COVID-19 Prevention Tips



WASH

Wash your hands frequently using soap for at least 20 seconds or sanitise them using alcohol-based handrub.



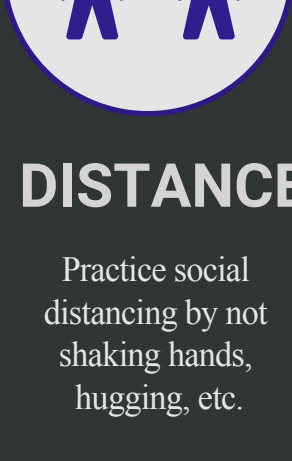
COVER

Use tissues when you cough or sneeze and dispose them immediately in a closed bin. Use flexed-elbow if tissue is unavailable.



AVOID

ISOLATE

Stay at home if you become ill and help prevent its spread.

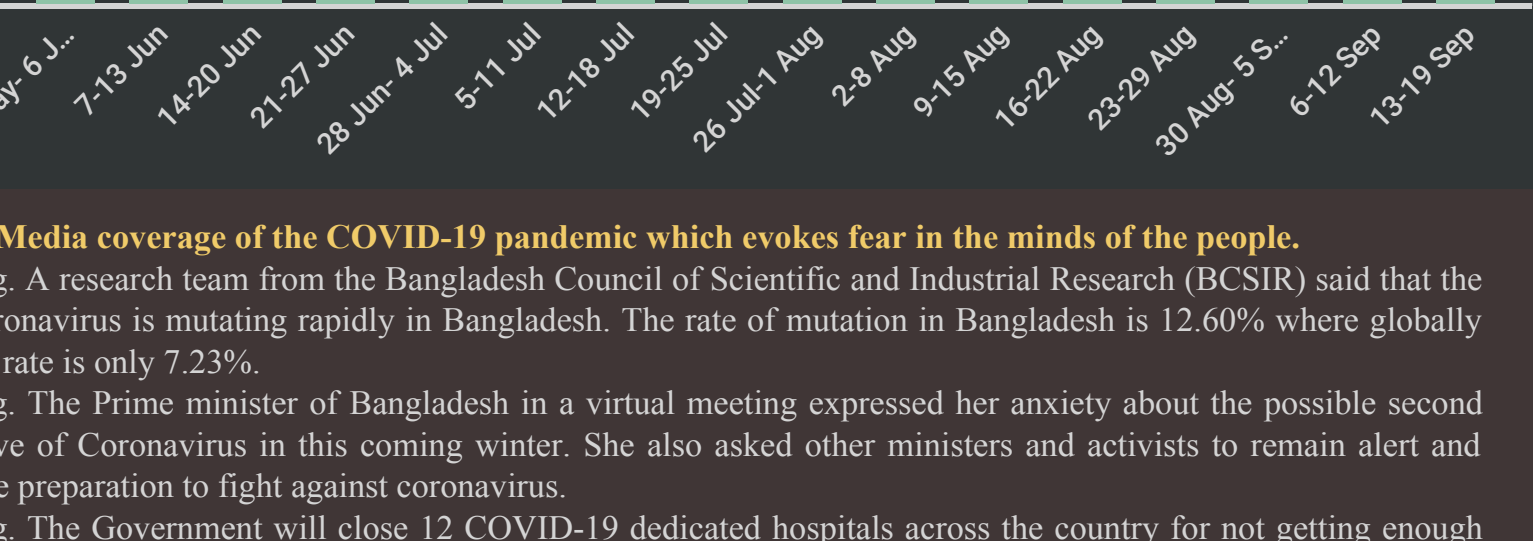
*Weekly Trend: Protests (3) associated with COVID-19 pandemic is steadily on the decline from 13 September 2020 to 19 September 2020.

