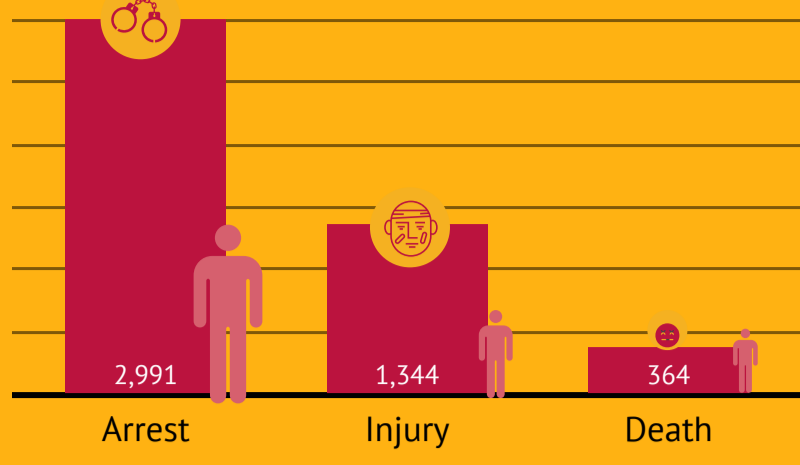
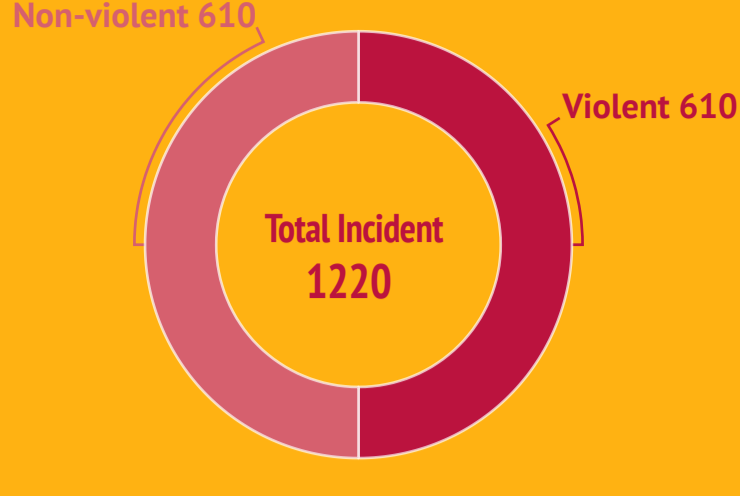

