COVID-19 Prevention Tips



WASH

Wash your hands frequently using soap for at least 20 seconds or sanitise them using alcohol-based handrub.



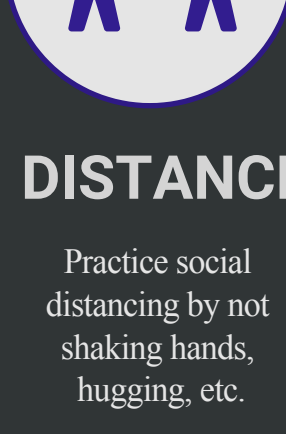
COVER

Practice social distancing by not shaking hands, hugging, etc.

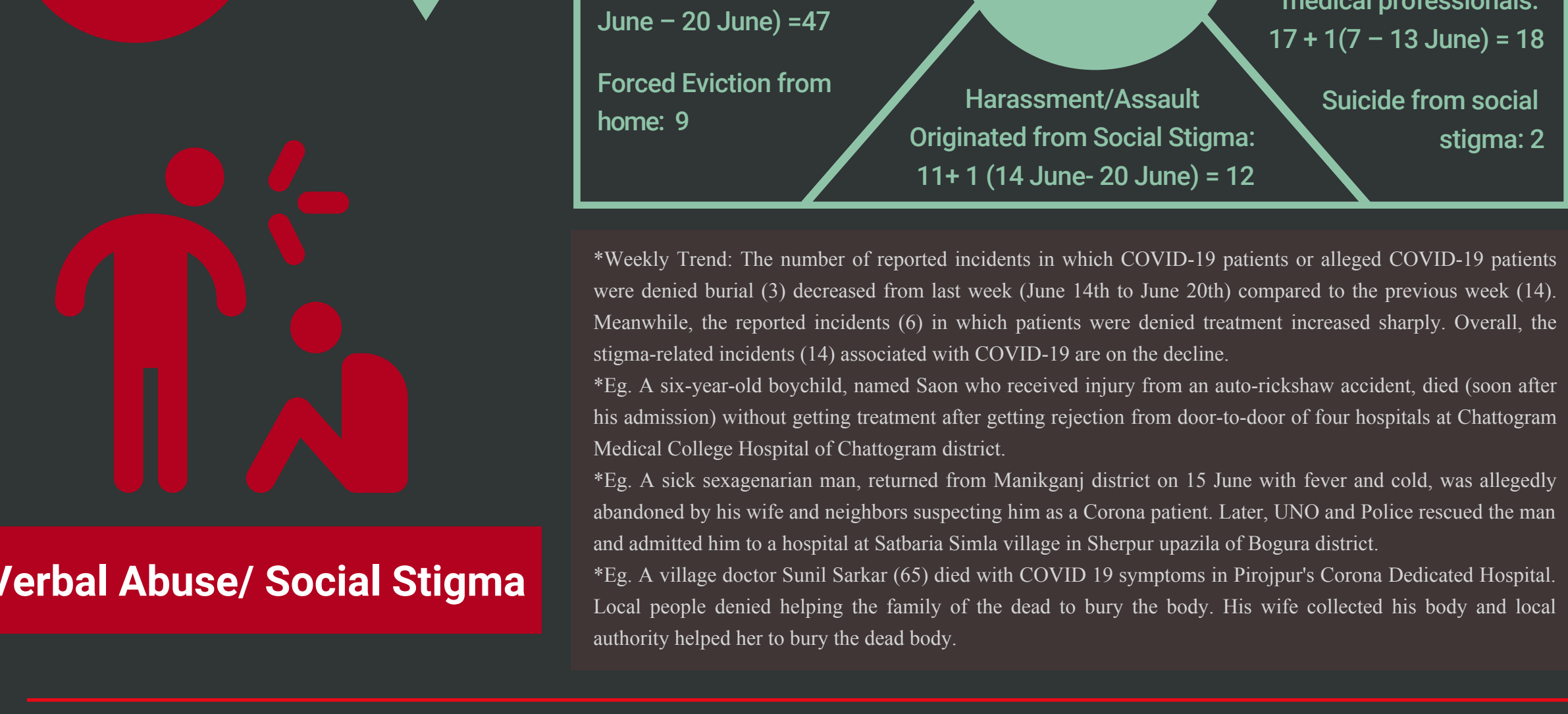


ISOLATE

Covid-19 Related Incident Mapping in Bangladesh

Update: 1 March- 20 June 2020



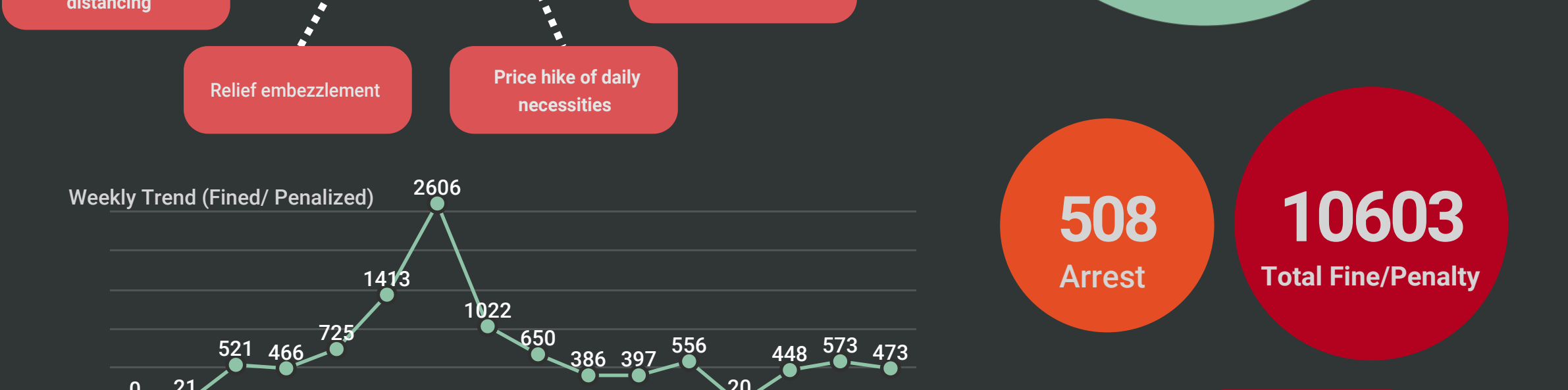
*Weekly Trend: The number of reported incidents in which COVID-19 patients or alleged COVID-19 patients were denied burial (3) decreased from last week (June 14th to June 20th) compared to the previous week (14). Meanwhile, the reported incidents (6) in which patients were denied treatment increased sharply. Overall, the stigma-related incidents (14) associated with COVID-19 are on the decline.