*Eg. Doctors on duty at the Covid-19 unit of Shahad Suhrawardy Medical College Hospital have given a 48-hour ultimatum to the hospital authorities in demand for safe accommodation. They surrounded the rooms of Director, Deputy Director, Medical College Vice-Chancellor, and Covid-19 Unit Coordinator. Several doctors working at the Covid-19 unit said they cannot put their family at risk by going back home every day after duty. 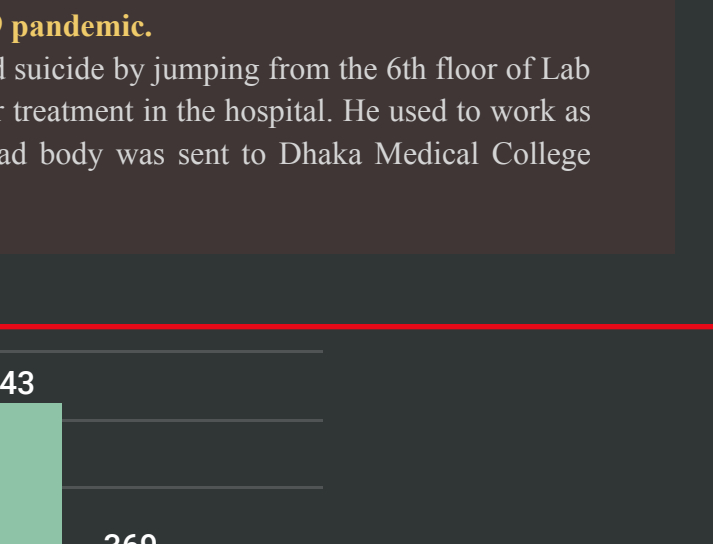
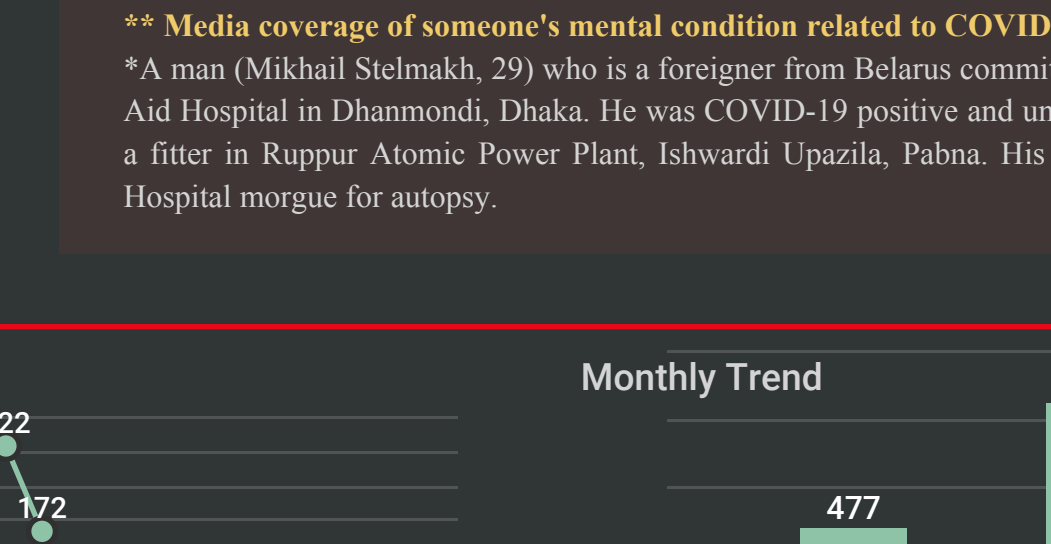
** Media coverage of the COVID-19 pandemic which evokes fear in the minds of the people.

*Eg. A research team from the Bangladesh Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (BCSIR) said that the Coronavirus is mutating rapidly in Bangladesh. The rate of mutation in Bangladesh is 12.60% where globally the rate is only 7.23%.