Consequences of the incidents in April 2022



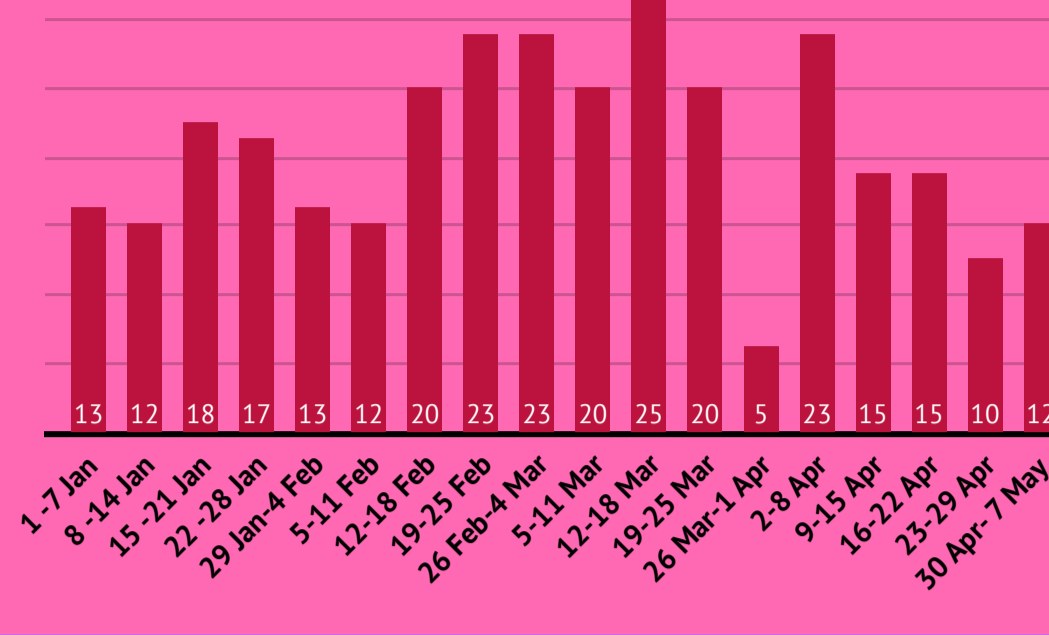

The number of sexual assault decreased by 18% in April'22 compared to March'22.