*Eg. A six-year-old boychild, named Saon who received injury from an auto-rickshaw accident, died (soon after his admission) without getting treatment after getting rejection from door-to-door of four hospitals at Chattogram Medical College Hospital of Chattogram district.

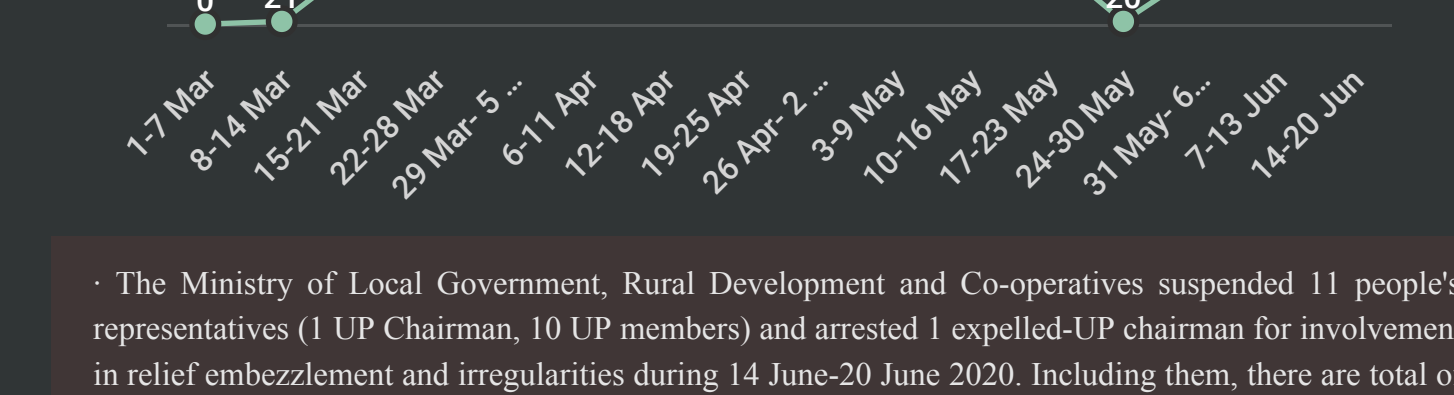
*Eg. A sick sexagenarian man, returned from Manikganj district on 15 June with fever and cold, was allegedly abandoned by his wife and neighbors suspecting him as a Corona patient. Later, UNO and Police rescued the man and admitted him to a hospital at Satbaria Simla village in Sherpur upazila of Bogura district.

