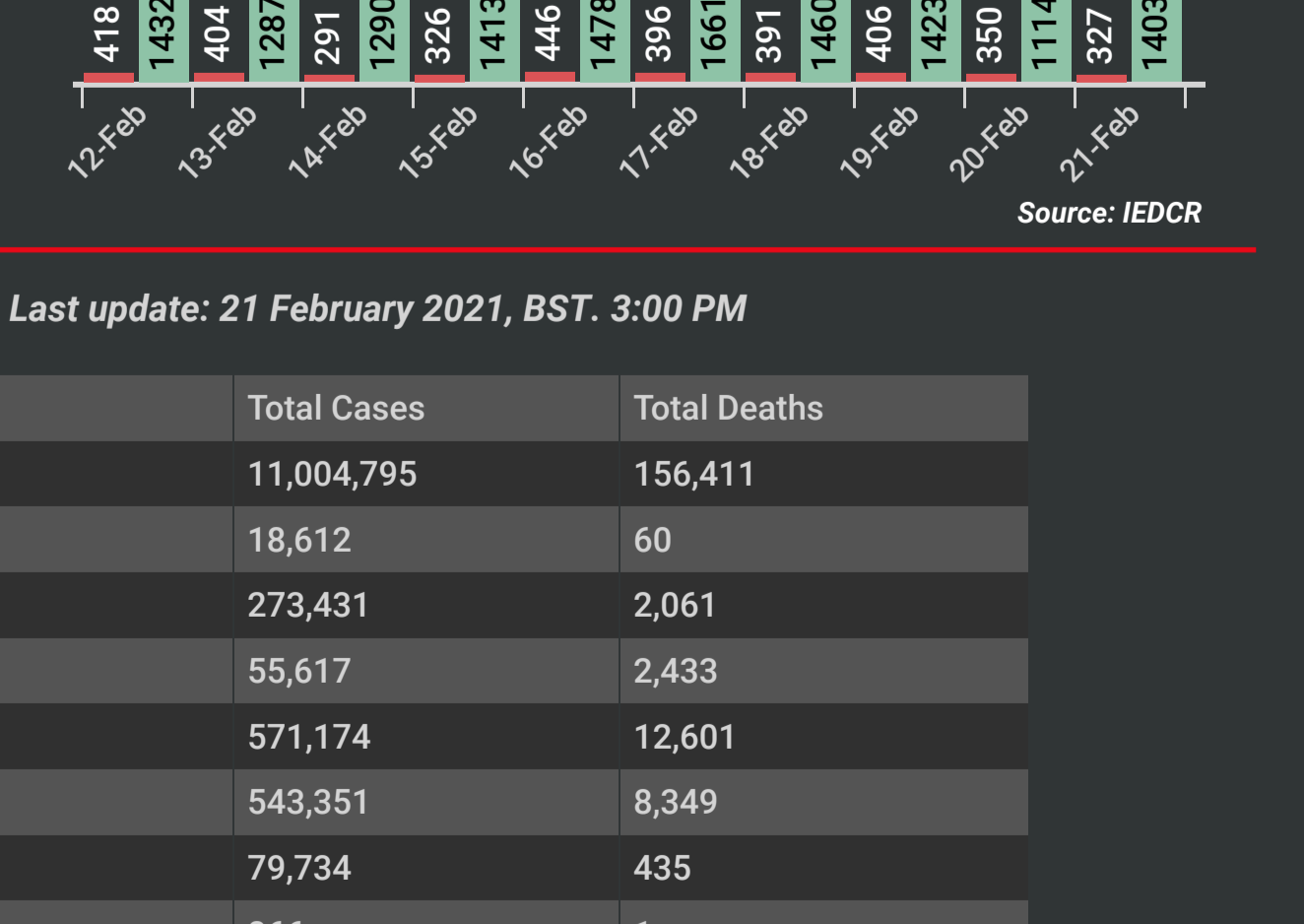