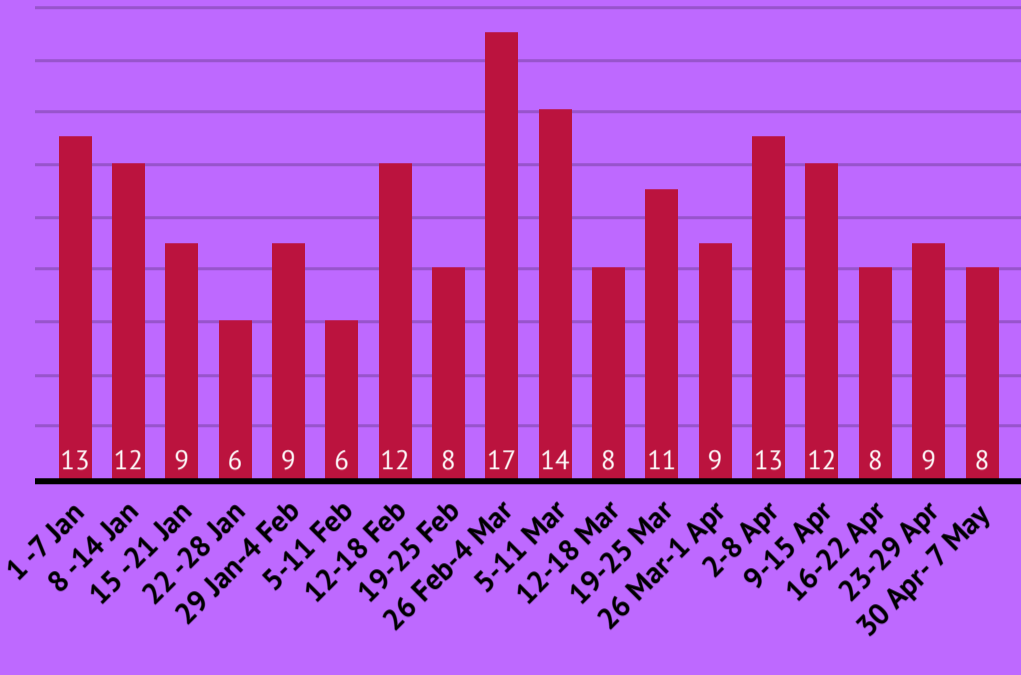

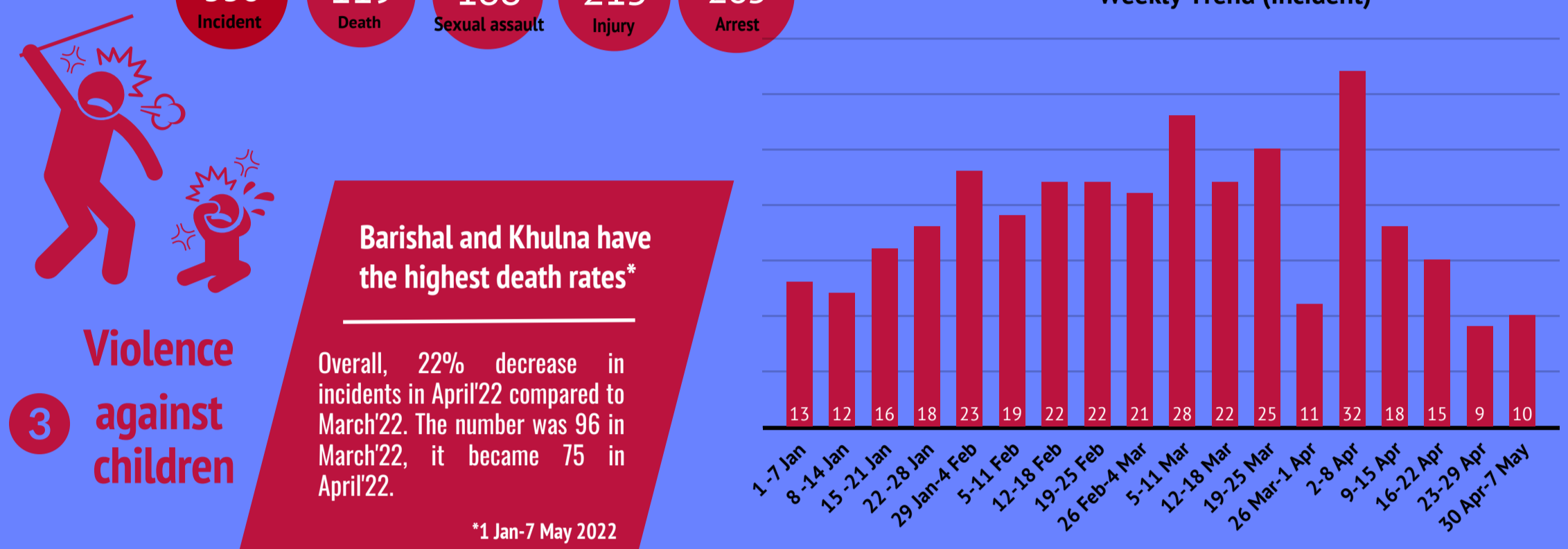
Domestic and dowry related violence decreased by 