*Eg. A village doctor Sunil Sarkar (65) died with COVID 19 symptoms in Pirojpur's Corona Dedicated Hospital. Local people denied helping the family of the dead to bury the body. His wife collected his body and local authority helped her to bury the dead body.

Verbal Abuse/ Social Stigma



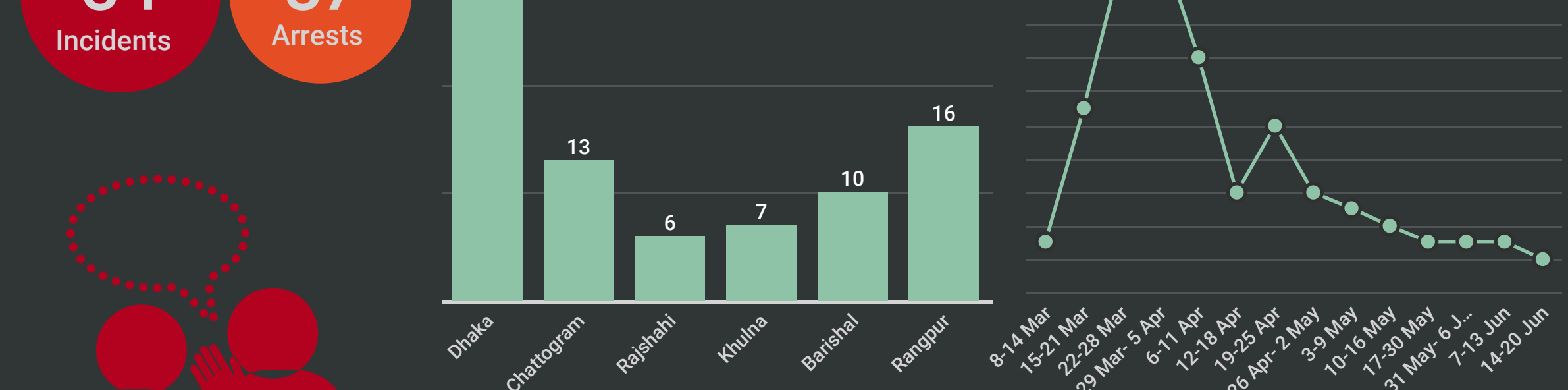

The Ministry of Local Government, Rural Development and Co-operatives suspended 11 people's representatives (1 UP Chairman, 10 UP members) and arrested 1 expelled-UP chairman for involvement in relief embezzlement and irregularities during 14 June-20 June 2020. Including them, there are total of 100 People's representatives who were suspended so far. Mobile court found stocks of relief materials in business places in several areas.

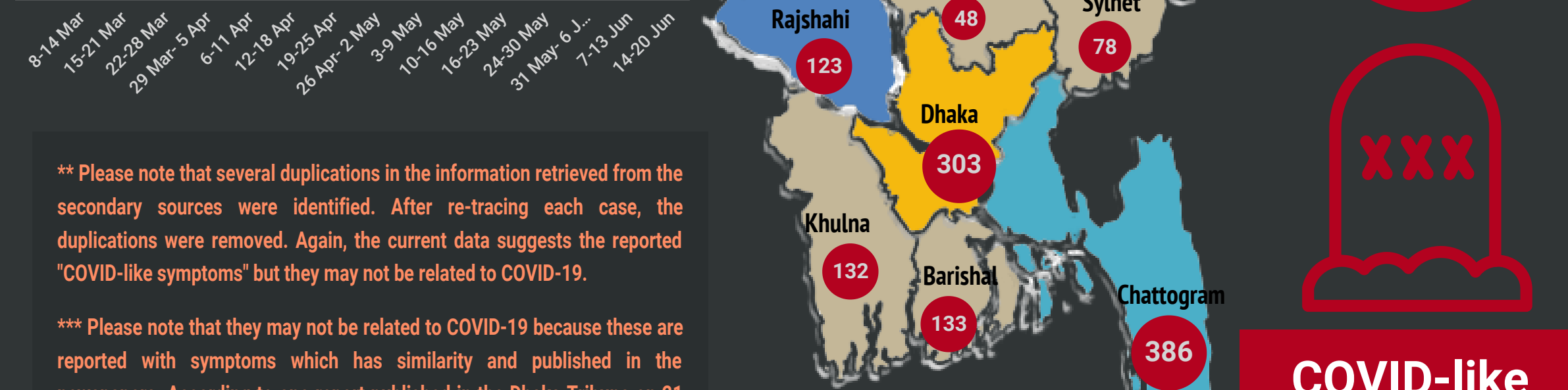
At least 465 were reportedly fined/penalized and 20 people were arrested all over Bangladesh during 14 June-20 June 2020. Most of the fine and penalty accounted for the violation of health and safety regulations public, increasing prices and selling adulterated medicines to the public, etc.