*Eg. The Prime minister of Bangladesh in a virtual meeting expressed her anxiety about the possible second wave of Coronavirus in this coming winter. She also asked other ministers and activists to remain alert and take preparation to fight against coronavirus.

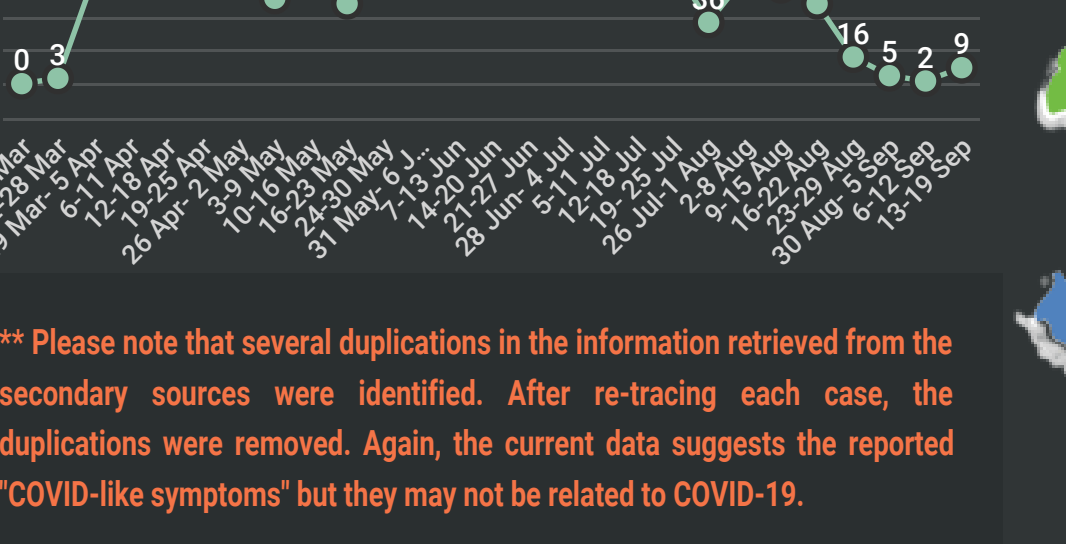
*Eg. The Government will close 12 COVID-19 dedicated hospitals across the country for not getting enough COVID-19 patients because these hospitals cost money, technical support, and manpower to operate.

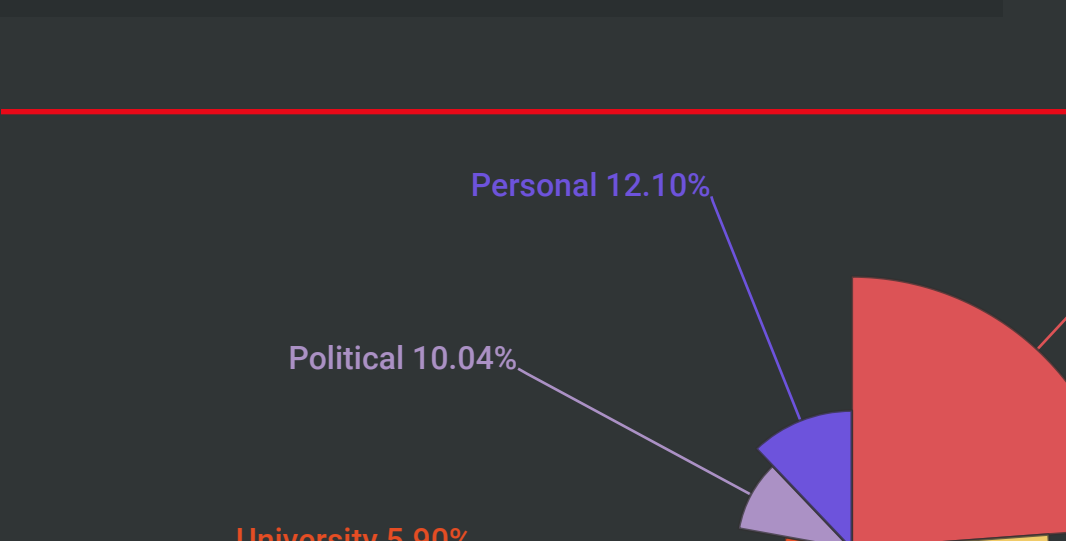
** Media coverage of someone's mental condition related to COVID-19 pandemic.

