COVID-19 Prevention Tips

WASH

Wash your hands frequently using soap for at least 20 seconds or sanitise them using alcohol-based handrub.

COVER

Use tissues when you cough or sneeze and dispose them immediately in a closed bin. Use flexed-elbow if tissue is unavailable.

AVOID

Avoid touching your mouth, eyes and nose, especially after contact with any surface.

DISTANCE

Practice social distancing by not shaking hands, hugging, etc.

ISOLATE

Stay at home if you become ill and help prevent its spread.

**** Media coverage of the COVID-19 pandemic which evokes fear in the minds of the people.**

*Eg. Vaccination against COVID 19 has begun in more than 50 countries worldwide, but large numbers of people are still being infected and dying every day. About 17,363 people have died with the world's highest death rate in one day.

*Eg. A report from the World Economic Forum stated the big challenge would be to provide jobs to the people who have become unemployed because of the Corona pandemic. It said that during the COVID-19 lockdown time, 80% of young people got mentally depressed.

*Eg. The dropout rate in primary and secondary education will increase as 69.5% of the students have no access to remote learning platforms amid this COVID-19 outbreak.

*Eg. Representatives of the World Health Organization said COVID-19 could claim more than one lakh lives per week in upcoming days.

*Eg. Bangladeshi biotech company OMC Healthcare (Pvt.) Ltd. develops COVID-19 RT-PCR testing kit to support the health sector in Bangladesh.

*Eg. COVID-19 vaccination program will begin on January 27 in Dhaka and the whole country on 8th February.

*Eg. Globe Biotech Limited to manufacture their Covid-19 vaccine, Bongavax, for the clinical trial. After the successful clinical trial, Globe Biotech will go for manufacturing the vaccine for mass population trial.

*Eg. Bangladesh Jubo League distributed winter clothes and masks among the poor people in Gazipur.

*Eg. India has officially handed over a consignment of around 2 million coronavirus vaccine doses meant as a gift to Bangladesh.