20% in the period between March-April 2022.

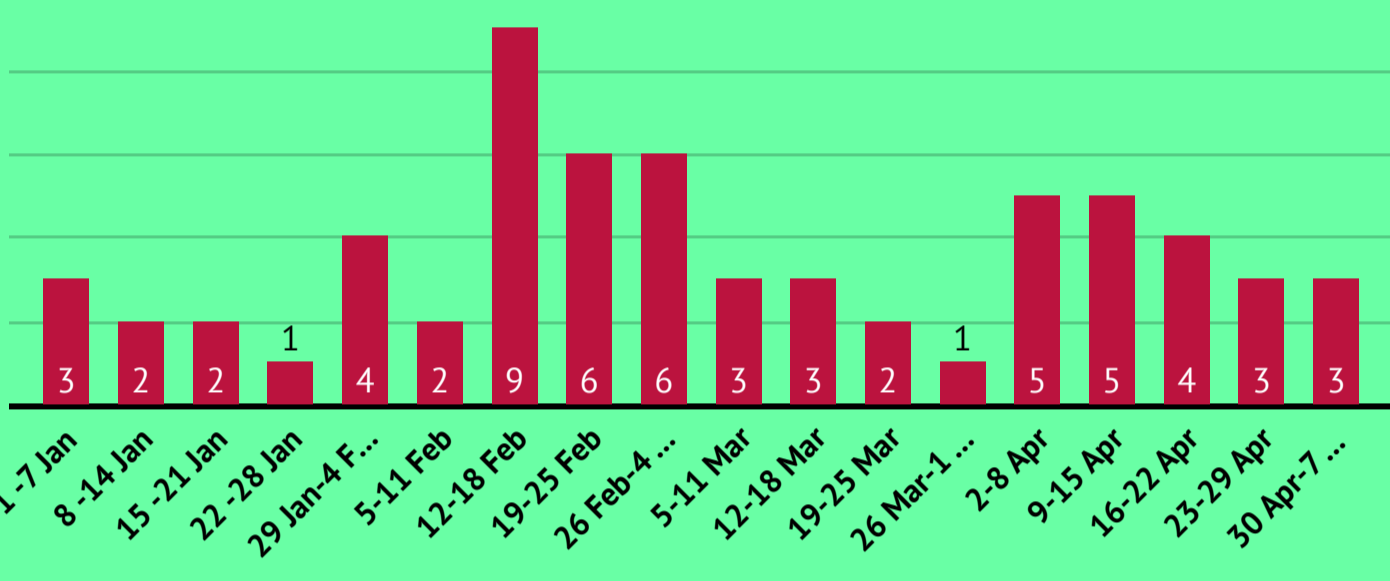
Barishal and Khulna have the highest death rates*