*Weekly Trend: There was no rumor-related arrest associated with COVID-19 crisis from June 14th to June 20th as in the prior week from June 7th to June 13th.

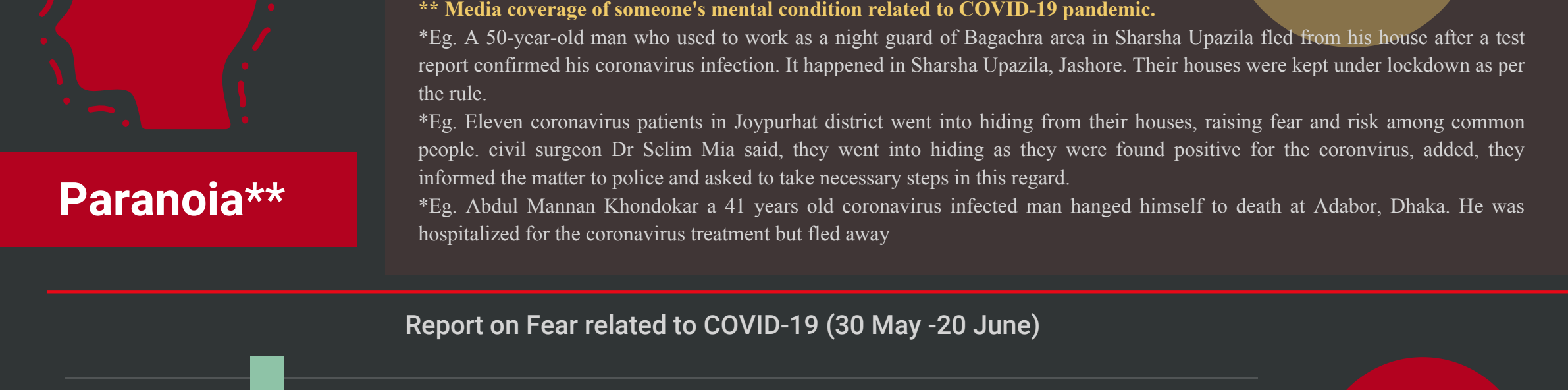
COVID-like Symptoms***

Paranoia**



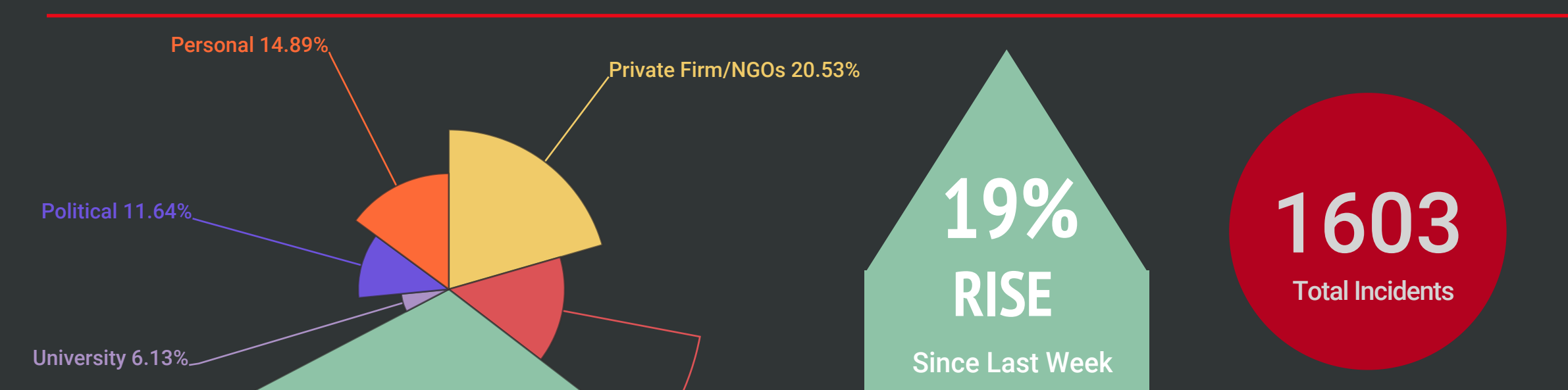
** Media coverage of someone's mental condition related to COVID-19 pandemic.