*A man (Mehdi Steimlich, 29) who is a foreigner from Belarus committed suicide by jumping from the 6th floor of Lab Aid Hospital in Dharmadhi, Dhaka. He was COVID-19 positive and under treatment in the hospital. He used to work as a fitter in Rappur Atomic Power Plant, Ishwardi Upazila, Pabna. His dead body was sent to Dhaka Medical College Hospital morgue for autopsy.



** Please note that several duplications in the information retrieved from the secondary sources were identified. After re-tracing each case, the duplications were removed. Again, the current data suggests the reported 'COVID-like symptoms' but they may not be related to COVID-19.

*Eg. Barishal Metropolitan Police gave three lakh taka check each to the families of two policemen who died from COVID-19 at Barishal Sadar, Barishal.

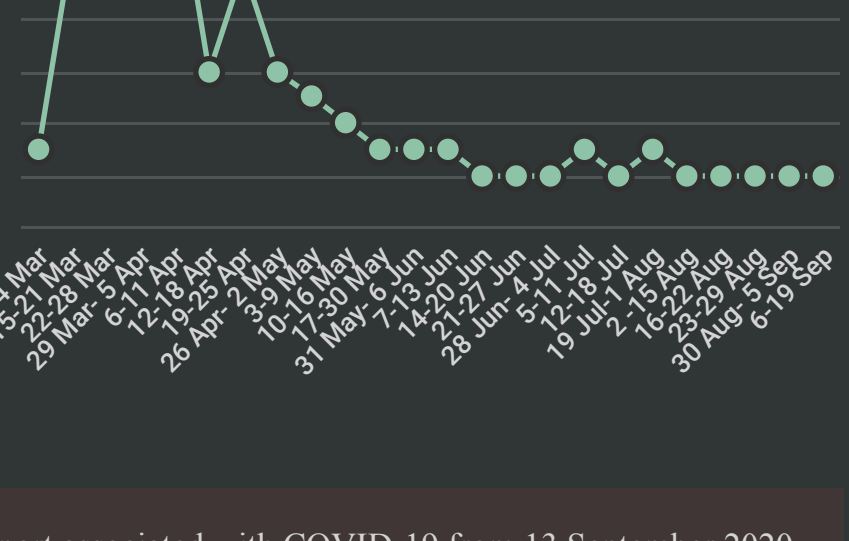
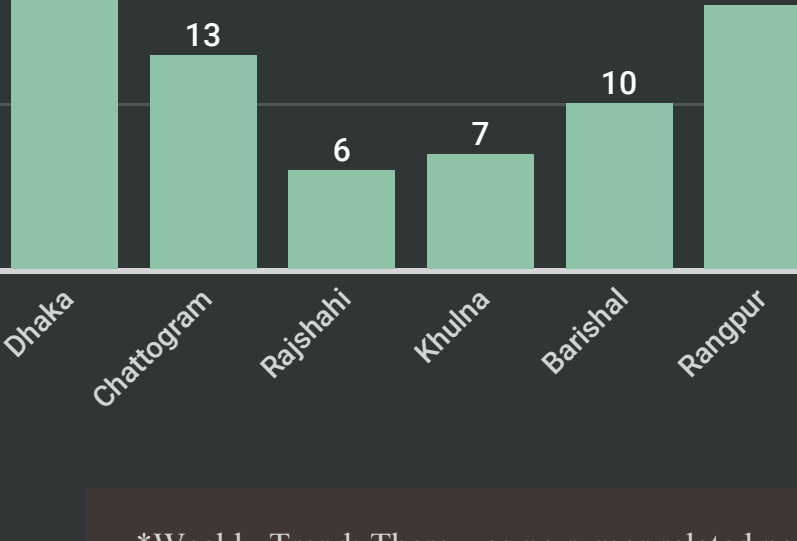

