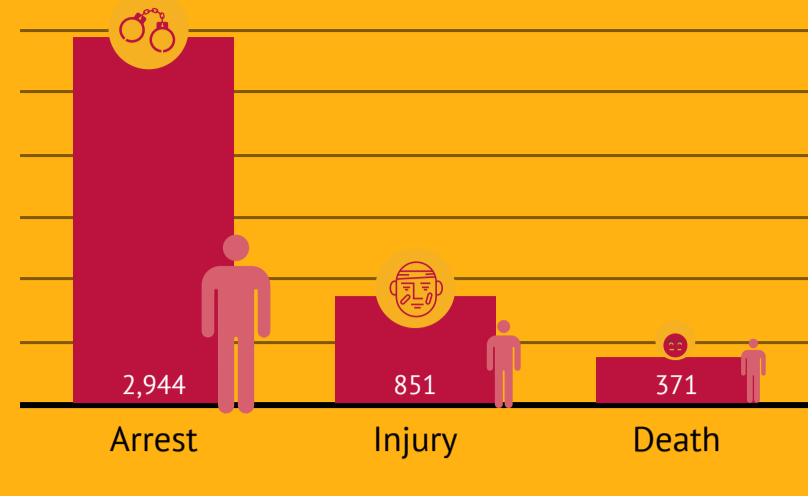
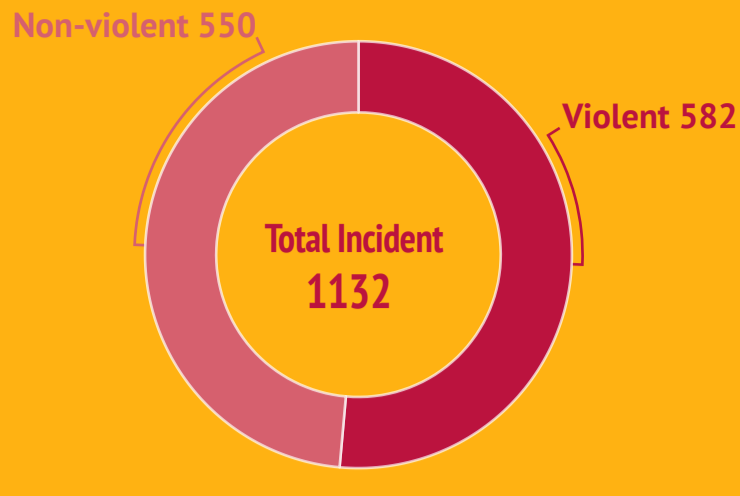

*According to BPO Codebook, "Violent incidents" are those reported incidents that "involved the intentional use of physical force by an individual or group against another individual or group, in a manner that resulted or could have resulted in death, injury or any other form of physical harm to persons or property."
According to BPO Codebook, "Non-violent incidents" are those reported incidents that "did not involve the intentional use of physical force by an individual or group against another individual or group, in a manner that resulted or could have resulted in death, injury or any other form of physical harm to persons or property, e.g. arrest, peaceful protest, rescue, and recovery."

Barisal has the highest incident rates*

E.g. A girl, Tisha Akhter (9), was gang-raped and killed by some goons in Tangail, Dhaka. Police arrested three people in this connection.
E.g. A third-grader student (10) was forcefully raped by an Union Parishad Member (45) in Sadar Upazila of Chapai Nawabganj, Rajshahi. Police arrested the accused member.

Barisal has the highest death rates*

E.g. A seven years old boy was allegedly strangled to death by a tea staller over a trifling matter in Gomastapur Upazila, Chapai Nawabganj; police arrested four in this connection.
E.g. Mahfuzur Sajid, 14, was stabbed to death by the local miscreants over the previous enmity in Mymensingh. Police arrested two suspects from the area.