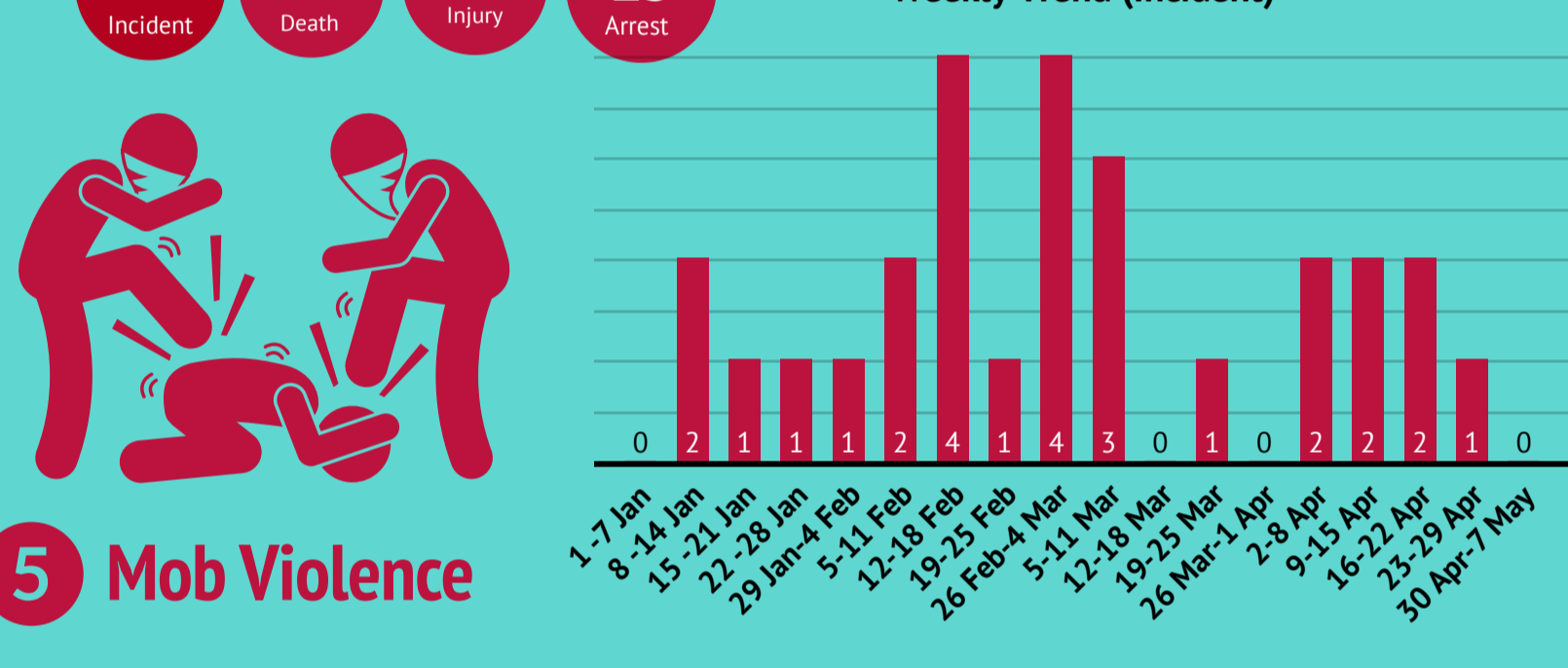

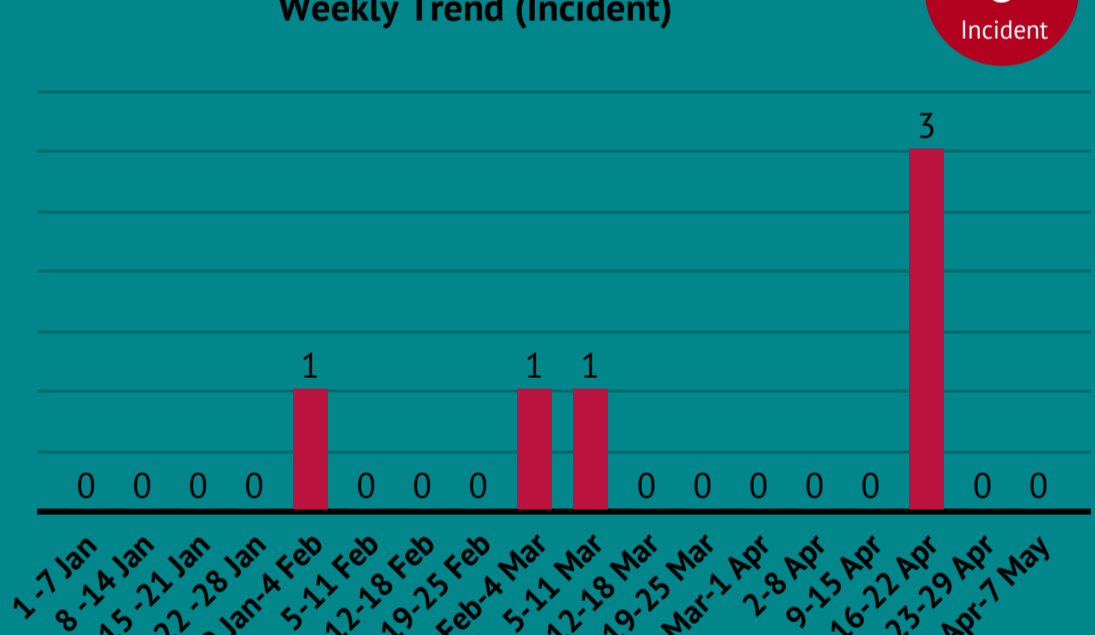

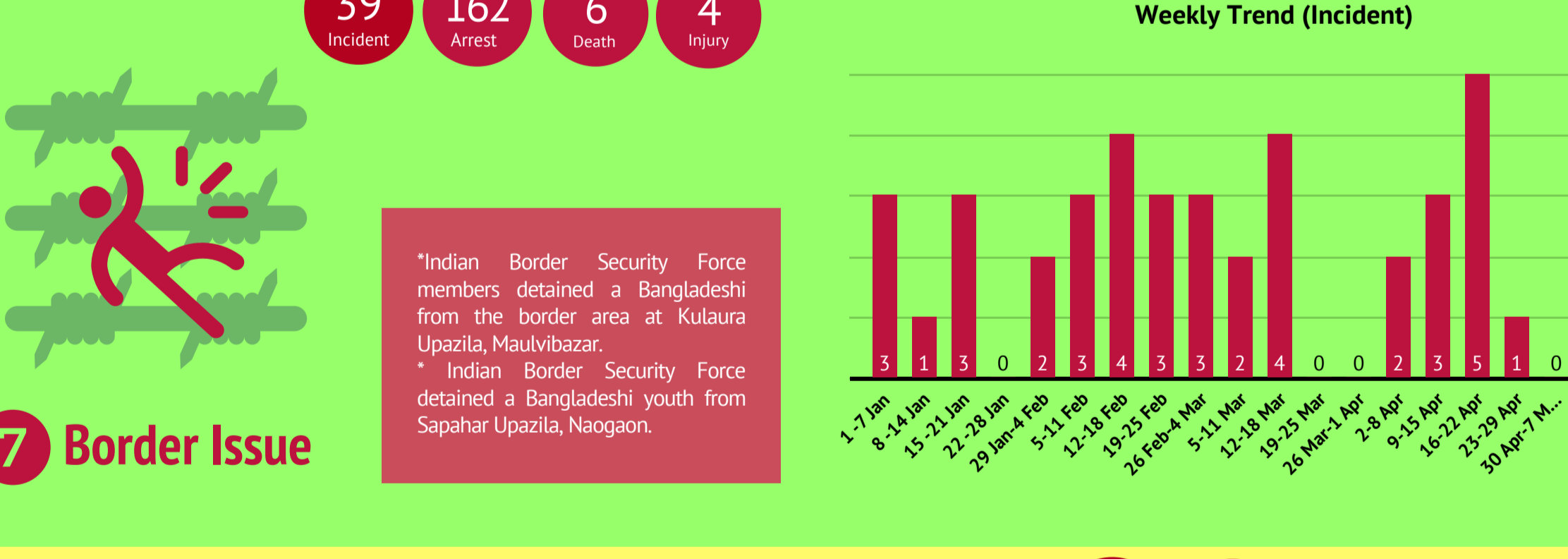

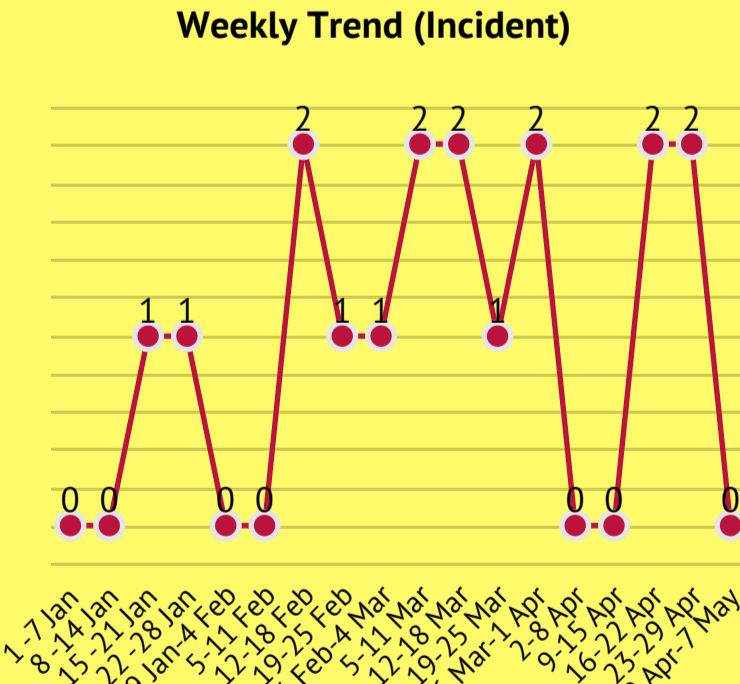

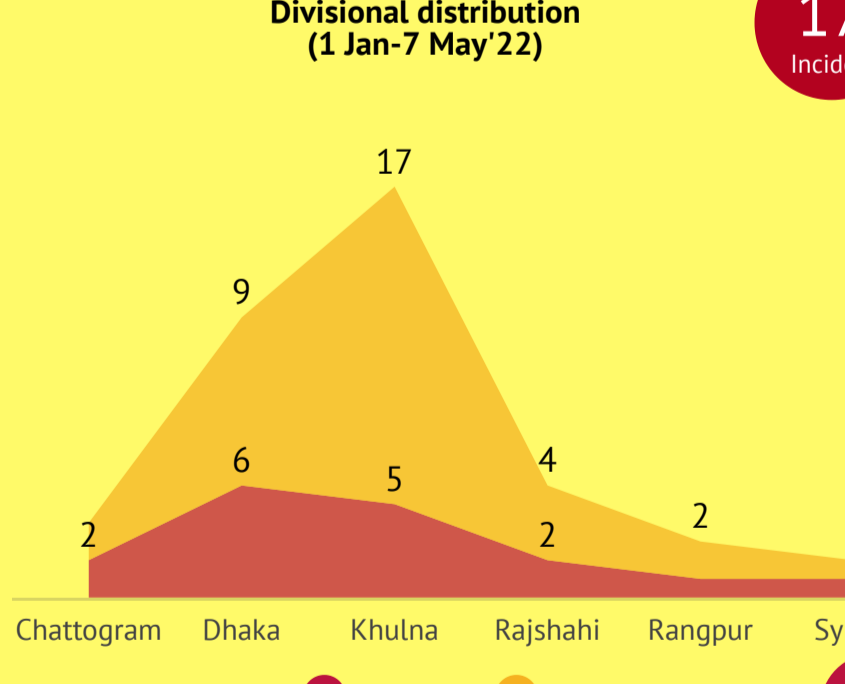

8 Violent Extremism

*Includes both violent and non-violent incidents. According to BPO Codebook, "violent incidents" are those reported incidents