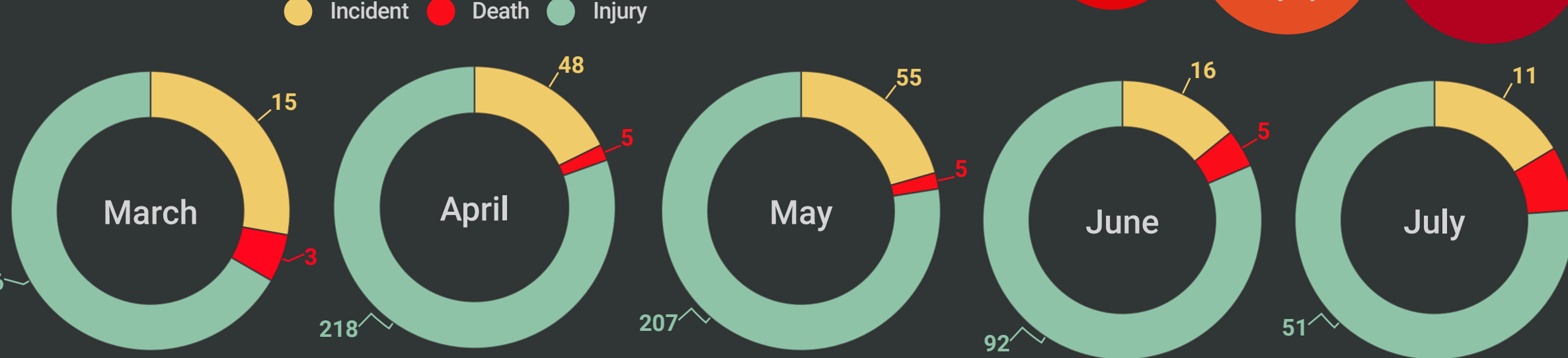

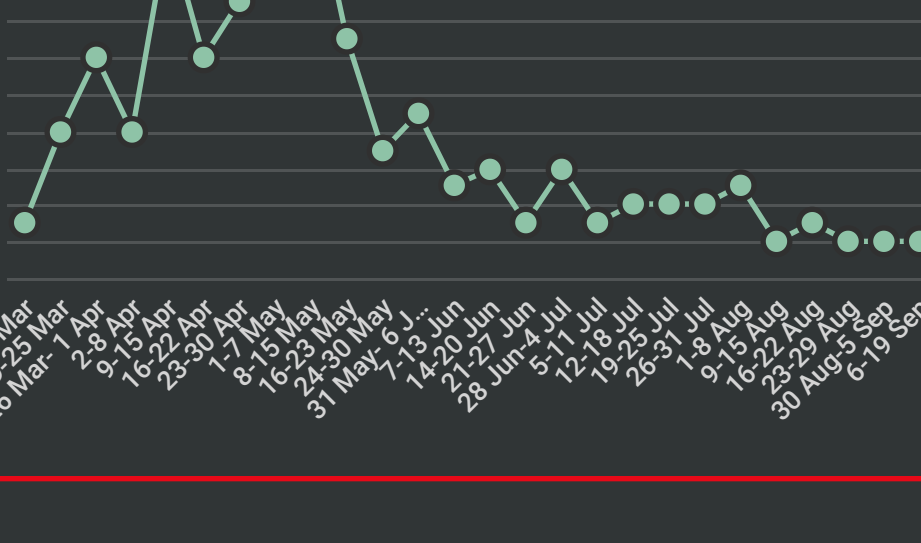


Violent Incident Related with COVID-19 (1 March -19 September 2020)