*Eg. A 50-year-old man who used to work as a night guard of Bagachra area in Sharsha Upazila fled from his house after a test report confirmed his coronavirus infection. It happened in Sharsha Upazila, Jashore. Their houses were kept under lockdown as per the rule.

*Eg. Eleven coronavirus patients in Joyprath district went into hiding from their houses, raising fear and risk among common people. civil surgeon Dr Selim Mia said, they went into hiding as they were found positive for the coronavirus. added, they informed the matter to police and asked to take necessary steps in this regard.

*Eg. Abdul Mannan Khondokar a 41 years old coronavirus infected man hanged himself to death at Adabor, Dhaka. He was hospitalized for the coronavirus treatment but fled away.

Fear**



** Media coverage of COVID-19 pandemic which evokes fear in the minds of the people.

*Eg. The non-COVID patients at Chattogram Medical College Hospital, Panchlaish, Chattogram are suffering badly for the mismanagement of the hospital.

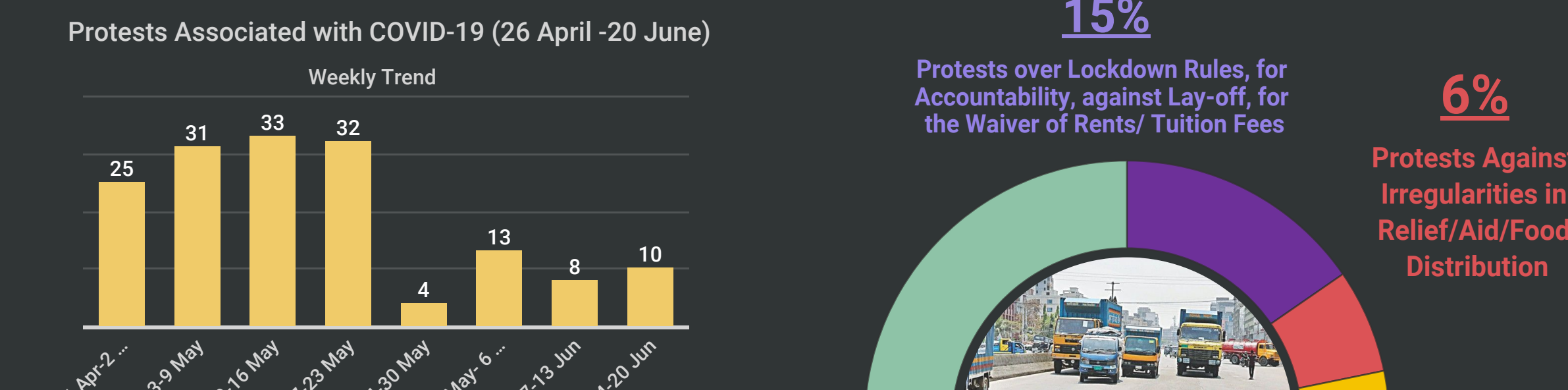
*Eg. WEF shows concern that 25% of remittance would be decreased regarding the joblessness of the migrant workers specially in the middle east and country like Bangladesh, mostly depends on the source of income from remittance, could suffer most.

*Eg. As confirmed COVID-19 cases in the country passed the one lakh mark, the director-general of health services said the outbreak of COVID-19 will not end within one, two or three months, the virus might continue to spread during the next two to three years.

*Eg. People are throwing the used masks, gloves, PPEs and protection stuffs randomly here and there which could higher the risks and chances to spread coronavirus infection at Dhaka capital city.

*Eg. The Covid-19 infection rate continues to spike in Bangladesh with 22.44% of samples tested coming back positive.

Resilience



*Eg. Faculties of Barisal University and doctors from Sher-E-Bangla Medical College Hospital invented a virus killing and preventing mechanism which will be used like a mask named "COVID Kit". This kit will be able to kill the coronavirus that comes in contact with the air from COVID-19 patients. They invented this mask by their own initiative and in their university lab and waiting for the final approval to grant it applying on the COVID-19 patients.

*Eg. Abul Khayer Group provided 25 oxygen cylinders to the Ma o Sishu Hospital in Chattogram.