that "involved the intentional use of physical force by an individual or group against another individual or group, in a manner that resulted or could have resulted in death, injury or any other form of physical harm to persons or property." According to BPO Codebook, "non-violent incidents" are those reported incidents that "did not involve the intentional use of physical force by an individual or group against another individual or group, in a manner that resulted or could have resulted in death, injury or any other form of physical harm to persons or property, e.g. arrest, peaceful protest, rescue, and recovery."

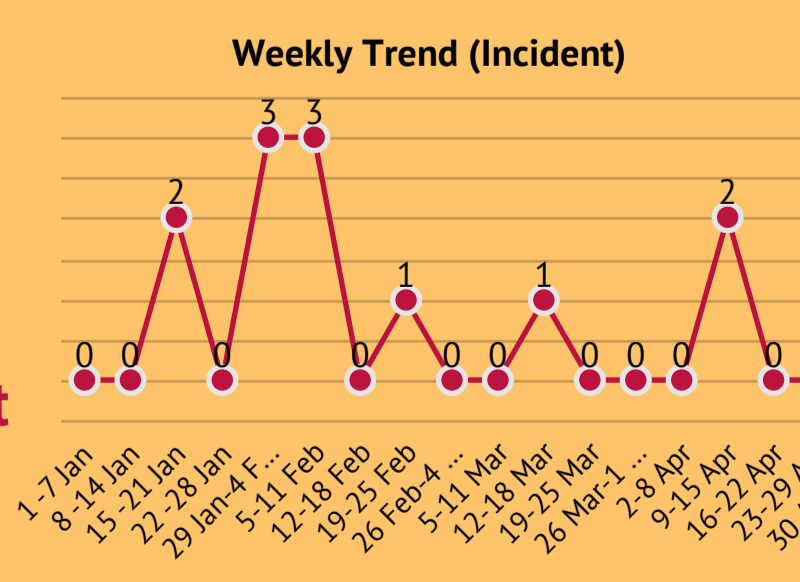
12 Incident, 0 Death, 25 Arrest, 22 Injury

