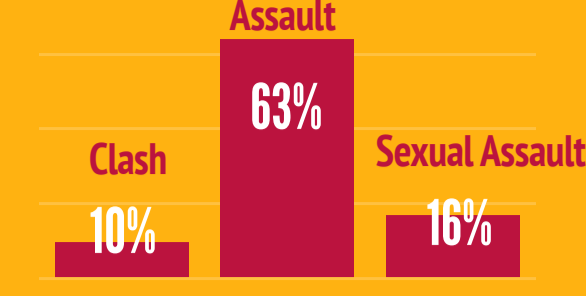

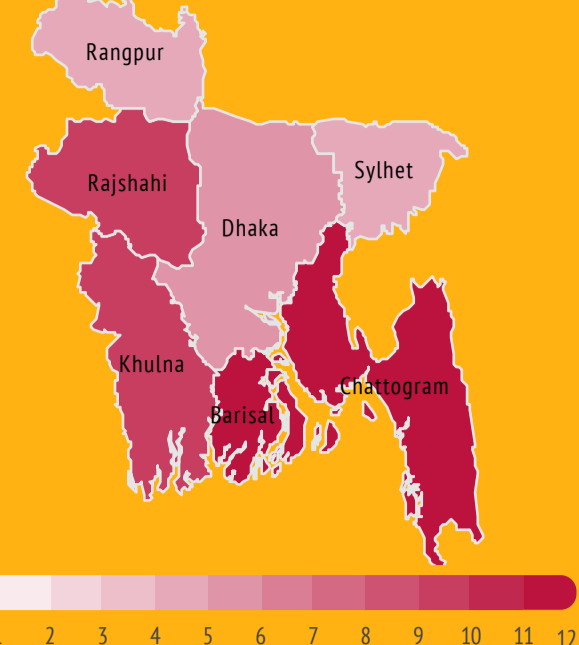
Top 3 reported violent incidents in January 2021



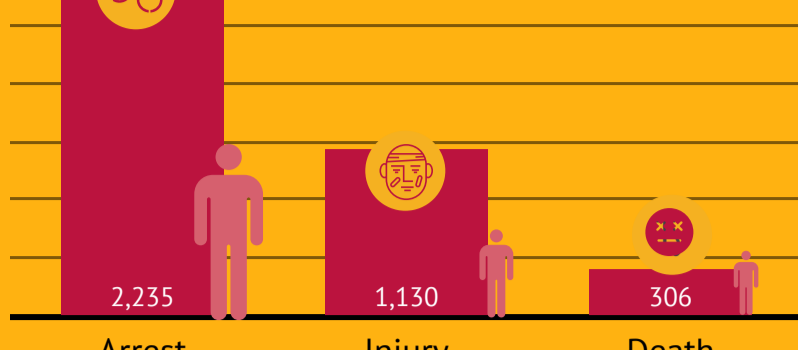
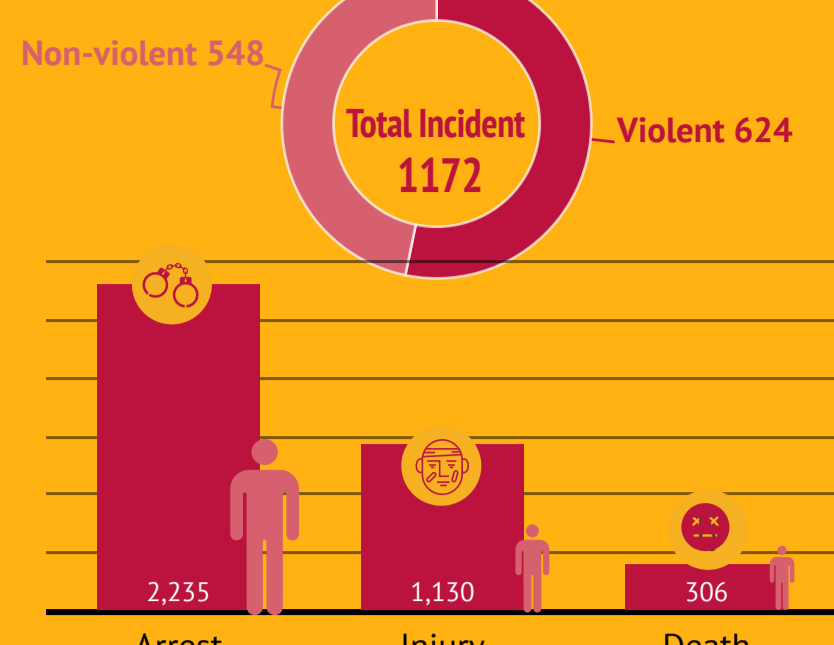
Bottom 3 reported violent incidents in January 2021

1 Sexual assault

RISE 16%
From December 2020 to January 2021

116 Incident, 126 Arrest, 6 Death

Barishal has the highest incident rates*

The number of sexual assault increased by 16% in January'21 compared to December'20. There were 100 reported sexual assaults in December'20 and 116 incidents reported in January'21.

Dhaka has the highest death rates*

The death rate in Dhaka is double or higher compared to other divisions.

Overall, 7% increase in incidents in January'21 compared to December'20. The number was 121 in December'20, it became 130 in January'21.

Divisional distribution (Jan'20-Jan'21)

*Includes both violent and non-violent incidents. According to BPO Codebook, "violent incidents" are those reported incidents that "involved the intentional use of physical force by an individual or group against another individual or group, in a manner that resulted or could have resulted in death, injury or any other form of physical harm to persons or property." According to BPO Codebook, "non-violent incidents" are those reported incidents that "did not involve the intentional use of physical force by an individual or group against another individual or group, in a manner that resulted or could have resulted in death, injury or any other form of physical harm to persons or property, e.g. arrest, peaceful protest, rescue, and recovery."

9 Violence against Minorities

* 3 temples were attacked and 6 Idols were destroyed in the last month. *Eg. Goons ransacked an ancient Hindu temple and assaulted the priest in Ruggan, Narayanganj, Dhaka. Nine people got injured in a try to protect the temple. *Eg. Miscreants attacked a Hindu temple and vandalized three idols in Sujanagar, Pabna, Rajshahi.