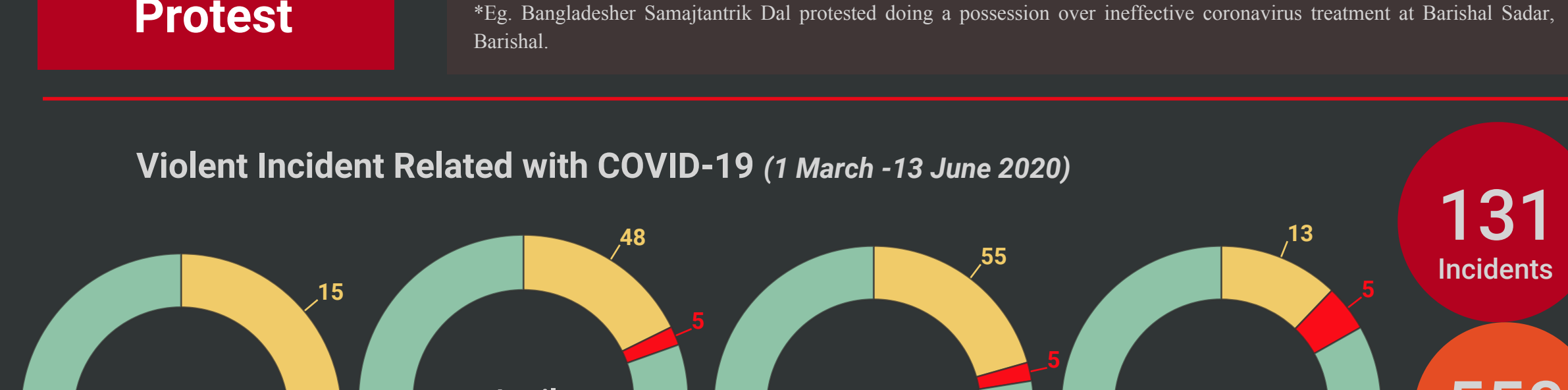
*Eg. Border Guard Bangladesh distributed necessary food products among 400 helpless families in Chattogram.

*Eg. A group of youth has built an Isolation center with 100 beds for the Covid-19 patients in Chattogram.

*Eg. A school teacher has provided an oxygen cylinder to the General Hospital of Chattogram.

*Eg. A Communist Party of Bangladesh distributed KN95 masks among the people at Khula Sadar, Khulna.

Protest



15% Protests over Lockdown Rules, for Accountability, against Lay-off, for the Waiver of Rents/ Tuition Fees

6% Protests Against Irregularities in Relief/Aid/Food Distribution

30% Demand for Relief/Aid/Food Related Protests

5% Protest against Hike in Bus fares

44% Protests for Unpaid Salaries and Eid Bonuses

*Weekly Trend: Protests against due wages and Eid bonus (6) from the manufacturing sector such as RMG was the dominant type from June 7th to June 13th. Overall, the protests associated with the COVID-19 pandemic were steady (10) from June 14th to June 20th compared to the previous week (8).

*Eg. Stone miners/workers formed a human chain and protested for due salaries and Eid bonus as the mine was closed following the outbreak of COVID-19 at Maddapara area in Parbatpur upazila of Dinajpur district.

*Eg. The tenants' council have demanded a waiver of house and shop rent in April, May and June this year. The group made the demand at a human chain in front of the National Press Club on Sunday (June 14th) morning.

*Eg. The members of Gana Sanghati Andolan carried out a rally and protested against the government over not taking measures regarding COVID-19 prevention in the initial stage; later, Police intervened to bring the situation under control in front of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare at Dhaka capital city.

*Eg. Bangladeshers Samajtantrik Dal protested doing a possession over ineffective coronavirus treatment at Barisal Sadar, Barisal.

Violent Incident Related with COVID-19 (1 March -13 June 2020)



*Eg. A ward boy of Khulna Medical College hospital was arrested over the allegation of sexually harassing a housewife, a corona patient, while she was undergoing treatment in a Hospital in Khulna.

*Eg. Five persons were injured in a fight between two groups of men over detaining government relief rice of the fishermen during smuggling at Morreiganj, Bangladesh.

*Eg. A Dhaka university graduates youth, named Enamul Haque Sweet, allegedly committed suicide by hanging himself over being frustrated after losing his job due to corona pandemic and other family funds on midnight past Thursday (19 June) at Bamondanga village in Santhia upazila of Pabna district.
