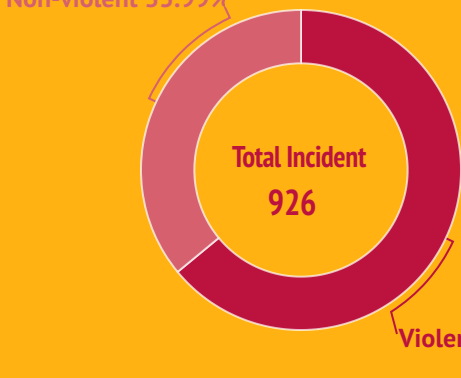
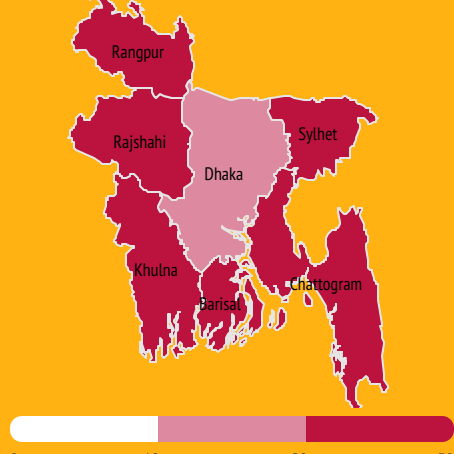


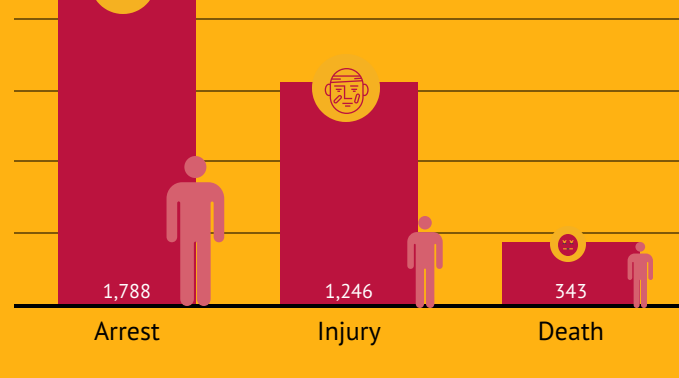
Overview of the incidents in September 2023

*According to BPO Codebook, "Violent incidents" are those reported incidents that "involved the intentional use of physical force by an individual or group against another individual or group, in a manner that resulted or could have resulted in death, injury or any other form of physical harm to persons or property."
According to BPO Codebook, "Non-violent incidents" are those reported incidents that "did not involve the intentional use of physical force by an individual or group against another individual or group, in a manner that resulted or could have resulted in death, injury or any other form of physical harm to persons or property, e.g. arrest, peaceful protest, rescue, and recovery."

1 Sexual assault

63 Incident, 44 Injury, 4 Death, 58 Arrest

Chattogram has the highest incident rates*

E.g. An elderly woman (65) was allegedly raped by two young men in Sreemangal, Moulvibazar.
E.g. A girl was gang-raped by a group of miscreants in Narayanganj. They tied her mother during the act.
E.g. A housewife was gang raped by 13/14 miscreants at night when her husband was not at home in Doulatpur, Khulna.

2 Domestic and Dowry related violence

44 Incident, 17 Injury, 39 Deaths, 18 Arrest

Rajshahi has the highest incident rates*

E.g. A housewife (Sadia Akter Mukta, 18) was strangled to death by her husband at Pirojpur. Police arrested five including the husband of the deceased.
E.g. A woman is assaulted and then killed by her family member for dowry-related issues. Police arrested her husband.

3 Political Violence

108 Incident, 15 Death, 644 Injury, 297 Arrest

Chattogram has the highest death rates*

E.g. At least 20 people including four police personnel were injured as Bangladesh Nationalist Party leaders and activists clashed with police in Rajbari. Police detained 15 people after the clash.
E.g. An Awami League leader (Nijam Sarkar) was killed and several others were injured in a clash between two factional groups of Awami League over establishing supremacy in Meghna, Cumilla. Four people were arrested.

4a Ethnic Violence

3 Incident, 2 Death, 1 Arrest, 9 Injury

One Year Before & After: September 2022 (1 Incident) vs September 2023 (3 Incident) ↑

E.g. A man from a small ethnic minority group (Anil) was reportedly killed by a local in Mahadebpur, Naogaon. A case was filed.
E.g. A female student (Dwijpita Chakma) of Dhaka University from an Ethnic group was abducted by a hill-tract-based terrorist group in Baghaichhari, Rangamati, allegedly for keeping a close relation with Bengali friends.

4b Religious Violence

4 Incident, 0 Death, 7 Arrest, 18 Injury, 6 Idols Destroyed

One Year Before & After: September 2022 (4 Incident) vs September 2023 (4 Incident) =

* Six Idols were destroyed in the September 2023.
E.g. Unidentified miscreants vandalised three idols of Hindu gods and goddesses, constructed for the upcoming Durga Puja at Tambulkhana Durga temple under Sadar upazila in Faridpur.
E.g. Two temples in Dhaka's Nawabganj upazila were vandalised by unidentified miscreants.
E.g. Several vagabond youths attacked on a Pooja Mandap and injured 12 people in Madhabpur, Habiganj.

5 Abduction

26 Incident, 7 Death, 6 Injury, 24 Arrest

6 Gunfight

4 Incident, 14 Arrest, 2 Death, 3 Injury

One Year Before & After: September 2022 (4 Incident) vs September 2023 (4 Incident) =

E.g. Two Rohingya men were killed and several others were injured in a gunfight between two rival groups at Madhurchara of Ukhiya, Cox Bazar.
E.g. Six pirates were arrested after a gunfight with police at Hatiya, Noakhali.

7 Border Issue

8 Incident, 5 Arrest, 4 Death, 1 Injury

One Year Before & After: September 2022 (5 Incident) vs September 2023 (8 Incident) ↑

E.g. A Bangladeshi national's dead body, (Jalal Uddin,18), was returned to BGB by BSF in the dowkioe border, Sylhet. BSF informed that he was killed by a group of mobs in accusation of stealing inside Indian state Meghalaya.
E.g. A Bangladeshi national was shot dead allegedly by members of Indian Border Security Force (BSF) at Thakurpur border point in Damurhuda upazila, Chuadanga.

8 Violent Extremism

10 Incident, 21 Arrest, 0 Death, 0 Injury

One Year Before & After: September 2022 (3 Incident) vs September 2023 (10 Incident) ↑

E.g. Rapid Action Battalion reportedly arrested six members, including a key leader, of the banned militant outfit Ansar al-Islam from different areas in Dhaka.
E.g. Anti-Terrorism Unit of Police arrested a member (Arif) of banned militant outfit Ansarulah Bangla Team from Vatara, Dhaka.