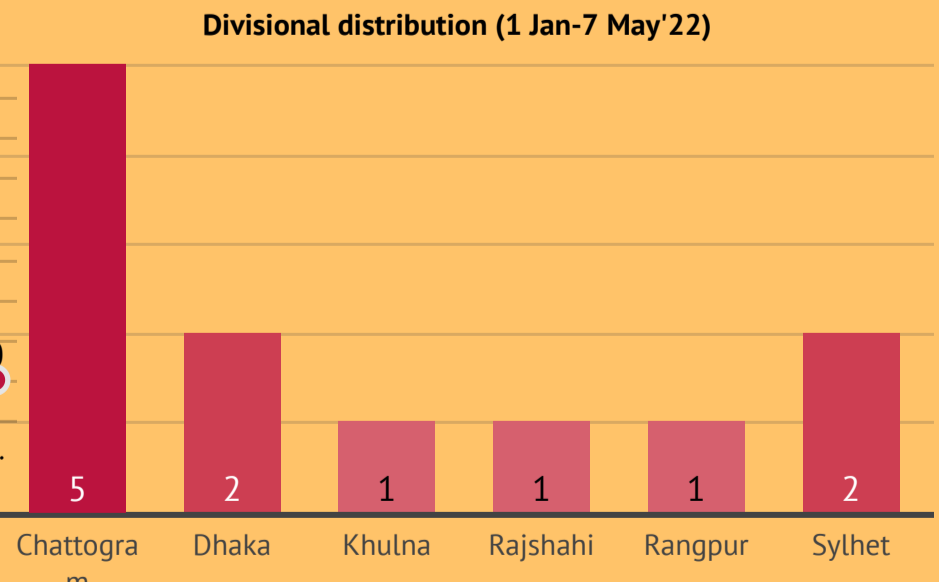

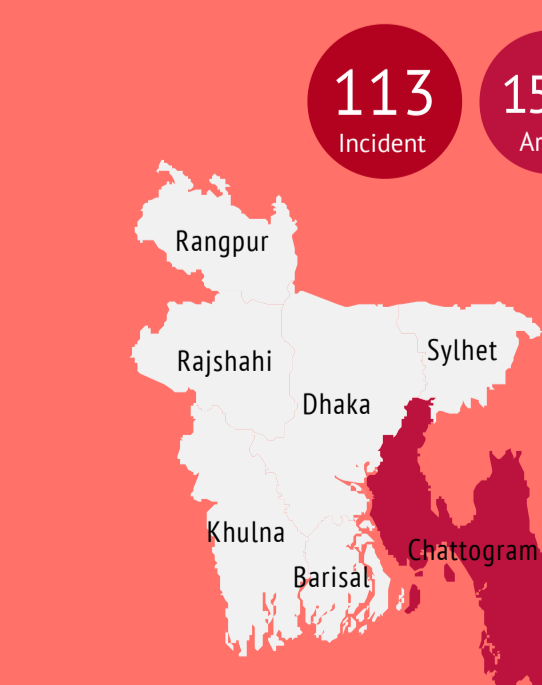
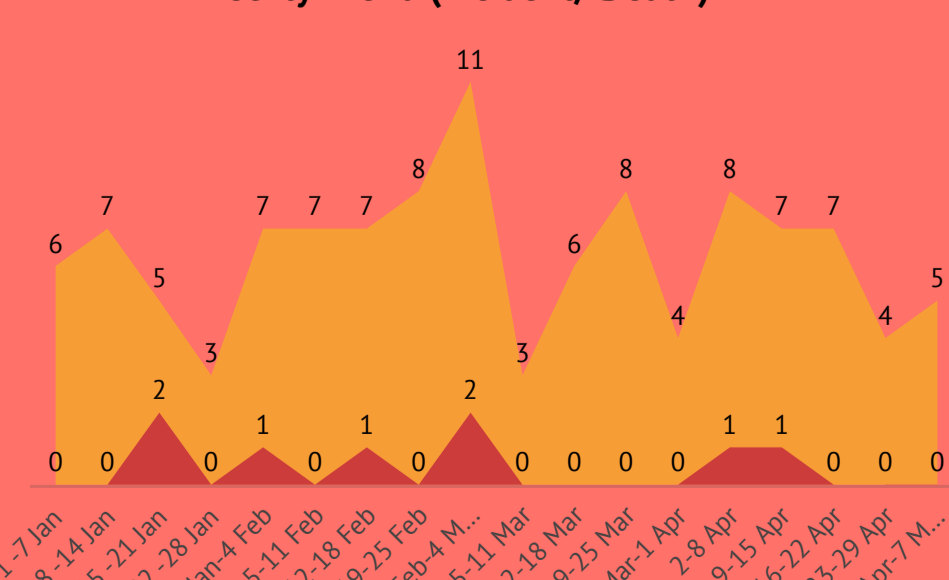
